New National Headquarters Opened

The new National Headquarters of the Party in Arlington was officially opened on Memorial Day, 30 May 1968. Eighty-six Party members and supporters from 17 states and the District of Columbia were on hand for the opening, including some from as far away as California and Florida.

Everyone was thoroughly impressed by the visible evidence of Party progress and success reflected in the securing of this headquarters facility. Having achieved this goal, National Leader Matt Koehl announced that the Party was ready to tackle a second priority, to be disclosed shortly.

During the day, appropriate National Socialist march music was played and refreshments were served. In the evening the film, "Raise the Banner," produced by the California Division of the Party, was shown.

Obtaining the new headquarters confirms the correctness of the National Leader's decision last fall to place the strengthening of the movement's center in Arlington over all other considerations. At a time when some were wavering in their National Socialist faith, the National Leader-against certain temporizing suggestions-recognized the supreme importance of solidly reinforcing the Party's central core in Arlington by all means as an unshakable bastion of hope, faith and confidence amid all the storms of doubt and despair in the aftermath of Commander Rockwell's assassination.

There were those, for example, who anxiously insisted that the Party abandon Arlington, failing to recognize the disastrous panic which such a move would have tended to cause--not to mention the enormous, almost mystic, geopolitical significance of this particular location. For it was here, and nowhere else, that the greatest event since 1945 took place: the raising of the Swastika banner by Commander Rockwell in March of 1959. By this single act, the central location of our revived National Socialist movement was forever determined. The National Leader, in making his decision on the new Headquarters, did not overlook this all-important fact.

Member Redoubles Support

One Member who visited National Headquarters during Open House, a truck driver with five children from New Jersey, had this to say afterwards:

"Seeing is believing. I was very doubtful about the chances of National Socialism after Commander Rockwell was killed. That has changed since my trip to Arlington last weekend. Seeing the new Headquarters and meeting and talking with National Leader Koehl and all the fine men around him convinced me we can and will win.

"I am more inspired than I've been in a long time. I am going to start tithing to the Party, just like some church members do. Giving 10% of what I make to the National Socialist Cause is the best investment I know for my children and my race."

Headquarters Visiting Hours

Regular visiting hours at National Headquarters are between 4:00 and 8:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 2:00 to 8:00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays. Special advance notice is required of those wishing to visit at some other time.

The new Headquarters is located at 2507 N. Franklin Road in Arlington, just off the 2500 block of Wilson Blvd., and can be reached by a No. 1 or No. 2 Virginia bus from Washington (which can be boarded along K Street, or between F and K Streets along the east side of 11th Street).

Massive Literature Distribution

Over the Memorial Day weekend Party members wearing White Power buttons handed out over 10,000 leaflets called "Special Rights for Blacks?" (like the enclosed copy) to White persons in Washington in the areas around the Lincoln Memorial, the Washington Monument, the White House and the Smithsonian buildings, as well as to rush-hour commuters in other parts of the city.

The response from area residents--who are becoming more and more infuriated with the provocations of the so-called "Poor People" rabble--was roughly as follows: 60% sympathetic; 35% noncommital; 5% hostile. (Of the latter number approximately 3% were Jews, mistakenly handed the leaflet.)

The leaflet distribution was held in lieu of the scheduled rally 31 May at the Sylvan Theater on the Washington Monument grounds, inasmuch as the National Park Service refused to issue the necessary permit. Rejection of the NSWPP application for the Sylvan Theater was based on a recent Park Service policy of refusing all new permits for use of park facilities in the nation's capital while the so-called "Poor People" are using federal grounds! The Party is planning to challenge this monstrous state of affairs later this summer.

Bus Drivers Favor White Power

Fourteen Party members led by Robert Lloyd and Capt Chris Vidnjevich were on hand at a mass meeting of over 1,000 striking White bus drivers of Local 689 of the Amalgamated Transit Union at a Washington hotel 3 June to pass out "Special Rights" leaflets. The response to the Swastika and White Power was overwhelmingly favorable and enthusiastic; there were no dissenters.

The bus drivers have refused to go on night-time runs in Washington since one of their number, John E. Talley, was brutally murdered by a Black savage during a recent robbery. Denied the right to carry firearms, the drivers have become exposed to an increasing number of Black assaults in the past several weeks.

National Socialists Oppose Forced Housing

On 1 June four Party members attended a meeting of the Arlington County Board, at which they threw their support behind the majority of area residents opposed to a local forced housing law. They included National Leader Matt Koehl, Robert Lloyd, Spencer Redfield, Jr. and Gary Hansen.

The National Leader pointed out that 90% of the White people in the community were opposed to such an ordinance, and blasted the 5% Liberal minority for disregarding the will of the people, challenging the Liberal-dominated Board to hold a public referendum on the issue. He accused it of wanting to import into Arlington the same jungle conditions which prevail in the District of Columbia, and suggested that it would be more feasible to send the Liberal minority over to Washington if they enjoyed associating with Black aborigines so much.

Over the strenuous objections of the chairman, the other Party members defiantly read chapter after chapter of Commander Rockwell's book, White Power to the packed meeting. In all, six persons--including several non-Aryans--spoke in favor of forced hosuing, with seven opposed, including the four National Socialists.

New Staff Member

James D. Finkenbiner, formerly with the Los Angeles Headquarters of the Party, has been transferred to National Headquarters. Finkenbiner, an ex-paratrooper and former surveyor and bouncer in Arizona, will serve as full-time duty officer.
