PROMOTIONS

Promotion to the rank of Troop Leader shall be based upon a minimum of four months of service in the previous rank, and compliance with the above criteria.

Promotion to the rank of Group Leader shall be based

upon a minimum of six months of service in the pre-

Promotion to the rank of Storm Leader shall be based upon a minimum of nine months ser of service in the previous rank, and compliance with the above criteria.

STORM LEADER

All Storm Troops shall fully serve the minimum period of time alloted each regular rank prior to consideration for a commission; or shall have served a minimum period of one year in the regular ranks prior to consideration for meritorious commission.

COMMISSIONS

Commission and designation to the rank of Lieutenant shall be effected in compliance with the above criteria for promotions and commissions.



Promotion to the rank of First Lieutenant shall be considered after a minimum of one year service in the previous rank.

CAPTAIN

Promotion to the rank of Captain shall be considered after a minimum of one and a half, to two years' of service in the previous rank.

ASSOCIATE STORM TROOPER

Solid black patch with red circle, worn on left collar.

All individuals residing outside a radius of fifty miles of National Headquarters, or any other Official Headquarters, shall be designated ASSOCIATE MEMBERS. Associate Members shall confine their activities to peaceful promulgation and distribution of Official Party promaganda; contacting and working with other associate members of their immediate locality; and, recruiting new members and supporters.

Associate Members shall not officially represent the American Nazi Party, nor shall they perform any acts in any capacity other than those designated in behalf of the American Nazi Nazi Party, without the official consent of the Commander.

All associate members may apply for membership in the Associate Storm Troops which will require notarization of the Storm Troop Oath.

SPECIAL DIVISIONS of the party will wear a right shoulder patch in lieu of right collar patch to designate area. (see diagram).

HAT PATCH of the Storm Troops will be a silver eagle on black triangular background.

ALL OTHER DIVISIONS will have their area designated by a right collar patch. (see diagram).
