National Socialists on Two More Campuses

Growing antagonism against Black militants has led to two more large scale literature distributions on college campuses. On 2 December NSWPP units in the vicinity of Ohio University put a "Had enough, Whitey?" leaflet in the hands of nearly every student there. Again on 8 December National Socialists distributed thousands of leaflets to the angry White students at riot-torn Wisconsin State University at Oshkosh. In both cases response to these distributions has brought new adherents into the Movement who are ready to form units on their campuses.

Both of these actions were carried off entirely by the NSWPP groups in the localities. Credit goes to the NSWPP Members in Ohio and Wisconsin who organized and successfully carried out the distributions.

Yuletide Sabotage

Members and supporters who have previously received mail and solicitations from the Jewish front group in Alexandria known as the White Party will be the recipients of another smear designed to discredit the NSWPP, this time in the form of a bogus advertisement published by them with the name of the NSWPP and the National Leader affixed to it. This new smear purports to be a flyer put out by the NSWPP *selling the ashes of Commander Rockwell as Christmas presents "for the man who has everything."* The advertisement offers a packet of ashes for a donation of \$5 or more.

In this base act, this group, which claimed loyalty to Commander Rockwell just a few months ago, has demonstrated its disrespect and utter contempt for the man who gave rebirth to National Socialism.

Activity of the Month

One of the groups most rapidly polarizing as a result of the political and social reversals are America's policemen. There are a number of different influences at work to push policemen out of the political middleground: Every police officer is finding it increasingly difficult to take a law-breaker into court and see him punished for his crimes. In this respect he is getting a bird's-eye view of the degeneration of the United States court structure as a result of the treasonous decisions of the Supreme Court. In addition, policemen are in perpetual contact with Blacks, many of whom are at constant variance with the law. As a result, not one cop in a million has fallen for the first iota of propaganda about "equality" and "human dignity." To top it all off, policemen have become the whipping boy of the Jewish press for every affliction in society from poverty to riots! Hardly an officer in the country has escaped an accusation of "po-lice brutality." And the police, of course, are the number-one target of the new left, having been dubbed "pigs" by leaders of the Yippies.

The NSWPP has published a special leaflet for policemen which has met with extraordinary success among White policemen of the Washington Metropolitan Police Department. A number of policemen have already signed up as Party supporters, and organizing among policemen has just begun.

This month's activity for Members and supporters is making the first step towards organizing local police departments by getting one of the new "Had enough, Pig?" leaflets (sample enclosed) into the hands of all policemen. This month is the ideal time to make first contact with the police of your city while their forces are at full strength and work shifts are long during the Christmas rush. Leaflets can be distributed to policemen in a variety of ways:

(1) The simplest way is to walk up to a policeman on the street and ask, "Have you seen this?" Invariably, the curious officer will look at it, and by the time he looks up, you can be gone.

(2) Around nearly all police stations is a parking lot for policemen who've driven to work. Often these lots are city property, but quick, careful work will enable you to put a leaflet on each car, tucked under the windshield wiper, within a few minutes time. Return to the lot more than once at different times of the day so that policemen of more than one shift will get a leaflet. If there is no parking lot for policemen, leave leaflets on the automobiles parked immediately around the police station. A big city will often have a police station in each precinct. Find out their locations and visit all of them.

(3) Take leaflets directly into the police stations and pass them around. If, after trying to give literature directly to policemen, they refuse to take it for fear of getting spotted reading Party propaganda, devise other plans for getting literature to them. One Member reported to a method which worked particularly well with detectives in Washington, D.C. He went to the office of each detective squad: vice, homicide, burglary, juvenile, etc., with a stack of twenty-five leaflets clearly visible under his arm. He asked the officer on duty if Detective White was in. In each case, he was told that there was no Detective White in that office. Looking puzzled, he asked if maybe there was a Detective Wright or Knight there. Meanwhile, the unsuspecting detective had begun eyeing the leaflets. The National Socialist then said that he must have gotten the officer's name completely wrong, so would he be good enough to find out which detective had asked him to drop these leaflets off? He then handed the leaflets to the officer, and while he was momentarily engrossed in the headline thanked him quickly and departed before more questions could be asked. Another Member found the lockers where policemen change into their uniforms and put the leaflets through the vents in the doors so they were safely inside till the officers came back to change.

(4) There is another method which can be followed for effective, long-range results. Watch your daily newspapers for all articles about crime where an arrest or investigation was involved. One or more policemen's names will usually be printed in connection with the case. First check the names in the phone book. If you find a listing, mail a leaflet to his home. If you can't find a listing in the telephone book, send a leaflet to him in care of the police station, and mark it "personal."

Always dress neatly when distributing to the police. If you are stopped by a policeman, be polite and cooperative. The police are tired of smart-alec slob; if you dress poorly and act insolently, you will get the same treatment as the hippies.
