
DAVID DUKE FOR PRESIDENT

HERE'S WHERE DAVID DUKE AND THE POPULIST PARTY STAND ON THE ISSUES

... a Ten-Point Program for Keeping America Strong.

- RESTRICT IMMIGRATION to protect employment for American workers, and to preserve the spirit, the heritage and traditional values of our nation.
- ABOLISH "AFFIRMATIVE ACTION" AND RACIAL QUOTAS in hiring and education. Return to Thomas Jefferson's principle of "Equal Rights for All; Special Privilege for None." Eliminate forced racial busing and forced racial integration.
- REFORM THE WELFARE SYSTEM. Require able-bodied welfare recipients to perform community work in order to receive welfare payments. Enforce family planning among welfare recipients and stop rewarding those who continue to give birth to illegitimate children.
- CRACK DOWN ON CRIME by instituting the death penalty for drug dealers, murderers, rapists, and those involved in violent crime. Protect the right of law-abiding citizens to keep and bear arms as guaranteed by our U.S. Constitution.
- REDUCE FEDERAL INCOME TAXES on America's middle income wage earners. A recent congressional study demonstrates that even with exempting the poor from taxes, a flat rate of approximately 10 percent would bring in the same revenues as our current graduated system.
- PROTECT AMERICAN FARMERS AND WORKERS from slave-labor foreign imports by instituting protective tariffs. Revenues from tariffs would help make up budget deficits and bring in additional federal revenues.
- PLACE AMERICA'S INTERESTS FIRST in foreign policy making. Stand behind anti-communist allies such as South Africa and the Nicaraguan "contra" freedom fighters. Stop siding with Israel in its endless Middle East war-mongering.
- REFORM WALL STREET. Enforce sweeping revisions of current trading regulations. Support free enterprise, not monopoly capitalism. Protect small business from government regulations that smother competition and prop up the multinational conglomerates. Defend consumers from price-fixing and artificial manipulation of the economy.
- ESTABLISH THE STRONGEST DEFENSE IN THE WORLD. Cease shipments of advanced technology and military equipment to enemy nations. Build an invincible national defense by maintaining a posture of armed neutrality.
- BRING DOWN INTEREST RATES by abolishing the privately-owned banking monopoly known as the Federal Reserve System. Replace the Fed with a national bank committed strictly to the interests of the nation as a whole.

You don't have to be a member of the Populist Party to be a populist. In fact, these days lots of Democratic and Republican politicians alike are calling themselves "populists."
