White Power Message Sticker Strike

During the night of 10 January, the first of many bannersized bumper stickers with Swastikas and the White Power Message number appeared in the nation's capitol and environs. That first night, five Party Members were arrested in Silver Springs, Maryland, a Washington suburb while adorning street signs and store fronts with the new stickers. One Member turned in the following report on the incident:

Report of Party Member Kane on Arrest for Littering

On Friday, January 10, at about 11:30 p.m., four other Party Members and myself were arrested in Silver Springs on charges of Public Littering. We were putting up the new White Power Message stickers in places where they could be seen by shoppers the next morning. These stickers are very eye-catching because of their size and can be seen by passing motorists as well as shoppers. Also, they are quite easy to put up since they're already gummed.

When we were arrested, all of us were putting stickers up at the same time. We had put up so many stickers, in fact, that the arresting officer said that all he had to do to catch us was to follow the trail of Swastikas. The police treated us all right; many of them asked for literature and some even said they agreed with us, but that the local merchants (Jews) would raise holy hell if we got away scott free after putting stickers all over their stores. We were released after about an hour on bond of \$33 each, which we can forfeit if we decide not to go to court.

We enjoyed putting stickers up in group; it was a lot of fun. But we could have avoided arrest and the subsequent fines if we had done some better planning. The following suggestions may be of help to people who use this effective method for posting National Socialist slogans:

- 1. Do your work alone! Don't go out in large groups. Our mistake in going out in a group cost us a hard earned \$165 in fines. One man can put up as many stickers as a whole carload; it will just take him longer, and the chances of getting caught are greatly reduced. The "fun" of going out to put up stickers with Party comrades is greatly outweighed, in my estimation, by the safety of doing it alone.
- 2. Put up only a few stickers each night. We left stickers behind us like footprints through half a dozen Washington suburbs, so it was no trouble for a lone policeman to follow our trail. Stickers should be put up a few at a time, regularly, and in different areas.

- 3. Locations for stickers should be chosen carefully. Highway and street signs on ar teries subject to rush-hour traffic jams are excellent. Store windows are all right for awhile, but proprietors will spare no effort to have them taken down as soon as the store's open. Stickers in Black areas are a waste. We put one sticker up in D.C. niggertown in the morning, and when I rode through the next day the coons had written so many obscent remarks on the sticker that the Swastika and number were impossible to make out.
- 4. Stickers should be stuck to smooth, clean surfaces and rubbed on with a cloth or handkerxhief. Proper application will prevent people from tearing them down, because when they're put on right, they just fray and pull apart in little strips when removal is attempted. If a surface is dirty, it should be wiped off completely before the sticker is put up.
- 5. Stickers should be placed up high. This is the best possible deterrent against people tearing them down. I can drive my truck up to a highway sign, climb up on the roof and put a sticker up in a matter of minutes. A sticker in the middle of a traffic sign can't be missed! Some activists have found that our big stickers really beautify the middle of a billboard. Others have found ways of getting them on an overpass. I saw some on my way to work this morning.

I hope this information will be of help to Party activists.

National Socialist Commemorative Date

What followed His ascention to power was not only the social and economic reconstruction of Germany, but a cultural and spiritual renaissance incomparable to any other in history.

New Leaflet

The NSWPP has published a new leaflet for distribution in schools which are being actively terrorized and wrecked by Blacks. The new leaflet, entitled "What kind of gutless creep are you, Whitey?" is considerably more militant than the previous student leaflet "Had enough Whitey?" The new "Gutless Creep" leaflet is keyed to situations calling for a provacative, strongly militant response, like the open destruction of universities and attacks on White students in California colleges. "Gutless Creep" leaflets are available from MS Publications, Box 5505, Arlington, Virginia, 22205, for \$5 per 500. A sample of this leaflet is enclosed. All activists should keep a supply of these leaflets on hand for immediate distribution as soon as Blacks start terrorizing a school in your area.

Objectives of the NSWPP in 1969

So that Party members and Supporters have a clear understanding of plans for Party development in the year ahead, a word will be devoted here to our strategy and objectives for 1969. The following information should give Members and Supporters a lucid picture of the tasks before the Party leadership as well as their own responsibilities to the Cause in the new year.

Organizational development for this year can be roughly divided into two basic categories: (1) Development of the organization which is the sole responsibility of the National Leader and the National Headquarters Staff. This will be known as *internal development*. (2) Development of a militant, responsive membership and the building of aparati for local activism will be known as *external development*.

Internal development in 1969 will concentrate on the following specific areas: (1) Regular publication of the Party periodicals, particularly White Power. Members and Supporters who have not yet made their contribution to the special newspaper fund are requested to do so without further delay.

As soon as the Party is able to maintain regular, monthly publication of the newspaper, frequency of publication will be increased to every two weeks. (2) Establishment of a network of White Power Message units in major cities across the country. (3) Regular production of revolutionary leaflets on topical issues, like "Gutless Creep" and "Stop the Slaughter!" for national distribution by Party activists. (4) Recruiting for the National Headquarters Staff for the generation of larger volumes of new material. (5) Streamlining of all routine operation at National Headquarters for maximum efficiency of all Staff Members.

In 1969 a general hardening of the Membership will be cultivated. Members will be expected to evolve a more activist outlook and leave behind the passive attitude of a sympathetic observer which many members harbored in the past. External Party development will generally consist of this militant, new attitude of the Membership which will manifest itself in the form of increased local activism. The development of a prepared, activist following is also the deliberate plan of the New Left degenerates at this time. In order for the development of the Party's human resources to be successful, Members and Supporters must never relax their efforts for local activism. A steady stream of revolutionary new leaflets will be produced by the Party for distribution across the nation, with which the recruitment of new supporters, the raw material for cadre building, must be the foal of Party activists.

In order to assure the organic accomplishment of Phase Two objectives, some endeavours will not be sanctioned in the year ahead. The following undertakings will be avoided in 1969:

1. No local headquarters or offices will be authorized. The building of local Units will be the only regional organization sanctioned during 1969. And Units themselves will only be commissioned when they have met the following requirements: (A) Installation of at least one White Power Message set. (B) Enough Party activists in each area to get out a large scale literature distribution on twenty-four hours notice. (C) Provisional Party representative for the area who has been interviewed at National Headquarters and accepted for that post.

In a few cities, groups have been calling themselves Units without recognition from National Headquarters. As of now, this practive must be abandoned until the above requirements can be met.

The first step in forming a local unit will be the mobilization of all activists and potential activists in the area. When new names come into National Headquarters as a result of local activity, they will be turned over to the most able National Socialist in each area for recruitment as Official Supporters and Party activists. This may turn out to be a slow job in many cases, but is nevertheless a vital pre-requisite to the formation of a Party unit.

No local headquarters will be considered until at least one local unit has functioned successfully for a year or more, until it can be entirely self supporting, and until a local leader of acceptable experience and talent can be appointed by the National Leader. Even then, a headquarters will be opened only if a demand is indicated by a favorable response from the local public.

- 2. No local fund raising will be permitted. All dues and contributions will continue to be sent directly to National Headquarters. Solicitation of pledges for support of White Power Message units will be permitted only when a Party representative holds a letter of authorization from the National Leader. Other fund raising is strictly forbidden.
- 3. No local newsletters or independent publications will be permitted. Members and Supporters should instead promote the present publications of the Party, by selling subscriptions to White Power and National Socialist World, and using the NS Bulletin to arouse the interest of new supporters.
- 4. No speaking engagements, public appearances or press conferences on behalf of the NSWPP will be sanctioned for Party Members or Supporters. Activists should, instead, work on arrangements for speeches by the National Leader and other Party leaders. College speeches, in particular, should be arranged for a spokesman from National Headquarters whenever possible.
- 5. Formal meetings with ceremonies are discouraged at this time. Those who are building local units should hold periodic meetings, but the meetings should be for the purpose of planning activities. (This tyge of meeting is known as a "workshop" by the left.)) M IN KAMPF study groups are also encouraged.

Local initiative is encouraged when it follows the precepts of Phase Two and accomplishes these goals for 1969.
