National Socialists Honor Commander Rockwell

On 25 August two separate ceremonies were held in Arlington by National Socialists paying tribute to Commander Rockwell, who fell in the Struggle exactly one year earlier.

At 11:58 a.m.—the time at which the Commander was murdered—a delegation from National Headquarters placed memorial wreathes at the site of the assassination, following which a silent tribute was observed. The ceremony concluded with the Party salute.

A memorial service was held at Party Headquarters at 3:00 p.m. in the presence of the sacred urn bearing the Commander's mortal remains. Before a large Swastika flag, the urn was flanked by two lighted candles. The National Leader's address was as follows:

"Fellow National Socialists! Exactly one year ago today we National Socialists were dealt a stunning blow. George Lincoln Rockwell, our Commander, was foully murdered by a cowardly assassin's bullet. Not since 1945 had our Movement suffered such a staggering loss.

"Today we pause to pay tribute to the immortal memory of our fallen Commander.

"George Lincoln Rockwell's mortal remains lie before us. Our enimies would like to think he is dead.

"But these enemies miscalcuated when they arranged the cowardly assassination of Commander Rockwell. For the spirit of George Lincoln Rockwell lives on in the ranks of our Movement. And as long as even one White man is alive, carrying on his good fight, he is not really dead.

"These enemies thought they could destory the National Socialist movement when they prompted a gutter hoodlum to fire the fatal shot at Commander Rockwell. But these enemies were wrong. They underestimated the true strength of the Movement which he revived on that historic day in March of 1959.

"These enemies underestimated the power of the National Socialist idea. For a Movement or an Idea which has become so deeply implanted in the hearts and minds of Aryan men and women can never be destroyed.

"This is not to say that the Movement was not severely tested after Commander Rockwell's murder. Following the assassination, the Party for the first time had an opportunity to test the loyalty, the dedication and the commitment of its adherents as never before.

"There were those who wavered in their National Socialist faith; there were those who quit. There were those who attempted to cause dissension and division in our ranks, thus wrecking the very Movement which Commander Rockwell had so painstakingly built—and for which he gave his life.

"But there were also those who did not quit, who remained firm and unshaken in their loyalty and devotion to National Socialism, and who showed their National Socialist mettle in this time of gravest crisis.

"It was you—those who have remained loyal—who paid Commander Rockwell the finest tribute—by continuing the Struggle when all seemed lost, when all seemed crushed; you paid him the only worthwhile trubute he would have wanted.

"And when the history of our Movement is written—after all the quitters, all the deserters, and all the cowards have been forgotten—future generations will honor those of you who remained loyal and steadfast. History will tell how our victory was acheived because there were those who, in the face of seeming defeat, simply didn't know how to quit.

"Commander Rockwell has left us a mighty legacy. Above all, he has left us with a sacred obligation to carry on the good National Socialist fight. And his years of struggle and sacrifice for the Movement now makes our task possible.

"In This Time the World, Chapter XIII, he wrote: 'Adolf Hitler has shown the way to (our racial) survival. It would be my task on this earth to carry his ideas and his example to total, world-wide victory. I knew I would not live to see the victory which I would make possible. But I would not die before I had made that victory certain.'"

The music played during the ceremony included Siegfried's Funeral Music from Wagner's Goetterdaemmerung, I Had a Loyal Comrad, the Party's Battle Song and the militant anthem, White Men to Arms!

National Socialists all over America joined in a fast on the 25th of August as a way of showing tribute to the late Commander Rockwell.

Party Member appears Before Human Relations Council

On 13 August, Party Member Charles White of Asheville, N. C. appeared before the city Human Relations Council to give the National Socialist viewpoint for improving human relations.

The Council was meeting to discuss arrangements for setting up an inter-racial club for teenagers. The Council members agreed that that would lead to "a deeper understanding of the problems encountered by minority races, and thus open the door to solutions which would ease the frustrations of Negroes"—like permitting young black bucks to rape all the White girls they want.

When Party Member White's time came to speak, he stated that he had a much better solution to the Black problem. Mr. White explained that the National Socialist White People's Party will ship Negroes back to Africa- free of charge, thus dispensing with the need for huge welfare appropriations as well as human relations councils.

An account of Mr. White's action was featured in his local newspaper.

Activity of the Month

On the 26th day of September, Rudolf Hess will have spent his 10,000th day in a democratic prison. This Jew-inspired act senseless cruelty keeps our comrade Hess, now a man of 76, secluded as the only inmate sole of this dungeon-like fortress.

Party members and supporters are urged to bring this disgusting situation to the attention of as many American as possible. This can be done in any of the following ways:

- (1) Call a radio "talk" show and start a controversy over whether or not Rudolf Hess should be released.
- (2) Write a letter to the editor of your local newspaper for publication. The following letter has been drafted by one of our Party members to be sent to all U. S. Congressmen:

"Dear Sir:

"This letter is to remind you that there is still a solitary inmate in Germany's Spandau Prison-Rudolf Hess. As you probably recall, Rudolf Hess is the National Socialist Officer who parachuted over Scotland, May 10, 1941, on a personal diplomatic mission to try to end the War. Mr. Hess was incarcerated that very day and remained in a British prison until Germany's surrender in 1945. At Nruemburg he was convicted of "plotting against peace" and sentenced to life imprisonment at Spandau, where he is still being held.

"Perhaps you do not realize that Rudolf Hess has been confined for over twenty-seven years, 10,000 days, to be exact, on the 26th of this month. Rudolf Hess, now aged 76, is kept in solitary confinement and is allowed only two half-hour periods out of his cell each day.

"The reasons for putting a halt to this injustice are too obvious and too numerous to list here. As an American citizen and a public official I'm sure you'll want to join with me in seeking the immediate release of Rudolf Hess and putting an end to this shameful situation."
