Red Meeting Crashed

The following account of the wrecking of a Young Socialist Alliance meeting appeared in a Washington, D.C. hippie newspaper. It may provide some pointers for those who oppose the Young Socialist Alliance and other Jewish, Marxist enemies:

YSA meeting disrupted

A Young Socialist Alliance public meeting was disrupted Sunday night, Aug. 17, when the speaker was attacked by a small group of youths shouting "Hell Hitler". Over 70 people were in attendance at the meeting, one of a weekly series held by the Washington YSA.

Peter Camejo, a Berkeley activist and YSA spokesman, had spoken for only ten minutes when the lights were suddenly turned off. The darkness gave the necessary cover for several ultrarightists in the front row to attack Camejo and some other people.

Camejo was sprayed in the face with a chemical substance, presumably mace, and hit over the head with a black jack. A firecracker was exploded, giving the impression of a gunshot, and a chemical-filled bottle was smashed on the floor, whose smell drove the audience out of the Reiss Science Center auditorium. Several other members of the audience were also sprayed.

The attackers quickly fled.

The two Georgetown University policemen assigned to protect the meeting were not in evidence until after the incident was over.

Dan Rosenshine, chairman of the local YSA, stated after the meeting: "The YSA will continue its regular series of educational meetings at Georgetown on Sunday nights.

"These pro-fascist hoodlums are attempting to treat Americans who oppose the war in Vietnam or racial oppression the way Nixon and the State Department treat the Vietnamese people. They, like Nixon, seek to silence movements for social progress by terror and violence. Such intimidation will not succeed."

A formal complaint was filed with the Washington police department on the following day by YSA members and other participants in the meeting. Identifications were provided to the police and a request made for an investigation that would lead to warrants being issued for the arrest of those involved.

No arrests have yet resulted from the incident.

Newspaper Sales—An Important New Activity

The results of last month's activity were so successful for those activists who went out and sold the twenty copies of WHITE POWER we sent them, that we're going to extend it an extra month for those who haven't made full use of their papers. Here's what some of our supporters told us in their activity reports about selling papers:

"I never thought WHITE POWER would be so easy to sell. Less than 15 minutes on a crowded corner and they were all sold."

"I gave 500 copies of the last issue of WHITE POWER away in the neighborhood near me where coons are moving in. I went around real early and shoved them under people's doors. When I got the 20 copies of WHITE POWER this month, I tried selling them at the same houses where I'd given away the last issue. Out of a total of 32 houses where I found people home, I sold all 20 copies, and two people signed up for subscriptions. Enclosed is the six dollars and their subscription forms. Also the three dollars profit from the papers as a contribution."

"I hadn't had much success selling the Party paper to people who know me, but when I went to other parts of town, I didn't have any trouble at all. I drove around to the barber shops on the west side and at least one barber in each shop I went to bought a copy. I am going to start going to the shops where I sold the papers for my haircuts. Maybe I'll be able to sign up some barbers as Official Supporters."

"My brother and I wanted to see how the Party paper would go over with people who'd just seen one of these Jew propaganda movies about WWII. We went downtown to sell my papers to people leaving 'Castle Keep.' ['Castle Keep' is the latest Hollywood fantasy about WWII; viciously anti-National Socialist, of course.] Several people made remarks and laughed at us, but we sold all the papers before even half the audience had gotten out of the theatre. We could have sold three times as many if we had had them."

"I took my papers out to the east-end suburbs where all the rich doctors and lawyers live. I thought since WHITE POWER is the only truthful paper in America I might be able to get some big contributions for the Party. But I only sold two papers out there all afternoon, one of them to a White maid. One rich creep threatened to call the police if I didn't get out of 'their' neighborhood. Anyway, I took the rest of the papers out last Monday afternoon to a lower middle-class neighborhood near me. I couldn't believe how fast the papers sold out there. It seemed like they were all gone in a few minutes. I could have sold hundreds. I wrote down the addresses where I sold the papers so I can go back and try to sign the people up with a subscription."

"Anyone who says he can't sell papers is a liar. I've been selling papers for three months now, sometimes peddling as many as 100 in a single afternoon."

Once you've tried selling newspapers, you'll agree with the comrades who have told us how easy it is. This activity will extend through the end of September so you'll have a chance to get your feet wet.

The vending racks pictured above are now being used in the Arlington area for selling WHITE POWER. There are no laws restricting their use in most areas, but this can be easily checked by calling your state's attorney's office.

We now have a supply of these simple wire racks, complete with coin boxes, ready for shipment. They are \$7.00 each. This can be recouped by the first 50 papers sold in the rack. You will have to supply your own chain and lock, and it is suggested that you take it in each night.

It's been nearly a year now since the Jews, working through their hirelings, have launched any sort of a smear campaign against the Party. Their last effort was a hoaxed-up "advertisement," with the Party's name and address on it, offering to sell little packets of Commander Rockwell's remains for five dollars as Christmas presents "for the man who has everything." These ads were mailed out to many of the names on a mailing list stolen from the Party several years ago.

Before that was the scheme trying to blame their own black deed of assassinating Commander Rockwell on the Party with the "wanted for murder" poster, with Commander Koehl's picture on it. This was also circulated by mail to many Party members and supporters.

They've been pretty quiet for a while now. It won't be at all surprising if the Party's recent success with the North American Congress stimulates them into making another series of attacks on the theory that if they sling enough mud, some of it will stick!

As National Socialist revolutionaries, we must always be prepared to be subjected to the most vicious, underhanded and dishonorable attacks which our depraved enemies can conjure up.

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
