Akron White Power Message/Bookstore in High Gear

After a bout of legal harassment from local police and politicians, Akron National Socialists are back in action. The legal expenses for Charles Lawrence, the Party organizer in the Akron area, who was arrested and tried on trumped up charges, did not leave sufficient funds to operate the White Power Message in Akron until the initial trial could be paid. An appeal trial is still forthcoming, but enough moeny has been squared away to pay off the major trial expenses and get the Akron messages back into operation. Since mid-April, the message service has been back in order, and as a result new visitors have begun frequenting the bookstore as never before. (The publicity of the trial is partly accountable for this.) During the *first week* after restoration of the message service, as many new supporters were signed up at the bookstore as were signed up during the entire previous month when the service was off—a striking example of the results which can be netted by the White Power Message.

New Party Bookstore Opens in Cincinnati

Another Party bookstore has opened, this one in Cincinnati, Ohio, under the sponsorship of Party members F. S. Pierce, Steven Love and Robert Brannen. The bookstore in Cincinnati also serves as a location for the White Power Message for the city.

The National Socialist Bookstore in Cincinnati opened to the public April 6, two days after commencement of the White Power Message. Ever since the opening, Cincinnati National Socialists have been embroiled in a conflict with the local telephone company which immediately bowed to pressure to terminate their phone service.

In spite of recurring legal difficulties over the White Power Message in different spots around the country, this is the first instance of the telephone company actively participating in an effort to silence the Message. In all previous cases, the telephone companies have merely acted on Jewish-spawned court orders requiring them to terminate service. Naturally they are more than happy to comply, since it greatly eases the burden of complaints which they receive in a torrent from Jews, Blacks and race traitors while the White Power Message is in operation,

Cincinnati National Socialists have turned the matter over to the Public Service Commission to have service restored. In addition, injunctive relief is being sought in the courts to prevent the telephone company from arbitrarily terminating service in the future.

With the White Power Message out of operation, public interest in the bookstore has been regrettably low. At last report, a relative small number of new visitors has been coming in, owing to the lack of advertising of the location without the WPM. But this situation will change as soon as the messages are again being heard by Whites across the city.





Cincinnati National Socialists are to be commended for their accomplishment in opening this new anchor spot for the Party. As the above photos indicate, they have located the shop in a modest, publicly situated storefront. The size and location are perfect for an initial undertaking of this kind. Decoration and displays were incomplete at the time these photographs were taken, but they should give local organizers some idea of what type of operation they should consider for their first public office in their localities. The Cincinnati Bookstore is located at 3943½ Spring Grove Avenue. The number for the White Power Message (when it goes back in operation) is (513) 681-1812. Party members and supporters in the Cincinnati area are urged to visit the bookstore and take their friends along. It's open from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday, Wednesday and Friday and from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturdays. By giving all possible assistance to the Party organizers there, you could make it possible to keep the bookstore open longer hours than it is at the present time.

VC Supporters Struck

An April 15 rally in Washington, D.C., against the payment of taxes for the continuation of the war in Vietnam turned out to be a victory-for-the-Viet-Cong rally. National Socialists were on hand to show once again that betrayal of our fighting men will not go unrebuked whether that betrayal comes from the White House, the System or the Jewish-led rabble in the streets.

The first of two rallies was followed by a march by a column of several thousand reds to the foot of the Capitol building, where the second rally was addressed by David Dellinger, Black Panthers, and assorted red criminals. It was during this march that National Socialists struck. Seemingly showing up from nowhere, Party activists swarmed into the middle of the column, throwing large, exploding firecrackers at carriers of VC flags. The first burst went off in mid-air right by the head of one flag carrier, who was so unnerved that he dropped his flag and fled with the rest of the crowd. More flags were wrenched from the hands of red demonstrators and poles used to clout the ones who did not scatter fast enough.

After awhile, police moved in to encircle the NS demonstrators and seal them off from the reds. In spite of the destruction of numerous signs and flags, and the stampede caused by the NS attack, no charges were

preferred by the police. (All of them were White.) It is understandable that police on the scene were unsympathetic to the miseries of people who'd been calling them "pigs" and "fascist vermin" during the previous hour.

New Staff Member

The National Headquarters staff has been increased as of late March by an additional Party worker: Mark Dials, a long-time Party member who joined the staff immediately upon discharge from the military. Mr. Dials served twenty-four months in the 82nd Airborne Division. He is employed in the Party's graphics and printing section, with responsibility for the production of Party literature.

Membership Applicants Plan Interview

Applicants for Party Membership are advised to plan an interview with Party officers during their candidacy period. In all but exceptional cases, these interviews will be conducted at National Headquarters in Arlington. The interview can be scheduled any time after notification that the candidacy period has commenced, but membership can not be conferred until the interview has taken place. In some cases, this will require an extension of the candidacy period until the formal interview can take place.

Notice of Suspension

Contrary to nationally circulated newspaper reports, Mr. Frank Collin of Chicago does not hold any official position with the Party.

Mr. Collin's membership has been suspended pending an investigation of irregularities in his Party application form. This investigation is being conducted independent of recent published reports alleging Collin's Jewish paternity.

July 5 (Sunday) Come to Arlington for a rally in Washington to commemorate the 10th anniversary of Commander Rockwell's historic rally on the Mall (July 3, 1960) which brought him into national prominence. This rally will be held on the exact same spot, and it is not unlikely that some of the exact same Jews will show up again to try breaking our meeting. Make definite plans to be here to defend our right to speak and spread the word of National Socialism. Be in Arlington by noon July 5 to participate in this honored event.
