EDITORIAL

At one time, WUNS counted more than two dozen Affiliates around the world. Some of these Affiliates were very small, consisting of only a handful of members; others were fairly promising organizations. Most of them, however, experienced such vicissitudes during the past few years that they are hardly recognizable as their former selves. Some disappeared altogether, and entirely new groups sprang up in their places. Others splintered into various squabbling factions, underwent repeated changes in leadership, and dwindled in size. A few—very few—have continued to grow in numbers and capability.

Such vicissitudes are endemic in revolutionary organizations. Until an organization has reached a certain size, recruited a certain minimum number of capable and dedicated functionaries, survived enough hard knocks to have acquired a certain store of essential experience and wisdom, established a source of more-or-less steady revenue to pay recurring expenses, and devised the proper organizational structure to insure viability and growth, it remains a very uncertain and unstable thing. For every organization that manages to reach this critical threshold for survival, probably fifty others fail.

This Darwinian situation certainly has its merits, in that it allows the survival of only the toughest and best-led groups—just those, in fact, best suited for carrying on the National Socialist struggle on a large scale. But, the way things are presently arranged, it also has one fatal drawback: it uses up scarce human material at a rate we can hardly afford. When a local National Socialist organization falls apart, whether due primarily to external pressure or internal weakness, it generally is a rather traumatic experience for the individual members concerned. Many become discouraged or disillusioned, adopt defeatist attitudes or lose their faith.

Nearly always there is no other local National Socialist group to which they can turn. Consequently, they may be permanently lost to the Movement. When this phenomenon recurs over and over again, in country after country, dissipating invaluable human resources each time, it must be regarded as an extremely serious impediment to the growth of the Movement—an impediment which must be removed or circumvented.

An essential step in this direction is to focus the interest and loyalty of the best National Socialists, wherever they may be, on the *one* National Socialist movement in this world. They must be able to draw strength and inspiration from their union with Adolf Hitler's single and enduring creation. Then, when a local organization collapses, all is not lost. It can be considered only a temporary setback, so long as the Movement, as a whole, continues to live and grow.

National Socialists who feel themselves bound first of all to the Movement itself can more easily survive the vicissitudes of local organizations, lending their experience to new efforts when earlier ones fail. Thus, the growth of the Movement will not be so subject to the ups and downs of individual groups. As long as the resources of good human material at the disposal of the Movement continue to increase, progress is being made.

It has been the foregoing consideration, primarily, which has led to the institution of the present WUNS policy of seeking Associate Members among individual National Socialists around the world, whether they are already members of a WUNS Affiliate or not. This new policy breaks with previous policy. In particular, it is contrary to Item 10 of the tentative "Cotswold Agreements" of 1962. Item 10, of course, is not the only part of this early set of proposals which necessity has forced us to modify during the past seven years. But it is the most important part, in that its modification brings a critical issue to the surface, where it must be faced squarely: namely, the conflict between parochial state-nationalism and Aryan racial nationalism.

So that there can be no possibility for anyone to misunderstand the WUNS position on this matter, we repeat here what has already been stated several times earlier, particularly in Commander Koehl's article in *National Socialist World*, No. 6: The only nation to which we, as National Socialists, owe allegiance in the final analysis is our Aryan racial nation; our only true nationalism is Aryan racialism. Whenever a conflict arises between the interests of the State in which we hold citizenship and the interests of Aryandom, we must take our stand with our race and against the State. Thus, we stand firmly opposed not only to race-destroying Jewish internationalism (which is really *inter-racialism*) and cosmopolitanism, but also to parochial state-nationalism. The latter has, in its own way, done our people at least as much harm as the former.

It should also be understood that this rejection of political parochialism by no means poses a threat to local cultural traditions or implies any sort of general "leveling" scheme. We have no intention whatever of asking Bavarians to give up their beer and *lederhosen* or Englishmen to do without their tea and umbrellas, to give a couple of slightly facetious examples. But a diversity in local traditions, or even in language, must not

be used as an excuse for a splintering of the Movement into dozens of politically autonomous "national" socialist parties. There is, and there must remain, only *one* National Socialist movement on this earth, and all those who belong to this Movement must always remember that they are bound together by a bond of racial kinship and by their common devotion to Adolf Hitler's mighty Idea, and not primarily by local tradition or language or state-citizenship.

This aspect of our doctrine separates us sharply from all the groups of the patriotic right wing, which may be a bit unnerving to those of us who have spent much of our political lives with these groups. Adolf Hitler's creation, however, is not just a variation on an old theme, but is something totally new under the sun. And the man who would be a National Socialist must have the courage to throw aside all the old, comfortable props and familiar conceptions and accept the uniqueness of the National Socialist idea with all its implications.

It may be worthwhile pointing out once again that which has already been said in an earlier *Bulletin*: A local program, aimed at mobilizing the general public on some issue, may very well be designed to appeal to parochial sentiments. The same is true of the programs of "front" organizations. But at no place in the world is the Movement strong enough—yet—so that it can afford to concentrate its efforts on mass activities of this sort. Instead, the effort must be on proselytizing and recruiting National Socialists into the Movement. And the way to do that is with a National Socialist program—and nothing less.

Before, we could often be accused of hedging on this issue, of sometimes failing to be completely blunt and forthright, for the sake of protecting the sensibilities of those who could not quite make the break with older conceptions and wholeheartedly accept the new. Any misunderstandings which may have arisen are hopefully cleared up now.

Once again, then, we call for National Socialists everywhere to take a decisive step in this new direction and establish a direct affiliation with the World Union of National Socialists. Within the near future, we would like to have at least the top leadership personnel from all local National Socialist groups registered as WUNS Associate Members. When this has been accomplished, we can look forward to an increasing participation in WUNS affairs by National Socialists from every part of the world.

HEADQUARTERS

Annual dues for Associate Members of WUNS have been reduced to \$10 (DM 40; £4). Those who have already paid the earlier fee of \$20 will be credited for a two-year period. This reduction was made possible through increased operating efficiency at WUNS HQ, which in turn was the result of the acquisition of several pieces of automatic mail-handling machinery by the National Socialist White People's Party, with whom WUNS shares facilities. Persons who have not yet submitted an application form for Associate Membership are urged to do so now.

BRITAIN

The National Socialist Group has announced the imminent appearance of a new National Socialist periodical, to be called *Phoenix*. The first issue is now at their printer's shop and should be ready shortly.

CANADA

The Canadian National Socialist Party has reported success in its new program of indoor meetings, which are open to the public. Several such meetings held recently in the Toronto area brought a number of new persons into contact with the CNSP.

During one public demonstration in Toronto, on April 20, John Beattie, National Leader of the CNSP, was attacked by a Jewish gang. He was struck on the head with a pair of binoculars by one of his attackers and knocked unconscious. Although several stitches were required to close his wound, Mr. Beattie was back at work within a few hours.

Meanwhile, the Canadian Jewish Congress has succeeded in applying sufficient political pressure to Canadian authorities to have the CNSP's Toronto-area telephone message service temporarily suppressed.

GERMANY

The Occupation Government of Kurt Kiesinger has outlawed the Bund Deutscher National-Sozialisten, arrested and charged several of its leaders, searched their homes, and seized all BDNS and WUNS material in their possession.


The ban was issued by the government on April 30th, and the arrests, searches, and seizures took place during the following weeks, in a campaign of terror and repression designed to crush the last remnants of the National Socialist spirit in Germany. Although those arrested are now facing possible prison terms, their spirits are by no means crushed. Their work will continue with undiminished intensity, even though they are once again forced underground. Neither provocateurs nor repression can halt the resurgence of the Leader's great Idea, in Germany or elsewhere.

No further mail should be sent to the former BDNS address in Hamburg, as all letters there are being intercepted by the political police and returned to the senders.

On the next page is one of the newsletters published by the BDNS before April 30. Note the blank circles—*sans* Swastikas—on the logo. The Swastika is a prohibited symbol in Germany under the democrats.

UNITED STATES

The National Socialist White People's Party has continued to vigorously pursue its Phase Two objectives during the second quarter of 1969. Activism has played an increasingly greater role during this period, with efforts concentrated primarily on the distribution of National Socialist propaganda materials. In the drive to reach an ever-larger audience, air-

craft have been used to distribute Party leaflets over major U.S. cities. This increased activism has resulted in several clashes with the authorities, who, for example, have suppressed the Party's White Power Message telephone service in Los Angeles and Chicago. Although the Los Angeles message service is back on the air now, the ban is still in effect in Chicago.

The Party is already looking forward to a major National Socialist event planned for later this year: National Leader Koehl has announced a North American Congress of U.S. and Canadian National Socialists, to be held in Washington from August 30 through September 1. WUNS Associate Members from Europe and elsewhere are cordially invited to attend as observers. This Congress, the first ever held in North America, will serve to mark the 50th anniversary of our Movement.

MISCELLANY

In Italy, the Union of Italian Jewish Communities has instituted court proceedings against a Roman publishing house, The Sentinel of Italy, which has just issued a new Italian edition of *Mein Kampf*. The Jews are attempting to have the book suppressed on the grounds that it is "an incitement to genocide." They are particularly unhappy about the book's foreword, which refers to the Jewish role in World War II and Jewish atrocities against the Arabs in Palestine.
