The Congress in Arlington: TRIBUTE TO A TITAN!

The fourth North American Congress of the World Union of National Socialists, in conjunction with the National Socialist White People's Party, was held in Northern Virginia over the Labor Day weekend, 2-4 September.

Delegates from 30 states and provinces of the United States and Canada attended the Congress, which was held this year in special tribute to Lincoln Rockwell, who was martyred five years ago on 25 August 1967. The Congress was also the occasion for celebrating the 10th anniversary of the World Union of National Socialists, which was founded in the Cotswolds, England, on 5 September 1962.

Commander Koehl addressed the opening session with a warm welcome to the assembled delegates, many of whom were attending their first Congress.

The late morning and early afternoon sessions consisted of reports from local Party organizations. Joseph Tommasi, leader of the Los Angeles unit, recounted the Party's successes in California over the past year and showed two special color films. One film was a 30-minute account of the JDL's attempt to "shut down" the NSWPP local headquarters in El Monte last January. Delegates cheered as shaggy Jews, their faces distorted with hate, stood at bay before the determined Stormtroopers who stood between them and the El Monte headquarters building. The second film dealt with the march on El Monte City Hall on 5 August by the Los Angeles unit in protest against the city government's protracted harassment of National Socialists in the community.

John Krenzer of Detroit gave a report on the Party's growth in Michigan. Comrade Lawrence Worth of Montreal reported on National Socialist inroads within the many European ethnic groups in Eastern Canada. A report on the Party's growing influence in Western Canada was presented by Comrade George Magas of Vancouver, B.C.

Richard Biederman, Delaware Valley organizer, reported on the Party's remarkable resurgence in the greater Philadelphia area. He described the many attempts by the JDL and city officials to stifle National Socialism. The Philadelphia unit was awarded a special citation by the Commander for having the largest representation of any unit present at the Congress this year.

Comrade Michael Szipronat of Chicago reported on the Party's increased activities in the Windy City. Comrade Dave Wydner reported on his organizational activities in Northern New Jersey. A report on the newly-established Baltimore headquarters was made by Wolfgang Schrodt.

Robert Homan, the NSWPP National Secretary, gave a report on the progress at National Headquarters over the past year. He outlined the high quality and monthly regularity of *White Power* newspaper, a direct result of the efforts of the editor, William Grimstad.



During the afternoon session a report was presented on the World Union of National Socialists by Robert Homan, the General Secretary of WUNS. Noting the world-wide resurgence of National Socialism, it was shown how the dream of Adolf Hitler and Lincoln Rockwell of Aryan global solidarity and co-operation was the duty of every National Socialist. Comrade Homan announced the revival of the quarterly newsletter, the *WUNS BULLETIN*, and invited all sincere National Socialists to associate themselves with WUNS as an organization dedicated to the common interests of Aryan mankind.

Statements were read before the Congress delegates from Dr. E. R. Cawthron, the WUNS representative in Australia, and from WUNS associates Bruno Luedtke of Germany, and Povl H. Riis - Knudsen of Denmark.



A state of the Party address was then delivered by Commander Koehl. The Commander surveyed the successes of the Party over the past year: the *White Power* bus and the anti-busing tours through the North and the South; the election success in Seattle in October, 1971, when the Party garnered 5 per cent of the vote with almost no campaign effort; the successful demonstration against the Reds in November in such cities as Cleveland, Los Angeles, Seattle, and Washington, D.C.; the inauguration of "The Future Calls" radio messages in March, 1972; the successful Memorial Day rally in Cleveland; the ST trip to Grandfather Mountain in North Carolina in mid-June where thousands of people were introduced to National Socialism for the first time; the tremendous ST confrontation at Flamingo Park, in Miami Beach, Fla., during the Republican national convention. These and many other accomplishments were offered by the Commander as proof of the NSWPP's commitment to the principles of revolutionary dynamism and direct confrontation. In summation, the Commander emphasized the two keys for success in the future: more activism and greater sacrifices.



After adjourning for dinner, the evening session was begun with a special two-hour workshop on practical problems in propaganda and local organizing. Martin Kerr discussed techniques of organizing on university campuses and in high schools. Using his experience at Hofstra University last spring, Comrade Kerr emphasized the necessity for confrontation-style tactics.

Joseph Tommasi spoke about organizing local demonstrations and literature distributions. Dan Dexter discussed the importance of using the right kind of propaganda. He categorized propaganda as being of two kinds: white (or positive) and black (or negative), and described situations in which they're employed.

The evening session concluded with the showing of the immortal film classic of the 1934 National Socialist Congress at Nuremberg, "Triumph of the Will."



On Sunday morning the ST was given close drill exercises and a pre-demonstration briefing before departing for the rally site in Washington, D.C. Meanwhile, at a special meeting for Party Members only at the new National Headquarters conference room, the Commander made it known that those Party Members who rested on past laurels and were inactive could expect to forfeit their status.

At 1 p.m. in the afternoon a special Stormtroop march was begun at the Lincoln Memorial. Hundreds of carloads of tourists stopped in amazement and curiosity as the long lines of helmeted, uniformed ST, formed up for final inspection before beginning the march to the Ellipse, a park directly across from the White House.

The Stormtroop column marched around the Lincoln Memorial then headed northeast to Constitution Ave. and proceeded down it for half a mile until it approached the Ellipse. As the column approached the speaker's stand the chant began: "We want. . .WHITE POWER!" Soon National Socialist airs from the speaker's stand mixed with the determined voices of the Stormtroop column. Crowds began to gather. Despite rain during most of the weekend, the sun was bright and the sky was free of clouds. It was "Hitler weather."

Speakers at the rally were, in order of appearance, Joseph Tommasi, Robert Homan, Richard Biederman, and Commander Koehl. Dan Dexter chaired the rally. Joseph Tommasi told the audience of 400 people that the time for talk had ended, that action was required and that it was embodied in only one organization: the NSWPP.

Robert Homan warned the audience that White America had two options before it in these days of irrevocable decisions. Pursuing its present course, America could follow the example of the classical civilizations and descend into racial destruction and cultural oblivion. Or, by embracing National Socialism, America could undergo a national and racial renaissance and herald in a new epoch for Aryan man.

Richard Biederman told the gathering that the time for class distinctions and bourgeois thinking was over. Citing the life-or-death conditions of poor Whites in Philadelphia, Comrade Biederman reiterated that there was only one issue for them: racial survival against the encroaching Blacks. He emphasized that all White Americans would soon be faced with the same choice.

Commander Koehl spoke to the people about "America: A Racial Concept." He pointed out to them that this nation was established by White men for White men. Outlining the great Aryan origins of America, the Commander declared that "Blacks and Jews didn't fit into the American scheme of things and that under National Socialism the nightmare of Jewish-liberal democracy will be brought to an end once and for all." The crowd, which had been very sympathetic throughout, applauding all the speakers, cheered the Commander's words and replied with shouts of "White Power!"



At the evening session a special two-hour presentation of rare color slides of National Socialist shrines and historical sites was shown by Douglas Kaye and Neil O'Connor.

The final ceremonies of the evening were held in recognition of services and sacrifices rendered to the Movement by National Socialists, both living and dead. In a darkened hall, with the flickering light of candles aglow on the holy Swastika banner and the faces of assembled comrades, the Commander announced the special presentations and awards to Party comrades who had made distinguished contributions on behalf of National Socialism during the past year.

An Operations Medal was awarded to those comrades who had contributed their services to "Operation Beachhead." The Medal of Merit was awarded those comrades who participated in the Flamingo Park action. Comrade Dennis Brucker of Florida was awarded the Wound Medal for severe injuries he received at Flamingo Park.

A special roll-call was then made of National Socialist comrades who had made the supreme sacrifice in the racial struggle. A crucible was lit. As the names of the fallen were read out, the delegates responded with the Aryan salute and greeting: "Heil Hitler!" The color guard lowered the Swastika banner in honor to the fallen amid the melody of "I Had a Loyal Comrade." The assembled comrades concluded the ceremony with the singing of the Movement's anthem, "Raise the Banner!"



Baltimore Headquarters Opens Against Enemy's Opposition

When Party comrades arrived on Saturday, 26 August, to participate in the opening ceremonies of the new Baltimore headquarters at 2112 Eastern Avenue, most had little idea that they would come to witness the testing of opposing wills, a literal struggle for existence in the predominantly Polish neighborhood of Patterson Park in south-east Baltimore.

Local Marxist toughs, aided by many mislead Polish-Americans who had been told the vicious lie that the NSWPP was anti-Polish and anti-Catholic, gathered in large, menacing groups, declaring that the Nazis wouldn't last the night. Numerous physical attacks were launched against the Baltimore headquarters that night. But our men repelled the attacks and the next morning the Swastika banner was once again flying on Eastern Avenue.

Open Hostilities As Hate Emblem

Hate lasted a little more than one hour in the 2200 block Eastern Ave., Saturday night. It started to manifest itself publicly about 6 o'clock when a group billing itself as the National Socialist White Peoples Party fluttered its flags, The Stars and Stripes and state banner flanking the Nazi swastika from a second floor window.

A half dozen crew-cut young men took up military positions in front of the three-story house building. A small crowd gathered.

And down Eastern Avenue a step van loaded another half dozen young men who obviously had been jockeying the afternoon in the American fashion—cold hot four and a softball.

The visitors stopped quivered rather harshly.

Neighbors Revolt

Swastika Of White Party Stirs Polish Resentment

When the khaki-clad members of the National Socialist White Peoples party marched out of their new headquarters last Saturday in the 2200 block Eastern Avenue, the Polish people of Southeast Baltimore had seen it all before.

The staid alarm troopers with red swastika armbands proclaimed "white power" to the parishioners of Holy Rosary Catholic Church.

But the Polish residents saw only the hated memories of the Third Reich's goose-stepping SS troops and concentration camps where many of the Americanized Poles lost entire families.

Confrontation began immediately between the neo-Nazi Eastern Avenue and Patterson Park area, and has continued throughout the week.

Police report calls four or five times a night to alter-party members and the party on Eastern Avenue.

A few neighbors of the party, identified, said the people object to the swastika and what it stands for.

They generally agreed that the party would not object to the party with a different symbol being headquartered on Eastern Avenue, although other Polish residents want the party out no matter what.

Wolfgang Schrodt, organizer of the party, who had to pull the egg-shaped swastika banner off the front of his building last Saturday, explained that "to unite our people we need some kind of a symbol."

"The swastika," he continued, "has been a symbol of white people throughout history from the Romans and Vikings to the Germans."

Party's aims

Mr. Schrodt believes the people without realizing too quickly his nationally affiliated "white power" party which includes "white pride, white self-defense, good education, white friendship, a strong America."

and a happy and healthy family life.

The bespectacled party organizer with closely cropped red hair has lived in the 2100 block Eastern Avenue since November.

A couple of neighbors called him a "quiet guy who kept to himself" and only when he came out front from his "fortress" with his ideology did the residents get up in arms.

Cites Motives

But Mr. Schrodt, who moved there because "it was the only left," said he "had to get out of West Baltimore 10 years ago when 'the blacks took it the same thing from happening here,' he added.

Edward Shopinski, of the 2100 block Bond Street, with more than 40 years residence along Eastern Avenue, believes there are too many people in the area who fought in World War II, and the Nazis of today have no chance in southeast Baltimore.

March scheduled

A march is planned for Monday but Mr. Schrodt, who said he has support received considerable quietly from members of the community and hopes for their participation, wants to avoid trouble and the parade may be canceled.

He talked of "protecting his home" in the front reading room of his three-story row-house with the sun lighting Adolf Hitler's picture. Red curtains were tied in place when a youth threw a chair through his window, and a German masser rifle stood at the ready nearby.

That swastika, like red in a people who were almost totally eliminated by the Nazis, Mr. Shopinski said, "Their Polish-American children have taken up the bottle-throwing battle to get the Nazis out of there."

Mr. Schrodt, who does "not want to be antagonistic toward the police," has asked the American Civil Liberties Union to investigate why only party members are arrested after the headquarters was pelted with bottles for four hours Thursday night.

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
