Resolutions Came Pouring In

Persuant to the request in the last Bulletin for each member and supporter to pledge greater activism in the coming year, New Year resolutions came in to Party Headquarters from National Socialists nation-wide. It is really encouraging to see the membership showing such a strong commitment to this aspect of Party development.

The results of last year's activism are well worth noting. Since local movement building became a regular function of Party followers, an altogether new form of contact with the public has been made possible. Now the public can learn what National Socialists really stand for, instead of what the Jews and their goy collaborators claim. Now it is possible for Party views to be put forth in a dignified, resolute manner, instead of having to take a beating from the press every time we are able to force the Party's name into the headlines.

And the results of this new contact with the public have been successful, even though it has been restricted to a modest scale up to now. The rate of new inquiries reaching National Headquarters, for example, has more than tripled over a year ago. New supporters have come in at a proportional rate.

The responsibility of Party activists now is to *scale up* the number of new people receiving Party literature in their locality. Whereas Party activists tripled new inquiries in 1969, a substantial increase in their activity should easily double that in the year ahead. Our work will be made much easier by the quickly ripening racial-political-social-economic crisis facing the White American worker.

The hard work of Party activists will serve a double function: Not only will you bring new blood into our struggle through direct proselytizing, you will serve as an example to other National Socialists, who do not immediately see the value of their personal involvement—an example of the gratifying results attainable through their own hard work. *And in the most important sense you will gain priceless experience in NS organizing—experience which will be essential for Party organizers during the crucial struggle of Phase Three.*

In the past year we have learned that there is nothing as valuable to the Movement as the personal involvement of every comrade. All those who made their resolution for greater activism for 1970 should stick to it with religious dedication. Of all the resolutions you have ever made in your life, this is one you should not break.

Wills Should Not be Put Off

Wills have a way of being needed when least expected.

A Party comrade, a lady of only 57, recently passed on, leaving an estate of over \$1 million to a foundation for the sheltering of orphaned cats. (Incredible, but completely true!) If this Party supporter had realized that her time was coming, she would have surely hastened to draw up a new will favoring the Party. Nearly all of us would like to leave all or some of our estates to the Party after we are gone. And almost none of us knows just when his will is going to be required, especially in these uncertain times. That is why this unhappy subject is brought to your attention—to remind you of the necessity of making ample preparations for your final bequest.

A word of warning regarding any will made out to the Party: After it has been drawn up and signed, the whole matter should be held in strictest confidence between you, the Party and your lawyer. This is recommended because of a disastrous situation just prior to the death of a Party benefactor in the mid-60s. A well-to-do admirer of the Party, who had done little in the way of support during his lifetime, had drawn up his will leaving the bulk of his estate to the Party. We later learned that it had run into six figures. On his death-bed, with a chance to finally do something valuable for the Cause, his family found out about his intentions of leaving much of his estate to the Movement. They immediately swarmed *en masse* to his bedside along with his family minister and his lawyer. They proceeded to hound and coerce the old gentleman into signing a new will excluding the Party, of course—just hours before his demise. A good lesson to all!

Please advise Party Headquarters in any changes in your final bequest. It will be held in the upmost confidence.

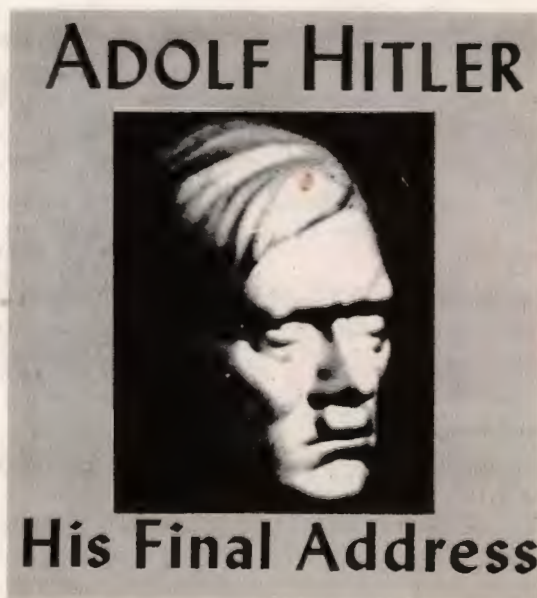
Good Standing Required for New Cards
