Commander Visits the West Coast

Commander Koehl recently appeared on the West Coast, speaking on radio and television and before important Party gatherings, reaching millions of new people in several cities. His itinerary went like this:

13 February

The Commander spoke before a large standing-room-only crowd of nearly 100 members and supporters at the Los Angeles headquarters. In a stirring address, he described the struggle for White Power as a battle involving every White Aryan in North America. He emphasized that the treasonous system under which we live is working against our racial interests, and that a revolution is necessary to return political power to the White people of this continent. His speech was played over KPFFK radio later in the week.

Other speakers at the meeting included National Organizer William Kirstein, White Servicemen's League Co-ordinator Robert Homan and Los Angeles Leader Joseph Tommasi.

The National Organizer spoke on the progress of the Movement and described the dramatic growth the Party has been experiencing since the last North American Congress. While strongly praising those local leaders who had done so much to promote the growth of the Movement, he emphasized that the significant factor was increased activism by individuals in currently unorganized areas.

Robert Homan stressed the importance of loyalty in his speech and noted that all who had attempted to disrupt the Party through factionalism had in the long run only failed miserably. He showed why White Power could only be achieved by a disciplined National Socialist movement comprised of loyal and dedicated activists.

During his remarks about upcoming events and demonstrations, Lt. Tommasi pointed out the importance of street activity, saying that only a direct confrontation with the enemy could give White people the forceful image of courage and direct action they need when they are finally ready to fight.

During the ceremonies which followed, several new Troopers were sworn in. ST Dan Stewart was promoted to the rank of Troop Leader, and Lt. Tommasi was cited for his exemplary leadership by the Commander. A showing of the inspiring NS film "Raise the Banner" concluded what many felt was the greatest National Socialist gathering ever held so far on the West Coast.

14 February

The Commander spoke to supporters and members at a VFW hall in the San Diego area. Many new people attended this meeting and received the Commander's speech on White Power with enthusiasm. An organized unit is now in the process of formation.

15 February

Radio station KPFK in Los Angeles interviewed Commander Koehl in an hour-long program, during which he emphasized the revolutionary idealism of the White Power program. This interview on the youth-oriented station gave many young idealists the opportunity to hear the message of racial idealism for the first time.

16 February

Commander Koehl arrived in Seattle for a meeting with local supporters and a number of other appearances. He was interviewed on KUOW radio--the University of Washington station--for a half-hour during which he detailed the Party's "Back-to-Africa" program for Blacks. Afterwards, he met with a number of students to discuss a variety of subjects, including the possibility of White Power activity on the local campus.

That afternoon, the Commander appeared on KRAB, a youth-oriented radio station. Expecting an interview, he was pleased to learn that he was requested to deliver a half-hour speech. In one of his most brilliant and effective talks yet, he described to many of the White youth listening the true nature of the System as an essentially JEWISH one which is working against White interests, and that only a White revolution could insure a responsible political solution to the problem. His address was recorded and played twice over KRAB as well as several other area stations later in the week.

Commander Koehl was interviewed for a newscast later that evening by KING-TV news. It was also re-run the following morning on the Hugh Downs program. The Commander said he had come to the Seattle area to explore the possibilities for White Power there. He also discussed the controversial local busing issue. After his appearance on KING-TV, the Commander met with a number of area supporters.

17 February

The Commander left Seattle for Vancouver to speak at the University of British Columbia. When he arrived at the U.S.-Canadian border, however, the guards insisted on interrogating him, which detained him for two hours. 'Curiously', he was released at exactly 1:30 p.m., the time he was to have concluded his university engagement!

18 February

Commander Koehl taped a panel discussion show on CBU-TV (a CBC outlet) in Vancouver entitled "Hourglass", a program moderated by a Jew named Jack Wasserman. Other panelists included a representative from the Canadian Council of Christians and Jews and a rather scroungy kook from a local underground paper. As the program progressed, panelists were so busy interrupting one another that the Commander easily exposed their phony arguments. Jack Wasserman, the moderator, wrote the enclosed articles in the Vancouver Sun. Contrary to his 'reporting' no uniforms were worn. Note his repeated obsession with jackboots.

TWENTY-SIX YEARS LATER -- The question that seems to arise is whether one should be nice to a Nazi.

The head of American Nazi Party crossed the border the other day looking for publicity and recruits. Wearing my other hat as a regular participant on CBC's Hourglass, I was involved in a roundtable discussion with this person who thinks that Hitler was right and that his only mistake was losing.

The reaction was fascinating. Nearly 100 people telephoned the CBC switchboard immediately after the show. More than half of them complained that the Nazi shouldn't have been allowed on TV. A few people said he hadn't been treated fairly. Eleven callers thanked the corporation for demonstrating that such people still exist. Several dozen more wrote letters. A large number of writers wrote long, thoughtful letters in which they complained that the would-be-dictator should have been given a greater opportunity to express his philosophy of racism and genocide.

The general theme of these complaints seemed to be that the three of us who participated in the roundtable with the Nazi were inconsiderate of the Nazi because we didn't treat him the same as any other guest. I personally must plead guilty to the charge. A man who wears jack boots, a brown shirt, and a swastika lapel pin isn't the same as anyone else. He represents something abhorrent to all right-minded members of society.

It should be said that we didn't throw him on television without a great deal of thought about the implications of his presence. This is a problem that faces every newspaper editor and TV public affairs producer. A case can be made for ignoring the promoters of unpopular views on the ground that any publicity is good publicity. A classic instance of this view involves TV coverage of the people supporting Quebec separatism. Members of parliament and citizens at large regularly attack any coverage of the Quebec scene on the ground that such coverage aids and abets the cause of separatism. The implication is that

the separatist will go away if they don't get any publicity. The other side of the coin is that the vast majority of the population will remain in ignorance of widely held views if they are not covered.

In the case of the itinerant Nazi, his views about a New Order are not widely held. But many of his basic precepts are shared by people who are unaware that when they casually support racism they are in fact giving aid and comfort to the ghost of Adolph Hitler.

The show was video-taped on a Thursday afternoon and a number of discussions were held between that time and the Monday evening when it was finally shown. My own view was that the show should be aired for a couple of reasons. In one instance, it illustrates the leakiness of the border and the readiness of the authorities to permit entry of a man who preached a view that may very well be in violation of Canadian laws against preaching hatred against any group of citizens. The other reason, in my view, was that the presence of the Nazi would remind many people that the ugly cancer that took millions of lives,

including those of a few hundred thousand Canadians, still flourished in some sick minds.

While the American Nazi party may not have all that many members, either in the U.S. or Canada, many people are tempted to accept the basic hate-filled doctrines as long as they are not wrapped in the swastika and other trappings of Nazi Germany.

The Nazi repeated his recurrent whine that the stories of Hitler's death camps and gas chambers was merely wartime propaganda. He repeatedly referred to a credibility gap when the subject was brought up. He denied all the evidences of brutality that marked the activities of Nazi Germany.

BORDER LINES -- When Matt Koehl, the fuhrer of the American Nazi Party sneaked across the border to spread his sick hate doctrines in violation of Canadian law, he was immediately met by a jack-booted junior grade storm trooper from Burnaby. Everywhere that Koehl went he was accompanied by his local ally, who was wearing a swastika in his lapel and who nodded approvingly when Koehl preached that Hitler was right. After a session at CBU, one of the producers ushered the Nazis to the door, and for lack of anything better to say, muttered "Go in Peace." To which the local storm trooper replied, with a stamp of his jack boot: "And return in triumph!" The only question that arises is how come Canadian authorities have found reasons to bar Abby Hoffman and Jerry Rubin, but they can still make excuses to permit lice like Koehl to enter the country.

During the program, the Commander outlined three points of interest to his Canadian audience. He condemned the idiocy of the U.S. -Canadian boundary, saying that it was arbitrarily drawn in the 19th century and that it separated men of a common race and language unnecessarily. One day, he said, White men from the Arctic to the Rio Grande would share a common nationality and destiny. Addressing himself to the problems of unemployment and non-White immigration, the Commander stated the Blacks should be repatriated, and that full employment could never be realized until White racial interests were truly served by the government. On the Indian question (an important issue in Canada), he advocated delegating adequate territory to them so that they could practice cultural and ethnic autonomy. He then exposed the myths of World War II and the warmed-over war propaganda of over 26 years ago.

Commander Koehl was also interviewed by the Vancouver Sun. That evening, he spoke at a public meeting in Vancouver on the topic "Political Realities in the U.S.", pointing out that political and social problems in Canada are similar to those of the United States in many instances. He then called for North American unity to solve these common problems. The audience was very receptive to the Commander's message and he was invited to return.

Commander Speaks in Baton Rouge

On 19 February, the Commander spoke to a gathering of hard-core National Socialists in Baton Rouge, La. At this meeting, he outlined the political tasks of the Party. He described the operations of the power-structure which dominates America and declared that Jewish power is what we have to smash; that Black Power is only a threat insofar as it is part of the organized anti-White attack of the Jew.

A local meeting of the White Youth Alliance was held separately earlier in the evening.

A Surprise Appearance in Cincinnati

On 20 February, Commander Koehl made a surprise appearance at a gathering which an anti-Party con-man had planned to use as part of a fraudulent fund-raising campaign. Before the bogus character could get started, the Commander thoroughly exposed his cheap racket. Interestingly enough, not once during this exposure would the phony look Commander Koehl in the eye, but instead hung his head like the guilty creature he is! After this clown had thoroughly discredited himself, the Commander was able to speak seriously to the group about the National Socialist program.

National Organizer on Pittsburgh TV

On 25 February, National Organizer William Kirstein appeared on "News Desk", a program of WTAE (Channel 13) in Pittsburgh. The 20-minute interview was shown in two segments at 7 and 11 p.m. on 26 and 27 February.

In answering questions, Capt. Kirstein spoke of the efforts by Jews and other anti-White traitors to weaken the White race and Western Civilization. When pressed for data on Party membership, Capt. Kirstein exposed the meaningless nature of the question, explaining that both major parties claim millions, yet are both similar in doctrine, and treasonous to the true will and interests of the White people. He emphasized that we National Socialists seek quality in our membership, so that we can build the necessary leadership for a White revolution!

During a later segment, he shocked interviewers by pointing out that the NAACP is a Jewish organization. As he elaborated on this fact, newsmen quickly whispered to each other in search of an answer, but ended up avoiding the subject.
