FORWARD INTO THE 1980s!

Two-Year Plan Begins; Publications Changes Announced

With this issue of the NS BULLETIN we enter the 1980s. January also marks the official beginning of the Two-Year Plan, which will run from 1 January 1980 through 31 December 1981. We say “official beginning,” because the plan has already been implemented, either wholly or partially, in most areas of the country.

At the end of this period we can expect to find the Party a stronger and more viable revolutionary vehicle than it is today, in every respect. The Two-Year Plan brings with it not superficial, cosmetic changes but profound and far-reaching developments in our strategic and tactical focus, in the attitudes of individual comrades and in the tone of our propaganda.

As all Party comrades should be aware, the objective of the plan is to prepare the Party for the revolutionary times which lie ahead. Our primary method of doing this will consist of attracting idealists to our ranks, and then training them (along with existing Party cadres) in the necessary revolutionary skills. A secondary goal of the Party during the plan will be to dispell the false, grotesque Hollywood portrayal of National Socialism, which the Jews have so successfully used to defame our Movement in the eyes of our racial brothers and sisters.

One of the main ways in which we will put the Two-Year Plan into effect is through our publications and related printed matter. As we announced in NS BULLETIN 258, there will be significant changes in the content of Party publications, beginning with this issue of the NS BULLETIN.

- The NS BULLETIN will devote less space to reporting routine Party activities and reproducing news clippings, and give more space to internal Party matters. It will concentrate on noteworthy Party news, announcements, NS Publications updates and practical suggestions and instructions to activists and organizers on propaganda techniques, fund-raising, recruiting and so forth. By noteworthy Party news, we mean that which has a special impact on Party operations and Party members, as well as new and innovative activities that serve as examples for other comrades and units throughout the Party.
- WHITE POWER will be reduced to eight pages. The paper will be designed to serve as a recruiting tool, not just an NS version of the Daily Press. Articles will be written to appeal primarily to those who are not already National Socialists. There will be no regular NS Publications page. There will be increased coverage of Party and WUNS activities.
- The new WUNS journal, in magazine format, will be concerned primarily in providing political and ideological instruction for those who are already National Socialists, in particular Party cadres. The first issue of this journal is presently in production.
- In place of the present NS Publications pages in the Party paper, there will be an NS Publications catalogue, issued yearly. Special items and new products will continue to be advertised in the paper and bulletin. The 1980 catalogue will be released sometime this winter.

There may be further changes as the Two-Year Plan progresses. The Party’s editorial department, in addition to producing these four publications, is readying a new line of leaflets and Swastika stickers, which should also be available shortly. Also, a home study course in National Socialism will be made available to those comrades who qualify for it next Fall or Winter. Lastly, several booklets and books are being produced by the Party which will also be released during the course of the plan.

It is clear that National Headquarters has its work cut out for itself. In order for the plan to be successful, however, it will take more than just long hours in Arlington. *The enthusiastic cooperation of every Party comrade is needed if the goals and objectives set down by the Commander for the Two-Year Plan are to be achieved.*

The Commander and the National Headquarters staff will do their part. The rest is up to YOU.

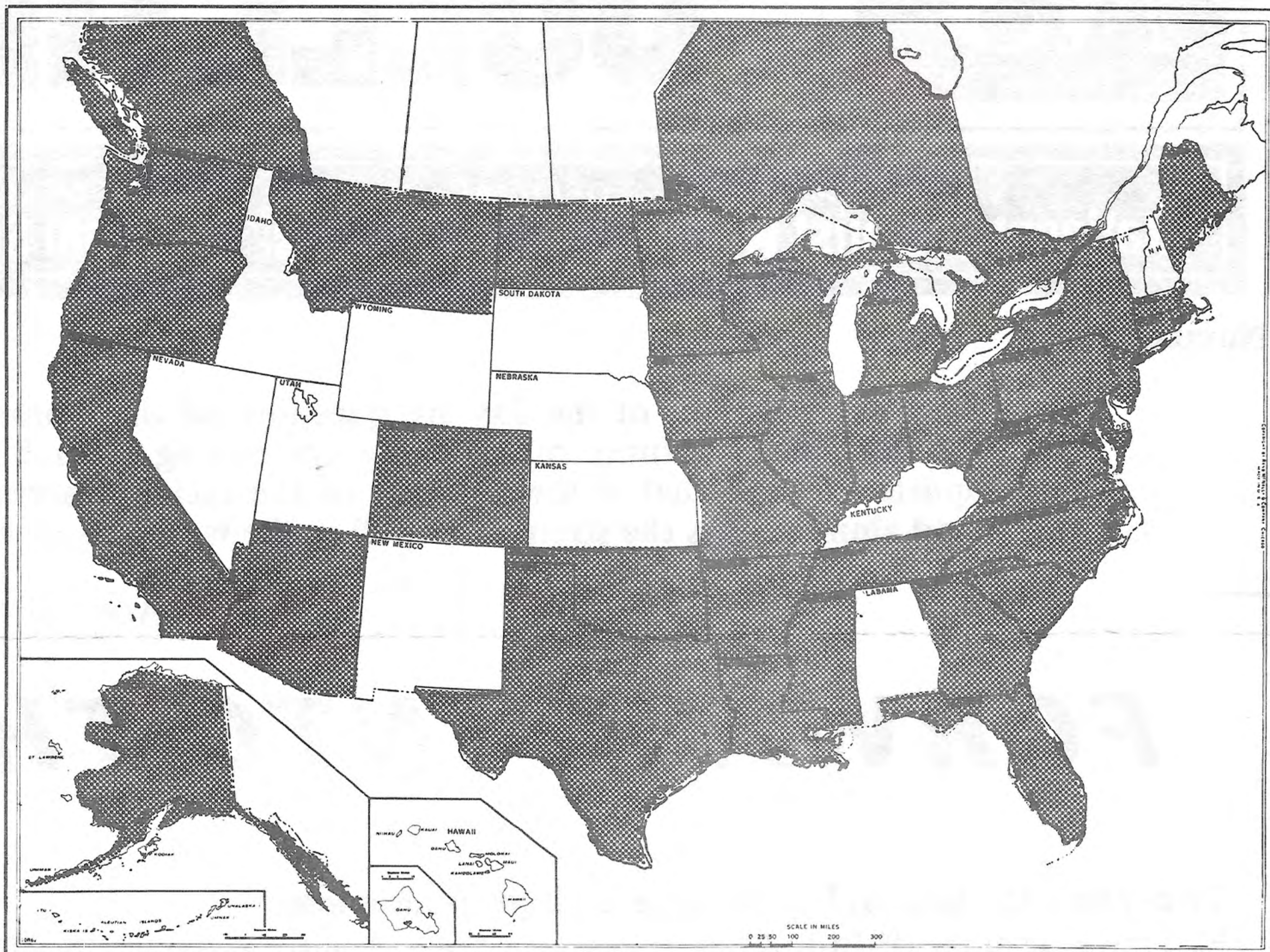
'A Vote of Confidence'

Fall Building Campaign Exceeds Goal!

National Headquarters is pleased to announce that the 1979 Fall Building Campaign is an unqualified success. The goal of the campaign was to raise \$10,000 above and beyond the Party's regular income between 1 November and 31 December. As of 31 December, that goal had not only been reached, but had been exceeded by more than 10 percent—and contributions were continuing to arrive past the official deadline.

Some \$6,369.55 was raised by the campaign during the month of December. Added to the November total, the amount raised in the campaign as of its deadline was \$11,011.12.

Comrades in 36 states, the District of Columbia, two Canadian provinces and two foreign countries gave to the campaign. In a show of solidarity with the Commander, all of the full-time staff members at National Headquarters and the Midwest Regional Headquarters donated one day's pay to the effort. Many other comrades throughout the country responded to the Commander's plea to give a day's pay, and some gave substantially more.



Although the Fall Building Campaign was not part of the Two-Year Plan, the success of the campaign and the plan were linked. Without the money raised under the FBC, many of the special projects and improvements scheduled to take place as part of the Two-Year Plan would not be possible.

In Arlington, Commander Koehl hailed the success of the campaign as "a vote of confidence" in the Two-Year Plan.

"At first we were uncertain as to how the rank and file membership and support of the Party would react to the Two-Year Plan," noted National Organizer and Two-Year Plan Coordinator Martin Kerr. "The plan involves some radical changes in the Party's focus and method of operation. Frankly, we weren't too sure that it would meet with the enthusiastic approval of the Party as a whole. Nevertheless, the Commander was determined to go ahead with the plan anyway, as he felt that it was vitally necessary for the success of the Party in the coming decade.

"As it turned out, our worries were unfounded. The successful completion of the 1979 Fall Building Campaign shows that the Party supports the Commander and the changes that will occur as part of the Two-Year Plan," Comrade Kerr concluded.

Party Responds Enthusiastically to Two-Year Plan

As was indicated by the generous donations received for the Fall Building Campaign, the overwhelming majority of the Party has reacted enthusiastically to the Two-Year Plan. The following are typical of the letters National Headquarters has received in response to the announcement of the Two-Year Plan:

Enclosed with this letter you will find my donation of \$25 towards the 1979 Fall Building Campaign. With great interest I read the Commander's letter which outlined the future development of the Party. I fully agree with what was said in that letter. In fact, I was greatly pleased that the Party is shedding some old tendencies of the past few years. Now we are going to see a unified effort to organize into a real revolutionary party, reaffirming our dedication to the principles of discipline and idealism in the National Socialist movement. I feel now, that with the program the Commander outlines in his letters, we will be able to reach more White Americans.

Not only has the Two-Year Plan won the support of present Party members and supporters, but it has already begun to attract the higher caliber of person which the Party is seeking. Here is a letter from a married couple in Arizona:

Upon receiving our November issue of *The Liberty Bell*, we discovered that George Dietz [the publisher] had enclosed your special edition of the NS BULLETIN, dated Sept. 15, 1979, along with it. My husband and I had never seen your bulletin before

and became very interested in what you had to say.

Until now we have shunned all White Power groups because of the reasons stated in your bulletin . . . Your new focus of propaganda on *positive* pro-Aryan ideals—what Aryans should be for, not against—makes your organization more idealistic . . . We would like more information on your organization and publications.

Of course the process of upgrading the overall quality of Party membership and supportership goes both ways. Not only are we trying to recruit new, better comrades into our ranks, but at the same time we are trying to discourage unsuitable types from affiliating with us. In connection with this, several persons who have proven by their past words and actions to be of marginal mental and emotional stability have been dropped as Official Supporters. Additionally, a small number of individuals who found the new direction of the Party unsuitable to their personalities have "purged" themselves by resigning.

Thus we can see that the plan is already beginning to have its desired effect. We are attracting those whom we desire, and making sure that those whom we do not desire do not act as a brake on the Movement's progress.

Introductory Brochure Available for Mass Distribution

The full-color introductory brochure on the Party ("An Introduction to the National Socialist White People's Party") is now available for distribution from NS Publications. As its title indicates, the brochure is designed to introduce people to the Party who have had no contact with us before. The brochure describes the Party's history and method of operation, lists an abbreviated version of the new 12-point program and answers some of the most commonly asked questions about the NSWPP.

Here is the reaction of one longtime Party fighter to the brochure:

I want to congratulate the Party's editorial department on the excellent job done on the introductory brochure. With its completion and distribution, the Party has moved into a more professional realm of technological achievement. You have done a great job, equal to or surpassing that of large advertising agencies.

This brochure needs to get into the hands of the right people. It would be better to send them this than even a copy of WHITE POWER. The potential is tremendous . . . There are hundreds of places where something of this nature can be left where other people of a like mind might find it: libraries, book stores, barber shops, people you meet on the street, etc. This brochure *needs* not to be wasted. We must get it into the hands of our people!

TWO-YEAR PLAN NOTES

PUBLIC ACTIVITIES

As was noted in last month's NS BULLETIN, the Commander has indicated that home study of the National Socialist world view, community service and public activities are the three things that local units and unit members should be concerned with during the Two-Year Plan. Having discussed home study and community service in the last two NS BULLETINS we will now take a look at public activities.

One of the reasons why the Party has been growing at such a slow rate in the past several years has been the failure to develop new and more effective types of public activities. Far too often, local units and individual comrades have stuck to old Phase I forms of activity, which have proven to be ineffective at best, and at worst have hurt the Movement.

Tiny uniformed pickets of Communist bookstores and porno shops and White Power rallies in which the audience is made up largely of Jews and Reds are two such forms of activity which are counterproductive. Overall, such activities do not strengthen the Party, do not bring in new recruits and do not make White people more sympathetic towards National Socialism. Rather, they dissipate our slim resources, scare many potential adherents of the Movement away and confuse the masses as to what the Party is really all about.

Such activities are only beneficial insofar as they attract news media coverage. This, of course, was the overriding goal of Phase I, when these activities were first employed by the Party. But we are no longer in Phase I, and our progress and success at this point is not measured by how many column inches we receive in the newspapers or how many seconds of coverage we get on the evening news—most of which is bound to be grossly distorted, anyway.

The goal of Phase II—and the Two-Year Plan—is to recruit a hard core of racial idealists and train them to be revolutionary leaders. Activities which recruit such individuals are the type of activity which is needed during the Two-Year Plan.

Such activities will in all likelihood not be as glamorous or exciting as the old Phase I activities, especially for those comrades who are particularly interested in getting their name and picture in the paper. Recruiting racial idealists—a tiny fraction of the shrinking White population—will be a slow, hard, boring job. Success will not come easily. Selling WHITE POWER on lonely street corners, leafleting at factories, libraries and schools, putting up posters, talking endlessly to White people who show an interest in the Party (many of whom will turn out to be turkeys or cowards)—these are just some of the mundane activities which we will have to concern ourselves with increasingly during the Two-Year Plan.

Another activity we might suggest is holding informal private gatherings in the home of a Party comrade or sympathetic White person to acquaint those interested in the Movement with the Party. Almost everyone knows a friend, neighbor, relative or co-worker who would be interested in hearing what the Party has to say in a relaxed, low-key, informal setting.

It should also be noted that *certain types* of demonstrations are worthwhile. Demonstrations on pertinent issues with *large numbers* of uniformed ST personnel (which present a *force image*) can be extremely effective, as can demonstrations out of uniform.

In the past, the Party has generally refused to take part in demonstrations with other racist organizations. As part of the Two-Year Plan, we have reversed this past policy and now

encourage local units to do this, provided 1) That the Party receives full credit for its participation and 2) The Party retains its organizational integrity (that is, that Party personnel don't end up taking orders from someone in some other group). Also implicit in this procedure is that the theme of any such demonstration be in keeping with Party policy.

Lastly, we encourage local units and individual comrades to take part in mass demonstrations organized by right-wing and non-Communist left-wing groups, when such demonstrations coincide with Party policy. Examples of this would be participating in anti-nuclear, pro-environment demonstrations or demonstrations protesting U.S. military intervention in Iran or the reinstatement of the draft. This is an *excellent* way to seek out those who have an idealistic outlook on life, as this type of person is the type who participates in these demonstrations. Comrades joining such mass demonstrations should wear civilian clothes (of course), have their own signs (reflecting Party policy), and bring any appropriate Party literature to distribute.

In the past the Party has made an appearance at mass demonstrations in a confrontational way so as to get publicity. We have stood outside of them and protested, stressing the differences between these right and left wing organizations and the Party. Now we want to get *inside* these demonstrations in order to make contact with and recruit the most idealistic and racially conscious elements present within them.

Most of the preceding activities apply primarily to organized Party units, although some (such as distributing literature) can be undertaken by individual comrades. The most important thing that an individual National Socialist, acting on his (or her) own can do, however, is simply to be a walking, talking advertisement for National Socialism. By making oneself a respected and admired member of the community, and letting it be known that one is a National Socialist, one becomes the best possible recruiting agent. (And let us hasten to add that we mean respected by *our White racial brothers and sisters*—not by the System, its stooges or its newsmedia.)

National Socialists should not let themselves become isolated, but should be part of the society in which they live, as sick as it is. That is the only way we will be able to come in contact on an effective personal level with those whom we are seeking. Joining non-political groups such as the Sierra Club, for example, is one way to meet those who have become fed up with the plastic, artificial, rip-off society that has infected the North American continent.

If we depend on the newsmedia to do our advertising for us—as we have in the past much too much—we will *never* attract the high caliber individuals we wish to, because the newsmedia is interested only in presenting such a grossly distorted caricature of National Socialism and this Party that few decent people (although many mental defectives) will be attracted to it.

The above is only a rough sketch or outline of types of public activities we wish to see as part of the Two-Year Plan. National Headquarters will inform local units and activists of specific activities to undertake in the future. Local units and activists themselves, however, must develop new types of activities suited to their respective locales, within the framework of the guidelines listed here. Ultimately, the success or failure of the Two-Year Plan in any area depends on how it is implemented by the Party comrades there.

ACTIVITIES IN BRIEF

● Commander Koehl and National Headquarters staff members were joined by other East Coast comrades on 22 and 23 December for the NHQ annual Rudolf Hess vigil. The National Socialists stood watch beside a giant picture of Comrade Hess across from the White House for 12 hours each day. Over 1,000 Freedom for Rudolf Hess leaflets were distributed to passersby, and thousands more individuals saw the vigil.

● Three Chicago ST men were arrested on 1 December when a fight broke out between a group of National Socialists selling WHITE POWER and two members of the Revolutionary Communist Party. Although the Reds started the fight neither of them were arrested. Both suffered "facial cuts and bruises" according to the police. The arrested ST men were GL Steven Martinson, TL Robert Bukowy and PT Robert Knepple. The three were immediately released on bail posted by other National Socialists. Those wishing to contribute to their defense fund may do so by writing to the Midwest Regional Headquarters in Cicero.

● Uniformed and non-uniformed literature distributions were reported during December in Arlington, Cleveland, Indianapolis, Milwaukee, New Hampshire, New Jersey and Northern California.

● Comrade Dale Enders was appointed Acting Unit Leader for Milwaukee Unit I in December. Comrade Enders takes the place of Comrade Tony Schmitt, who has been granted a leave of absence for personal reasons.

● The Party gave financial assistance to several pro-National Socialist victims of persecution and oppression by the Zionist-dominated System during December. Among those who received such assistance were two of the families of the Greensboro defendants. (See NS BULLETIN No. 261 for details.)

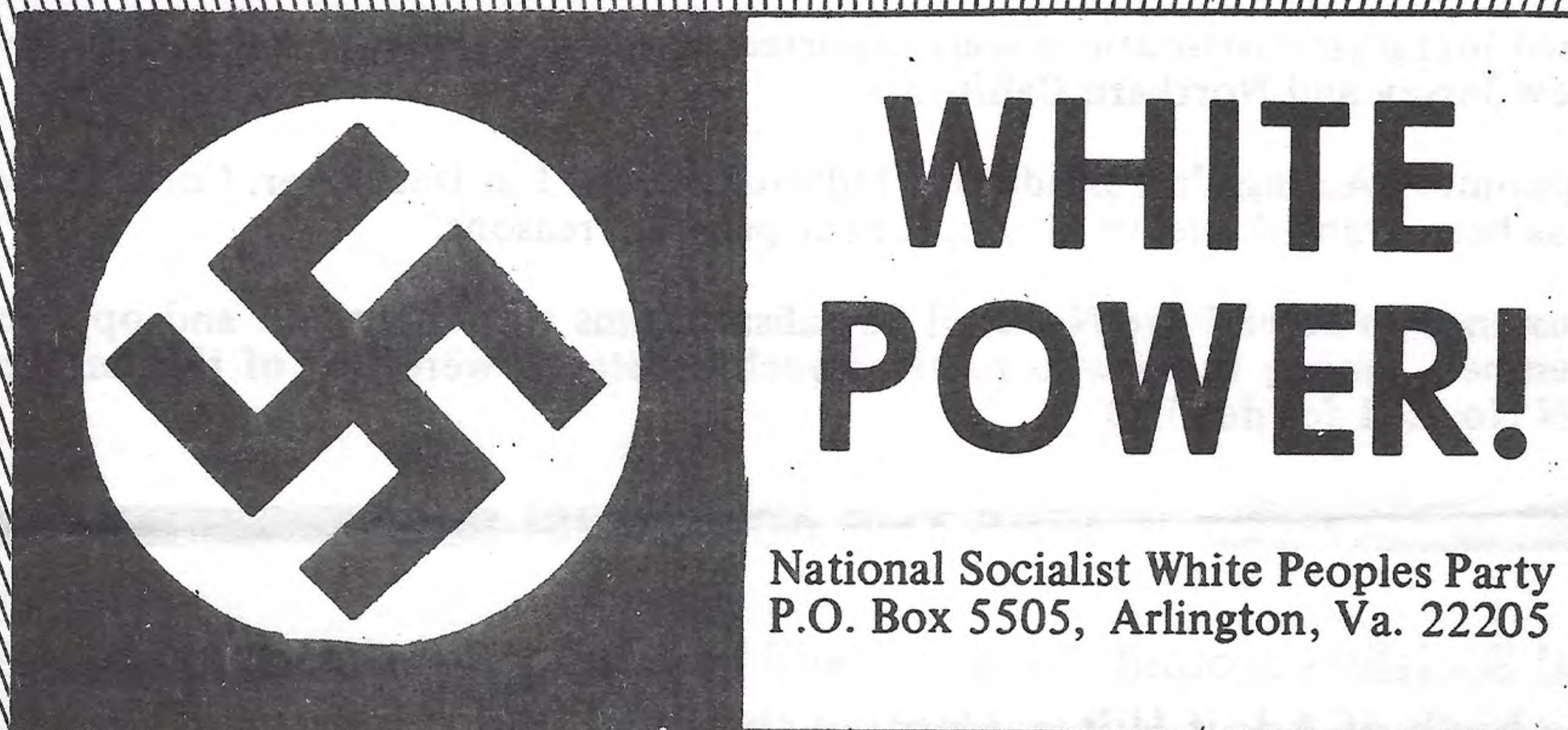
