88 HUNDRED VOTES FOR NATIONAL SOCIALISM!

Party candidate Richard Johanson captured 8,792 votes — just eight short of 8,800 — in the 2 November race for the San Francisco Board of Education. This is the *highest number* of votes ever garnered by a Party candidate. This figure represents approximately 5.3% of the total number of votes, or about 10% of the White vote, as the city's population is half non-White. In addition, Comrade Johanson beat three Communist candidates and won a clear *majority* of votes in one White precinct!

One significant aspect of the campaign was the small amount of money spent on it — well under \$1,000. This is a mere pittance when compared with the tens of thousands spent by each of the professional and incumbent politicians in the race. Yet the Party was able to make much more effective use of each campaign dollar than the other candidates. On a cost-per-vote ratio, we spent less than 10¢ for every vote gained. By comparison, Jimmy Carter spent 80¢ per vote to win this year's presidential election!

The significance of the Johanson vote is all the more amazing when it is noted that his entire campaign consisted almost entirely of a few speaking appearances before small local audiences and the distribution of 35,000 leaflets. Since Johanson received the votes of nearly 9,000 people, that means that *one out of every four persons* who read our leaflets voted for the National Socialist candidate. Very few commercial advertisers can boast similar results, and it is doubtful that any of the other 16 candidates in the race could make the same claim about the effectiveness of their popular appeal.

The campaign was not without its exciting moments. There were several tense situations between Comrade Johanson and enraged Jews, Blacks and Communists at public candidate forums. Johanson, who had the distinction of being the only pro-White candidate of the lot, drew as much hateful reaction from the assorted anti-White scum as he got sympathetic reactions from conservative White parents. The Communist Labor Party candidate in particular, who ran with the campaign slogan “Ban the Nazi Party,” made several attempts to prevent Johanson from speaking and to thwart the NSWPP campaign generally. (See clipping, next page.) Also, several Northern California activists repelled an attack by a gang of Jews while distributing campaign leaflets in the Fisherman's Wharf area.

The election race will have many lasting benefits for the San Francisco Bay Unit and the NSWPP as a whole. As a result of the campaign, the Party is receiving new support and interest from the area. In addition, Comrade Johanson and other unit members have gained experience in election campaigning, which will be of invaluable benefit in future contests.

The results of this latest election campaign are similar to others entered by the Party in this past year. We are consistently winning between 5% and 7% of the vote wherever we run in the country. (Compare that to the showing by American Independent Party presidential candidate, Lester Maddox, who got only 6,866 votes in San Francisco or to the Communist Party presidential candidate, who got only about 7,000 votes in the whole state of Illinois — See clipping, next page.) This proves that the appeal of National Socialism is not a temporary, sporadic or localized phenomenon, but represents a very definite, fixed — and considerable — undercurrent within the American body politic today. Projecting these percentages nationwide, this means that between 10 and 20 million White Americans would be prepared to vote for an NSWPP candidate right now!

All comrades who participated in the campaign or who gave their assistance by supporting the Party are to be thanked and congratulated for a job well done.

Illinois vote for Hall, Tyner shows 71% increase over 1972

CHICAGO, Nov. 17—Incomplete returns from counties with about 75 percent of the votes in Illinois show that Gus Hall and Jarvis Tyner, Communist candidates for President and Vice President increased their votes by 71 percent over 1972 and that Ishmael Flory, Communist candidate for governor, increased his vote by 95 percent.

Returns from Cook County, including Chicago, and from 17 populous downstate counties give Hall and Tyner 7,123 votes, compared to 4,159 in the same areas four years ago.

Party Units Across Country Demonstrate Solidarity With German Comrades

On 16 October 1976 — the 30th anniversary of the postwar lynchings of National Socialists at Nuremberg — Party units across the country held demonstrations to show solidarity with our German comrades, who continue to be persecuted by a repressive Bonn regime to this day. Below are the reports from the various units:

Washington — The activity began as Commander Koehl led a party delegation to the West German embassy where a letter of protest was delivered to a shocked representative of the Bonn government. Afterwards, the National Socialists picketed

nearby with signs reading "BONN DEMOCRACY A JOKE," "30 YEARS OF KANGAROO JUSTICE," and "THE LYNCHINGS HAVEN'T STOPPED." Leaflets condemning the persecution of National Socialists in the so-called Federal Republic, in both English and German, were distributed to embassy workers and interested passersby.

A special meeting followed the demonstration, at which an ST swear-in ceremony and a Martyrs ceremony took place.

Communist wants Nazi off ballot

Michael Miller, Communist Labor party candidate for the Board of Education, yesterday filed suit to omit another candidate's name from the ballot.

In a Superior Court complaint, Miller accused Richard Johanson, a Nazi candidate, of listing a "non-existent" address as his place of residence on nomination papers.

Miller's complaint said that Johanson's true residence is 917 Santa Fe Ave., Albany.

Presiding Superior Court Judge Henry Rolph scheduled a 9:30 a.m. Monday hearing on the matter.

Richard Johanson, 31, a salesman, is the candidate of the National Socialist White People's party, formerly known as the American Nazi party.

He is running for the board because he is "fed up with fiscal mismanagement in the school district" and because he wants to oppose "all interracial busing and transfer schemes."

Chicago — The day's activity began when Midwest Regional Leader Cedric Syrdahl and local Unit Leader John Logan delivered an open letter to the West German consulate in Chicago. Next a copy of the letter was delivered to an official of the German government-owned airline, Lufthansa, as a contingent of National Socialists held a protest vigil outside. The demonstrators carried signs with slogans similar to those used in the Washington activity, and handed out specially

designed leaflets to hundreds of interested passersby.

Detroit — Representatives of the probationary local unit went to the West German Consulate in Detroit to deliver a letter of protest against the inhumane treatment of German National Socialists.

San Francisco — Northern California activists held a public ceremony in front of the San Francisco Civic Center in which an honor roll of the martyr dead of Nuremberg was read.

The demonstration began with a solemn procession to the civic center by uniformed ST, who carried a Swastika banner and a wreath. At the site, the banner was raised and the wreath set in a stand and was flanked by the troopers. A short eulogy address was then delivered in honor of the 11 Martyrs of Nuremberg and the German National Socialists who have been killed or imprisoned since that dark day 30 years ago. Afterwards Party newspapers were passed out to the interested people who had gathered to watch.

\$7,500 Raised in First Month of Fall Building Campaign

As of 31 October, exactly \$7,496.36 has been raised in the Fall Building Campaign. Over two-thirds of the drive's goal of \$11,111 has been met in less than three weeks time! This fantastic response from National Socialists across the continent reaffirms the faith our people have in the Party and the important work it is doing. It proves what we can do when we all do our best and work together to build the National Socialist movement.

We have to raise only about \$3,600 by the end of December to meet the Fall Campaign goal. If the first month's results are repeated, we should have no trouble at all in succeeding in this drive. However, this can come about only if everyone makes a final effort to put us over the top.

Taking \$187 collected before the official start of the Campaign, and adding it with the October tally for the drive gives us a total of \$7,683.36 for the month — certainly a record of the Three-Year Plan. This brings the Plan's total to \$28,152.34, or 31% of the goal of \$88,888. However, at this point, with 42% of the allotted time passed, we should have raised \$37,000. So we are still behind schedule, although we are catching up at present.

Comrades from 32 states and four Canadian provinces gave donations to the Fall Building Campaign and the Three-Year Plan in October. Their initials and amount of contribution is listed on the next page. Everyone who took part in the effort can take pride in last month's achievement.

To accomplish this, personnel from other departments — as well as the Commander himself — have had to step in to prepare each issue, often neglecting important Party work in other areas. We have reached a point, however, where we can no longer afford to do this.

But do not despair! As a result of the success of the Three-Year Plan in recent weeks, National Headquarters is now in a position to hire a *professional* newspaper editor.
