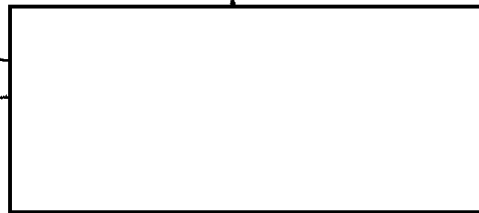

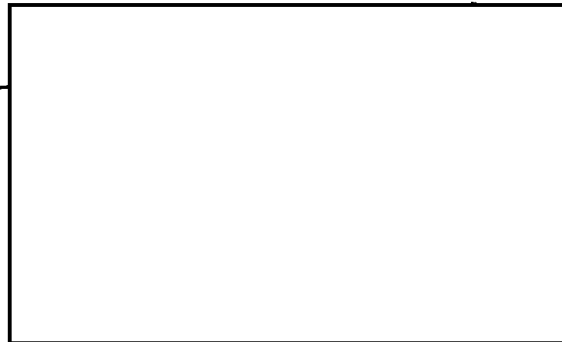

The Washington Field Office concluded, after a review of the above file, that it contained the name of STEPHENS' Minutemen group together with his mailing list, contributors, right wing contacts, and legitimate business contacts.

The name card file included the following: Doctor REVILO P. OLIVER, 701 Ohio Street, Urbana, Illinois 61801.

2. On February 4, 1974, the Springfield Division files were reviewed and correlation revealed the following:

a. REVILO OLIVER, described as a white male, born July 7, 1910, at Corpus Christi, Texas, resided at 701 West Ohio, Urbana, occupation-Professor of Classics, UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS (UI).

In April, 1964, OLIVER was a victim of extortion due to several articles published in the national monthly magazine of the John Birch Society. These articles had caused a nationwide storm of protest and OLIVER was denounced publicly by many responsible people.

b. In February, 1958, (SI T-2), a ^{Confidential} source of the Springfield Division of the FBI in Urbana, advised he had attended a meeting of a group calling themselves "The Cantonians" and in source's words this was an "against" group which Doctor REVILO PENDLETON OLIVER addressed.

c. In February, 1961, (SI T-3, *omit*) a self-styled anti-Communist, advised the FBI that Doctor OLIVER and his wife are extremists and literature distributed by them was not factual, but filled with their own personal opinions on the dangers of Communism.

d. In January, 1966, a source who is not further identified but who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised Doctor OLIVER was one of the many speakers at the 11th annual leadership conference of the Citizens Councils of America, Incorporated, held at Chattanooga, Tennessee.

e. In May, 1970, Doctor OLIVER's name appeared on a mailing list compiled by [redacted] of the Minutemen in the State of Michigan, and [redacted] of the Loyal American Association, a former Minutemen front group. *b6 b7C*

3. On May 21, 1974, (SI T-4, *omit*) a confidential source advised that he has known Doctor OLIVER for a number of years and has spoken to him on a number of occasions; however, he has not had any personal contacts with him in the past two years.

Source advised that Doctor OLIVER, as well as [redacted] were both very much anti-Communists and that approximately ten years ago, he wrote some articles for some national magazine for the John Birch Society. Source advised Doctor OLIVER is a brilliant individual and knows a number of well-known people all over the country, to include WILLIAM BUCKLEY, the columnist, who is a close personal friend of his. The source advised that Doctor OLIVER has never openly been involved in any right wing organizations, such as Minutemen, and if his name is connected to any right wing organization, his interest would lie solely in the theoretic aspect of the organization. *b6 b7C*

Source further advised that Doctor OLIVER is not a violent individual and he has never known Doctor OLIVER to have ever advocated the use of violence, nor does he believe Doctor OLIVER would ever engage in any violent activity. Source advised Doctor OLIVER is still employed as a professor of Classics at the UI in Urbana, and continues to reside at 701 Ohio Street, Urbana.

4. On June 26, 1974, an anonymous caller contacted the Washington Field Office of the FBI, and advised that a meeting of the East Coast right wing people was to be held in southern Maryland on June 29, 1974, or July 6, 1974. The caller stated that among those attending was REVILO OLIVER. OLIVER has been a member of the "Advisory Board" of the National Youth Alliance (NYA) and currently is an NYA subscriber and supporter. The anonymous caller had no details regarding proposed meeting and refused to identify himself/herself.

DOCTOR REVILO PENDLETON OLIVER

Further investigation by the FBI developed no information that Doctor OLIVER ever attended the above mentioned meeting.

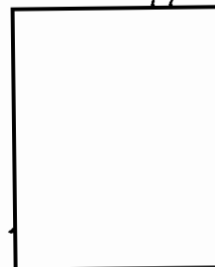

AUSTIN JOSEPH APP is a United States citizen of German extraction. In 1975, he received the "European Peace Prize of the German National Newspaper (DNZ)." An article he wrote entitled, "A Fair Deal for Germany," appeared in the April 1, 1949 edition of "COMMON SENSE," and in the November, 1949 issue of "THE MALIST." He authored an article entitled, "Food, Clothes and Homes in Germany, 1949" after returning from a three-month tour of Germany, Austria and Italy. APP spoke at the KELPING HAUS OF PHILADELPHIA in October, 1949, his topic being, "The Expeller Problem as a Challenge to Catholicism."

(U) Investigation conducted in 1945 disclosed that APP was described by fellow professors as an extreme idealist, pacifist and altruist. He was described as pro-German, but not pro-Nazi. Prior to World War II, he was described as a non-interventionist and extremely critical of United States foreign policy. ~~SECRET~~

No further information has been developed concerning APP since 1949. His last known residence is Takoma Park, Maryland and he is lastly known to have been a Professor at LA SALLE COLLEGE, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

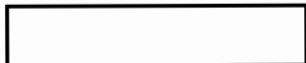

Several references were located for one Lieutenant Colonel Gordon "Jack" Mohr (U.S. Army-Retired), who may be identical to your subject. References reveal that Mohr has spoken in the past under the sponsorship of the John Birch Society. In March, 1969, he was a speaker at a TRAIN (To Restore American Independence Now) meeting. In September, 1970, he spoke at a Motorede (Movement to Restore Decency Committee) meeting, advocating the John Birch Society and the Christian Crusade to oppose the Communist movement in the United States. A pamphlet entitled "Our Families - Under Attack," authored by Mohr, Rt. 4, Box 213, Hot Springs, Arkansas 71901, described Mohr as follows: "Lt. Col. Mohr was one of the most highly decorated men to come out of the Korean War; he was a prisoner of the Communists, was tortured, stood before a People's Court, was "brain washed" and faced a firing squad. In 1953, he worked with American servicemen returning from the Communist prison camps of North Korea and Manchuria. As a result of his extensive background with Communism, he wrote the lesson plans for instruction in the Code of Conduct, given to army personnel. He is an outspoken lecturer against Communism, having spoken in many areas of the United States and is on the National Roster of the American Opinion Speaker's Bureau."

Larson had been the owner and operator of Larson's Paint and Wallpaper Store, 5690 West Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan, circa July, 1935. In 1933, Larson was

described as an organizer of the Proletarian Party of America, 664 Charlotte, Detroit, Michigan. From 1930-33, lectures were held locally by the Proletarian Party. Larson conducted a class on "Proletarian Philosophy." The average attendance was forty. In 1942, Larson was the chairman of The Labor Institute Detroit Open Forum, 2705 Joy Road, Detroit, Michigan. In October 1974, Dr. Martin A. Larson, author of "Tax Revolt, USA!" was scheduled to appear at the Midwest National Tax and Posse Comitatus Convention, held at the Red Carpet Inn Expo Building, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. In March, 1944, a criminal records check of the Detroit Police Department regarding Larson revealed the following: 7/22/33: Fugitive non-support (of [redacted]), Dismissed; and 2/1/41: Violation of Liquor Control Act, Dismissed. b6 b7C

No record could be located for Percy Al Greaves, Jr. One reference was located regarding one Percy L. Greaves, Jr., who may be identical to your subject. In September, 1952, Greaves resigned as Co-Chairman of the Constitutional Party, whose headquarters at that time was the Hotel Russell, Park Avenue and 37th Street, New York, New York. Descriptive data appeared as follows: Percy L. Greaves, also known as Percy L. Greaves, Jr., 49 years (in 1954), 3409 Turner Street, Chevy Chase, Maryland, employed as a writer of the economic column of the "Christian Economics" Magazine, 26 West 58th Street, New York, New York. b6 b7C

A reference was located for one [redacted] in advertisements and literature submitted by United States Senator Jeremiah Denton in May, 1983. This literature revealed that Video Buff/Samisdat Publishers, P.O. Box 11132-0132, Station E, Buffalo, New York 14211 was offering a video cassette entitled "The Anne Frank Diary Hoax," featuring Ernest Zundel, Ditlieb Felderer, and Eric Thomson.
