1973 Fall Building Campaign Launched!

All members and supporters of the Party should have received by now the special letter from Commander Koehl announcing the beginning of the 1973 Fall Building Campaign. This is the Party's annual fall drive to gather funds for very necessary new projects. The goal of this year's campaign is to raise \$5,000 by Christmas Eve. This money will be added to already existing funds as the beginning of an effort to raise the necessary money to purchase the building directly adjacent to National Headquarters.

In sending out the letter, Commander Koehl spoke of the dire need for National Headquarters to expand, pointing out that we are starting to "burst at the seams." Commander Koehl stated that we have only two choices — either slow down and contract operations, or make a concerted, sacrificial effort to raise the funds necessary to expand.

Though the necessity to expand is only a natural growing pain, not a single comrade can afford not to take heed of the importance of this drive. Growing pains are only overcome by 100% effort on the part of everybody. We all realize that the present economic situation in America is an added burden especially to those with large families and elderly supporters who are already finding it almost impossible to make ends meet. But it has been these very same people who have been among those who have come through in the past and helped make these campaigns successful. In future editions of the NS Bulletin, we will announce the progress being made to reach our goal.

ST, JDL Clash Near Israeli Embassy in D.C.

Four teams of ST from the Arlington-Baltimore area picketed against the Israeli Embassy in Washington, D.C. on 20 October. As the troopers, led by Commander Koehl, arrived they were immediately confronted by two aging Jewesses, who appeared to be the spiritual leaders of a JDL counter-demonstration. After pushing the Jewesses aside, the ST commenced its picket which was held to protest aid to Israel. In about 20 minutes the crowd watching the demonstration had grown to nearly 200 persons, including about 80 JDL. Finally working up enough courage, the JDL broke through police lines and attacked the ST. Though vastly outnumbered, the Stormtroopers pitched in to the Jews with National Socialist fervor. After a short but sharp fight of about several minutes, the Jews retreated across the street in a disorganized and defeated array.



Severely defeated, the Jews attempted to get the police to arrest two troopers for assault. Though the police were unwilling to arrest anyone, the Party was ordered to send representatives to a judicial hearing to see if there was enough evidence to press charges against the Stormtroopers. At the hearing, a United States attorney — after hearing the accusations of a half-dozen hate-crazed Jews — dismissed all charges against the troopers. In the battle a number of Jews were so severely mauled, that three of them required hospitalization.

Party Activity on the Increase Around the Country

In the last month the Party has seen a dramatic rise in the amount of the activity around the country. One area of increase has been in the distribution of Party materials largely newspapers. The step-up in activity has been most noticeable in the area of pickets and demonstrations. Among the demonstrations that have taken place have been the following:

Los Angeles

On 28 October, three teams of LA Stormtroops picketed two smut bookstores and a pornographic movie-house in Inglewood, a suburb of Los Angeles. Throughout the entire three hours of picketing, none of the shops picketed received any customers, as most people were fearful of crossing the picket line. The only incident during the entire afternoon occurred when an obvious racial reject came up and challenged Marshal Clifford Ward who was leading the demonstration, and claimed that he was a full-blooded Indian. Ward looked at him and informed him that "he himself was a "full-blooded White man." After being confronted by a brave White man, the Indian scampered away.

Chicago

On 21 October, the Chicago unit, using its White Power bus, protested U.S. support of Israel. Led by Lt. Cedric Syrdahl, the busload of troopers travelled to a busy street corner on Chicago's northwest side. The troopers set up a picket line near a busy shopping center, while others handed out literature to passersby. Upon noticing the troopers, one Jew nearly went hysterical and tried to block the bus as it tried to leave and go to another corner. The Jew left after White pedestrians and motorists laughed at him for his strange behavior. For the rest of the afternoon, the bus continued to stop at selected corners including O'Hare International Airport.

St. Louis

On 17 October, St. Louis area comrades staged a "Free Rudolf Hess" demonstration in front of the offices of the Globe-Democrat newspaper, located in downtown St. Louis. During the picket, interviews were given to all local newspapers and a local television station, which broadcast the event that same evening. After concluding the picket, the troopers marched several blocks to the office of U.S. Senator Thomas Eagleton, where local leader Richard Patton along with comrade Dennis Nix presented him with a statement demanding the release of Rudolf Hess.

On 22 October, a team of troopers conducted an informational picket in the south St. Louis business district demanding that no aid be sent to Israel. Again the troopers were interviewed and one interview resulted in a 60-second news brief. The troopers received many favorable comments.

Seattle

On 4 October, Seattle-Tacoma area National Socialists protested the appearance of Black militant Stokely Carmichael at the University of Washington. After picketing for 30 minutes at the entrance to the hall where he was speaking, campus police ordered them to leave, whereupon they stationed themselves at the front entrance to the University and commenced handing out literature to those coming and going. In a while, a large limousine pulled up and stopped in front of the National Socialists. One trooper went up to the vehicle and gave a White Power newspaper to the occupant, who turned out to be none other than Carmichael himself, surrounded by his bodyguards.

Cincinnati

On 8 October, a team of local troopers picketed a regular Cincinnati School Board meeting. In the picket the troopers demanded that the school board stand up to federal authorities on the question of racial integration. After picketing a short while they were confronted by about 20 Jews armed with clubs and chains. The troopers refused the order to leave, and after it was apparent that our men were not going to leave without a fight, the Jews stood back and heckled.

On 20 October, Cincinnati comrades traveled to Chillicothe, where they teamed up with local troopers there for a protest and literature distribution. This distribution was held to show local politicians that despite the recent arrest of Party comrades (See Bulletin 144) there, National Socialists would not allow themselves to be intimidated.

St. Petersburg

Comrades from that Florida city report that activity is greatly on the increase. Recently, local comrades have been regularly attending Pinellas County School Board meetings. In a recent appearance, the National Socialists were interviewed by the local media including television.

A van has recently been donated to the unit. Presently, area activists are working to get the bus painted and have signs ready for upcoming demonstrations. This new addition will enhance the efforts of the unit immensely.

Atlanta

Party activists in this city have become much more active recently. They have announced a campaign of regular street sales and distributions of Party literature and newspapers. The reproduced clipping on page three is a result of one of their literature distributions on the University of Georgia campus in Athens.

Three Injured As Jews, Nazis Clash in D.C.

Three people suffered minor injuries yesterday during a scuffle between American Nazis and Jewish factions a block from the Israeli Embassy.

The scuffle reportedly began when 15 Nazis, who had a permit to demonstrate, were charged by a group of 30 Jewish men and women.

D.C. police broke up the fight, which resulted in two women suffering cuts and bruises and one man being taken to George Washington University Hospital.

A spokesman for the Nazis said they were protesting American support of Israel.

Belleville

Two NAZIs oppose Israel

Two members of the National Socialist White People's Party (NAZI) passed out literature in Belleville's Public Square Saturday expressing anti-Israel views on the Middle East War.

Dennis Nix of O'Fallon and Richard Patton of Belleville, the NAZI unit coordinator for Metro-East, said Friday the U.S. is forcing the Arabs into the arms of the Soviet Union by supporting Israel in the war.

Nix and Patton expressed opposition to Jews and other minorities, in line with the NAZI party's belief in white superiority.

"In the conflict we believe that the United Arab Republic is right," Nix said of the war. "All that area has been lived on by Arabs for thousands of years."

Nix admitted that Egypt took the first military action in this particular crisis by crossing the Suez Canal, but he said Egypt only was trying to regain territory illegally taken earlier by Israelis.

Both men predicted Israel will be victorious in the war, however, due to superior arms, training and U.S. help.

"If Israel needs American aid or American troops they will get them somehow," Nix said. "America will not see Israel lose."

Patton said the National Socialist White People's Party has been organized for about six months in Metro-East. He said it is growing in membership, but declined to give figures, saying his refusal is "for the protection of the members."

Sound familiar?

Handbills are never in short supply on the University campus, but the ones being handed out in front of Memorial yesterday were not of the usual variety. The handbills, full of condemnation of Jews and blacks and their detrimental effect on white America, were emblazoned with swastikas and bore the name of the National Socialist White People's Party operating out of Arlington, Virginia. The party's platform calls for a white America, white world solidarity, white self-defense, an Aryan culture and the sending of blacks back to Africa. America's problems, the handbills went on, are part of a Jewish conspiracy. Sound familiar?

NAZIS HERE PROTEST U.S. AID TO ISRAEL

Three uniformed members of the American Nazi Party delivered a letter to Sen. Thomas F. Eagleton's office at 1520 Market St. Wednesday protesting U.S. support of the Israelis in the 1973 Middle East war.

Earlier, they distributed literature for about an hour in front of The Globe-Democrat building at 12th and Delmar boulevards.

The FBI said there are only a handful, perhaps six or seven, members of the party in the St. Louis metropolitan area.

Another person who recently joined staff because of the Commander's call for more personnel, has been Douglas Flagg from Cleveland. Mr. Flagg is a long-time Party activist who replaces Mr. Floyd Juilliard as Party Business Manager. Due to personal circumstances, Mr. Juilliard found it necessary to leave staff and return to his home state of Louisiana.

ST Jimmy Clendennen who just recently joined staff has been reassigned to the staff at the Los Angeles headquarters.
