Fall Building Campaign Reaches Half-Way Point

The 1973 Fall Building Campaign, which was launched in early November, has just passed the half-way point of its goal to raise \$5,000 by Christmas Eve. As stated in an earlier Bulletin, the money raised in this drive will be added to already existing monies to be used as down payment when the Party is ready to purchase the building directly adjacent to our present facilities.

Though 50 percent of the necessary money has been raised there is still a ways to go in the final stretch of our campaign. In fund raising drives of this sort there is always a very good initial response, but as the first impact of Commander Koehl's special letter begins to wear off, the contributions coming in to National Headquarters tend to drop off. For this reason, we would appreciate it if any member or supporter who has not already done so would send in his personal contribution to this all-important drive.

Connecticut ST Demonstrates Against Black Quota System

On 3 November a contingent of Stormtroopers picketed the Bridgeport city hall to demand that the minority quota system for the Bridgeport police department be dropped.

Recently local System politicians have forced on the police department an anti-White policy entailing the hiring of non-Whites over qualified White men. Bridgeport has recently been overwhelmed by an influx of Blacks and Puerto Ricans as well as Jews. Being close to New York City, Bridgeport has received that city's overflow population of non-Aryans. Because of this, local police have found it increasingly difficult to keep crime down. Local Organizer Fred Sherwood has taken advantage of this fact and stepped up the Party's drive to show the White public that only the Party backs the police in their struggle to control the non-White masses.

WHITE POWER Sells Out for Second Straight Month

For the second month in a row, the Party newspaper WHITE POWER has completely sold out. This, despite an increase of almost 50 percent in the number printed in November as compared to October, should serve as an added stimulus to all members and supporters to make sure this trend continues. This is the time for everybody to increase — not slack off on — their orders for this excellent paper, as there are still millions of White Americans who have never seen the Party publication. To adjust to this great upsurge in the demand for WHITE POWER, the Party is planning yet another substantial increase in the press run for December.

Commander Arrested in Opposing U.S. Sell-out to Israel

On 1 November Commander Koehl was arrested in Washington, D.C., while leading a demonstration to protest the visit to the U.S. by Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meir. Early that day, while Golda Meir was meeting at the Blair House with Henry Kissinger, the Commander arrived with two teams of Stormtroopers to picket. The Commander carried a "Gas Golda" sign, while other troopers displayed a large "Dump Israel" banner. After picketing for twenty minutes, the contingent was informed that if the demonstration did not end at once the police would proceed to arrest the troopers. The Commander explained that the Party was merely exercising its First Amendment rights in peacefully protesting our sell-out to Zionist interests and was arrested. Two other troopers were also arrested in the confrontation. All were released after posting \$50 collateral each.

On 10 November Commander Koehl again lead a demonstration of six ST teams in a picket of the White House demanding that the U.S. drop all support of Israel. While some of the troopers picketed others displayed a large "Dump Israel" banner for passing motorists and pedestrians to see. The ST held signs that proclaimed "No More Arms to Israel" and "No More Jew Wars."

Though the weather was very cold, the Stormtroopers picketed for the entire two hours their permit allowed. Commander

Koehl gave several interviews during the protest. The demonstration, besides being on national television and in the local Washington papers, received world-wide attention as shown in the reproduced clipping from the Stockholm newspaper 'Dagens Nyheter', Sweden's largest daily.

Jew Warmonger Picketed in Florida

On 12 November two Teams of Stormtroopers picketed the appearance of Israeli foreign minister Abba Eban at an aid-to-Israel rally in St. Petersburg, Fla. The troopers formed a picket line outside the main entrance to the hall where Eban was speaking. They picketed one and a half hours, with signs reading "No More Jew Wars" and "Hitler Was Right," positioning themselves in such a way that they could confront the exiting Jews. Local officials moved in hundreds of police to avoid a confrontation.

November 9th Commemorated Around the Country

On 9 November National Socialists all over the country celebrated the 50th anniversary of the Munich Revolt. At National Headquarters a moving ceremony was held, climaxed by a stirring address by the Commander as well as a tribute to the 16 martyrs who fell a half century ago. Among the local units which observed the occasion with public activities were the following:

CHICAGO

The unit took its White Power bus onto the streets of that city. After spending a considerable amount of time in the northwest section of the city distributing Party materials, the men headed toward another area, when they were pulled over by the police. After frisking the troopers, they were allowed to proceed, except for the driver and the owner of the bus. After a short detention, both were released — but not before they had gotten a number of WHITE POWER newspapers to the police. The police were thoroughly impressed by the discipline shown by the National Socialist contingent and openly displayed there friendly feelings toward the Party.

ARLINGTON

As part of their observance of November 9th, a team of local Stormtroopers delivered a letter of protest to the West German embassy, located just across the river in Washington. The letter demanded that the German government stop all harassment of National Socialists in that country. After delivering the letter, the National Socialists verbally warned the stunned official that he could expect other demonstrations unless action was taken to end political persecution in Germany.

LOS ANGELES

Marshal Clifford Ward, accompanied by a team of Stormtroopers, went to the West German consulate in downtown Los Angeles. Marshal Ward and the troopers marched in in uniform and demanded to see an official. When a certain Herr Lieber appeared, he was read a statement in German that protested the treatment of National Socialists in West Germany and demanded the release of Rudolf Hess. After completely shaking up the Bonn functionary, who ordered the building evacuated, the contingent left.

San Francisco WPM Stirs Controversy

The recently installed White Power Message in San Francisco has unleashed an unprecedented wave of publicity for the Party in that West Coast city. Caught in the middle, the area telephone company complained to hysterical Jews that it is powerless to halt the message service. Local Leader Allen Vincent has given a number of interviews to the media, which has only added to the complaints by the area's Jews and Blacks. The WPM controversy has been heavily covered on radio and television, as well as in the local press, as shown in the reproduced clippings.

Israel Crisis Fuels Nazi Hope

The National Socialist White People's Party, headquartered in Arlington, Va., hopes to gain support through the energy crisis because of its strong anti-Israel stand, according to Matt Koehl, the party's national commander.

Koehl said that busing is another issue that may strengthen his party. While refusing to give an exact membership figure, saying that it is classified information, he said the

party is presently relatively small, although gaining support.

Koehl claimed that if given the same resources as the Democratic or Republican party, the National Socialists could pull 10 to 20 million votes in a national election. Founded in 1959 by George Lincoln Rockwell as the American Nazi party, it calls itself an extreme organization, a revolutionary party proposing extreme solutions, ac-

cording to Koehl.

Wearing the storm trooper uniform of Hitler's Third Reich—complete with swastika armband—17 party members demonstrated against aid to Israel in front of the White House last Saturday.

Explaining the party's stand on Israel, Koehl said American support for Israel only opens the door for communists in the Arab world. "America has nothing to gain but trouble from supporting Israel—our interests would be best served by a 180 degree turn in our policies," Koehl said.

Nazi Picket Golda Meir, 3 Arrested

Three men in Nazi uniforms were arrested yesterday as they paraded outside the Blair House with signs reading "Gas Golda," as Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meir conferred inside with Henry Kissinger.

The three were in a group of seven, all wearing khaki uniforms and swastika armbands, who staged a brief demonstration outside the residence, across Pennsylvania Avenue from the White House.

Police identified the three as Richard Biederman, 23, Matthias Koehl, 58, and Harold Mantus, 25. They gave their address as 2507 N. Franklin Rd., Arlington, the headquarters of the National Socialist White People's Party.

Police said the three men were arrested about 10 a.m. when they refused to obey a law forbidding demonstrations within 500 feet of a diplomatic mission or other building where a foreign government leader is staying. All three paid \$50 fines and were released, police said.

Hate, delivered by phone

This telephone message is brought to you by your local Nazi organization.

"Race mixing stinks, but not half as bad as the pornographic Jews who promote it. The sick, depraved Jews who monopolize the motion picture industry can hardly wait to turn America into a mongrel cesspool."

Pacific Telephone is not pleased that its equipment and circuitry are being used to disseminate that message, but it claims a 1968 State Supreme Court decision prevents it from acting as a censor.

The telephone company is caught between the dictates of free speech and good taste.

"If there was any way — and I emphasize any way — we could deny service, we would do it," a telephone company spokesman said.

In November, 1968, the telephone company disconnected service for tape-recorded messages sponsored by the National Socialist White People's Party in El Monte and Fresno after law enforcement officials ruled messages advocated violence.

"Do you believe that law enforcement should be relaxed so that blacks can burn people to death, stone people to death and shoot people to death?" it asks in a series of questions designed to degrade blacks along the usual stereotypical lines.

"If your answer to these questions is an emphatic no, contact us," says an unidentified voice. The message concludes with the name National Socialist White People's Party, a post office box, and the slogan "White Power."

Two San Francisco groups are exploring legal avenues of shutting down the message. Rita Semel of the B'nai B'rith Anti-Defamation League said the organization's lawyers were "looking into it" but doubted if anything could be done.

phone President Jerome Hull to try to stop the message.

Contacted at his home, Axel Vinson said other call in messages have been set up by the National Socialist White People's Party in Fresno and Los Angeles and that others are expected to begin in Tracy and San Jose this week.

Designed "to get the truth to the guy on the street," the messages, he said, are part of a West Coast recruiting effort to rebuild the party which fell apart after the assassination of George Jackson in 1968.

Vinson, as recently as last month, was a San Francisco resident living with his wife and two children. He is now a member of the National Socialist White People's Party in the

Hate peddlers

THE RACIAL HATE-SPEWERS are at it again in San Francisco. They are peddling via anti-Jewish and anti-Negro monologues via a recorded message at a telephone number they invite the public to dial.

They call themselves the National Socialist White People's Party. They are better known as the American Nazis.

In 1968, the telephone company tried to prevent use of its facilities for such hate messages. The courts ruled that it could not do so under the First Amendment right of free expression unless the messages contained a specific incitement to violence.

The right of free expression must be protected. We are exercising that right when we say the hate mongers are a scrutiny for deserving contempt from the public.

"It's always busy," Vinson said. "We're going to have to get a couple more units."

"Some people have tried to jam it by leaving their phone off the hook, but it can't be done. When the message ends, it automatically disconnects the caller."

Pacific Telephone, which has taken a neutral position on the matter, is barred from censoring such messages by a 1968 order of the state Supreme Court.

In that case, the American Civil Liberties Union brought suit on behalf of Fred E. Huntley, a conservative who attempted to disseminate his views under the slogan, "Let Freedom Ring."

Vinson said the National Socialist White People's Party has about 200 members in the Bay Area. "Most are working class people," he said, "but we have a few lawyers and teachers, too."

Secret Meetings Of Local Nazis

Allen Lee Vincent, the well-known local Nazi leader, told yesterday that the local Nazi group meets every week in secret. He said the local Nazis put on uniforms once they are inside the building and frequently practice military-style drilling.

"Do they carry guns?" he said, "just in case they might be necessary for self defense in case of a riot." The heavy-set, Northern California leader of the local National Socialist White People's Party was interviewed in his apartment at 404 Third Avenue.



A Recorded Message of Racial Abuse

A recorded telephone message that exorcises blacks and Jews and solicits its membership in a white supremacist group, touched off a legal dilemma in San Francisco.

Despite the recording's abusive, racist nature, Pacific Telephone Co. officials said the message is protected by First Amendment guarantees of free speech and expression.

The two-minute tape was produced and paid for by the National Socialist White People's party and went into operation a week ago from a home in the outer Richmond District.

Party leader Allen Vincent said similar messages are playing "all over the country."

Chillicothe National Socialist Sent to Prison

On 2 November James Mason of Chillicothe, Ohio, went to trial on a trumped-up charge of assault on a Black youth. After a one-day trial, which received wide local coverage, Mr. Mason was found guilty. The judge, who was apparently trying to appease city officials, sentenced Mr. Mason to the maximum of six months in prison and a \$200 fine. The attorney handling the case lost his nerve and refused to appeal, thus resulting in Mason being sent to the Cincinnati workhouse. With the help of National Headquarters he was able to change lawyers, who immediately appealed the case. After serving six days, Mason was released. Gregory Hurles, the other National Socialist charged in the case, will be tried after the outcome of Mr. Mason's appeal. In the meantime Mason and Hurles have set out to defeat the local government's frameup, (See Bulletin No. 144), and have started uniformed literature distributions, which have already gotten thousands of pieces of literature into the hands of interested Whites.

Northern Jersey Activists Harassed, Arrested

On 4 November two Party activists in northern New Jersey were arrested on petty-harassment charges of "destroying private property." In the last several months, local Comrades have greatly stepped up their attempts to reach more White people with Party literature. With racial tension at local high schools on the increase, David Wydner, along with other Party activists, have been contacting local students and urging them to defend themselves. Apparently this resulted in some over-zealous Whites painting White Power slogans on area buildings. The local police, spurred on by the FBI, arrested Mr. Wydner and one other person when they were unable to find those responsible. Both were released on \$200 bond. Word on the outcome of their trial will be forthcoming in a future issue of the NS Bulletin.

Protestors arrested

Four members of an anti-Jewish organization have been arrested by Belleville police for passing out handbills without a city permit.

Wearing military-type brown uniforms with red and black armbands, the four were apprehended at 2 p.m. Saturday near the E. Main St. entrance to the Public Square.

Jerry L. McGhee, 21, St. Ann, Mo., Terry A. Klasek, 27, Normandy, Mo., Richard M. Patton, 32, 205 W. B St.,

and Dennis M. Nix, 27, 107 N. 3rd St., pleaded not guilty before Associate Circuit Judge D. W. Costello and were released under \$25 cash bonds.

Police said the armbands were emblazoned with Nazi swastikas.

They carried banners that read: "Jews Control U.S. Government" and "Demand No Aid for Israel." They said they are members of the National Socialist White Peoples Party.

Four Arrested in St. Louis

On 10 November four St. Louis-area Stormtroopers were arrested in the suburb of Belleville after protesting U.S. support of Israel. After giving the local police three-days' notice of their intentions, the uniformed National Socialists showed up to picket at the city's public square. After demonstrating for a short while, they commenced to hand out literature. At that time they were arrested and charged with "advertising without a permit." After posting \$25 each, they were released. Local organizer Rick Patton has contacted lawyers and is confident that the law will be overturned when the case comes to court.

Police quiz NAZI pickets

Belleville police Saturday arrested four members of the National Socialist White People's party who were picketing in the city's Public Square.

Richard Patton, unit coordinator for the NAZI party in the metropolitan St. Louis area, said the demonstration was to protest U.S. aid to Israel and emphasize the national fuel shortage.

He said they planned nothing except picketing with signs.

Police still were questioning the four men, who were in NAZI uniform, late Saturday. They said the four may be charged with picketing or soliciting without a permit or that they might be released after questioning.
