





#### INTERVIEWS:

Those desiring special interviews with the Commander should contact NHQ no later than 25 August.

NOTE: There will be NO membership interviews conducted during the Congress.

#### PHOTOGRAPHY:

The Party is now looking for several qualified amateur or professional photographers to take movies and still shots of the Congress. Interested persons should get in touch with NHQ by mail or phone no later than 25 August.

In addition, a volunteer is sought to tape the Congress sessions. Interested persons should contact NHQ by 25 August, describing their equipment. (No cassettes please!)

#### DISPLAYS:

Unit leaders and local organizers should send in their unit display plans immediately. Upon arrival at the Congress site, those with displays will be directed how and where to set up by the Congress Co-ordinator, National Secretary Ward.

#### ST MARCH AND RALLY:

All male participants should come prepared for the ST march and rally. In accordance with this, attendees should come with regulation uniform, consisting of combat boots (if possible), black straight-cut trousers, black, gold buckle garrison belt, black socks, tailored brownshirt (no epaulettes), black tie (no wider than 3½"), Swastika armband and regulation ST helmet. (The last three items will be available at the Congress site.) A fantastic march and rally is planned to really rock Milwaukee. Everyone should try to participate in this historic street demonstration.

#### ACCOMMODATIONS:

Persons desiring advance room accommodations in the vicinity of the Congress site should notify NHQ immediately, specifying whether a single or a double is desired. A \$5 holding fee must be sent in for each person reserving a room, indicating which nights the room(s) will be needed.

#### APPEARANCE:

Attending a National Socialist Congress is a privilege, not a right. That privilege requires that all attendees adhere to certain basic National Socialist standards relating to appearance and dress, as well as conduct and attitude. Accordingly, the following items are to be noted:

Hair length — All male attendees must have proper haircuts. This means that hair is to be no more than four inches on top, evenly tapered off on the sides and back, with sideburns not extending below the lower opening of the ear. Under no circumstances is the hair to touch the ear or collar.

Mustaches — Mustaches must be neatly trimmed, and are not to extend over the lip or below the corner of the mouth. All male attendees are otherwise to be clean-shaven, although an exception may be made in the case of elderly attendees with well-groomed beards.

Male dress — All attendees taking part in the public march and rally should be attired in the basic ST uniform. At the Congress site, only full Party members, full NSYM members, and \*regular members of the ST are to wear the brown shirt. All other male delegates (including Official Supporters and probationary members) are to wear ordinary shirt and tie. Suit coat is optional. No levis, bellbottoms, leather jackets, sandals or freak or garish attire will be allowed for attendees. Similarly, no German military paraphernalia will be permitted to be worn. No armbands are to be worn off the Congress site premises.

\*A regular member of the ST is anyone who has submitted an ST application to National Headquarters and who participates regularly — either on an active or reserve basis — with a local ST unit.

Female dress — Women attendees should wear a dress or skirt and blouse in good taste. Miniskirts (anything over 3" above the knee), "hot-pants," shorts or slacks are not proper for this occasion and will not be allowed.

NSWO members should wear proper NSWO dress.

Armbands — No armbands are to be worn off the Congress site premises.

**DUAL MEMBERSHIP:** The Congress itself (not including the public march and rally) is an INTERNAL event of our Movement. Only those who are committed to it above all other movements will be admitted. So there won't be any misunderstanding later, let it be known in unmistakable terms that no one who is a member of any political party or any group claiming to represent the White man, — other than the World Union of National Socialists, the National Socialist White People's Party, the National Socialist Youth Movement, the National Socialist Women's Organization and the Stormtroops — will be admitted to the Congress. That privilege is reserved for those who give their sole loyalty to the one true Cause of Adolf Hitler and Lincoln Rockwell.

#### Attention Unit Leaders

Congress attendance for all unit leaders and local organizers is mandatory; unless officially excused. Personnel under their jurisdiction must be given all possible encouragement to attend. Unit leaders and local organizers will be held responsible for attendance from their locales.

## Milwaukee Unit Draws State Fair Crowds

On 7 August the Milwaukee Unit held a Party booth at the Wisconsin State Fair. The success of this action indicates one of the reasons Tony Schmitt is unit leader in Milwaukee. Under comrade Schmitt's dynamic leadership, Milwaukee stands as one of the many focal points of National Socialist activity throughout the nation. The work, courage, loyalty, accomplishment, dedication and sense of NS duty of not only comrade Schmitt but all of the comrades in Milwaukee was essential in the Commander's decision in selecting that city for the Sixth National Socialist Party Congress. They are all to be commended!

The following account from the unit secretary explains what happened:

The Milwaukee Unit of the National Socialist White People's Party made front page news across Wisconsin when it was learned they had rented space for a booth at the 1975 Wisconsin State Fair.

WITI-TV Channel 6 in Milwaukee was the first station to report this on their 6 p.m. news Tuesday August 5th. Within minutes of the report, every radio and TV station in Milwaukee had the story. The Milwaukee Sentinel in its August 6th edition, reported the story on page 1.

Meanwhile the Jews, as expected, did all in their power to close us down legally. But the Attorney General, Bronson La Follette, and the Wisconsin Civil Liberties Union and the State Fair Board did not buckle under the Jewish pressure.

The Jews then decided since they couldn't force us out legally since we were a legally registered political party with the State Elections Board, their next tactic was to set up a booth directly down the aisle from ours.

As expected, the Jews harped on the "Six Million Jews" lie as the theme for their booth. By contrast, the Milwaukee unit's display played up anti-Communism under a large banner in red, white, and blue with the slogan, AMERICA AWAKE! DETENTE IS A TRAGIC MISTAKE.

On opening day of the fair, we were ready for business. Large crowds of White people, disregarding an editorial in the August 7 Milwaukee Sentinel to ignore us, formed around our booth and we gave out free literature to hundreds of people during the first three hours of operation.

However, by noon, the crowd of friendly, curious White people began changing into a large mob of Jews, then niggers, and finally, long-haired White leftists. As the day wore on, only the most courageous White people came by our booth.

The Jews repeatedly tried to provoke our men into violence so the State Fair Board would close us down. However, none of our men took the Jews' bait.

Meanwhile, our booth was the center of attention of the entire state of Wisconsin. Just about every politician in the state jumped into the fray on the side of the Jews, including Governor Patrick Lucey.

The publicity our booth received was far and above anything we had ever received before. Television crews from as far north as Green Bay and as far west as Madison followed the entire controversy from beginning to end.

It soon became clear however that the very people we had hoped to reach with our booth were frightened off by the mob of scum that early-on had surrounded us. Finally, a nigger high on dope worked himself up into a violent rage and attempted to destroy our exhibit. Comrades Art Jones and Scott Moseby restrained him from doing so, until the West Allis police arrived to arrest the savage.

After that attack, unit leader Schmitt decided for the good of the fair, and the safety of innocent people, that we would close our booth for the duration of the fair. In gratitude, the State Fair Board made an unusual move — they refunded our \$250 fee, and all the monies for six 11-day pass books, plus they issued a press release stressing the fact that we closed our booth voluntarily.

This strategy to close early paid off in another front page news story and a wave of public sympathy toward the Party being heard on local radio talk shows, and from co-workers at our places of employment. Despite the ugly mob, the booth was a smashing success for the Party. We sold in a few hours \$25 worth of literature, and gave away hundreds of leaflets and newspapers and generated interest and publicity in the Party across the state.

As an indication of many people's approval of the Party presence at the fair, local radio commentators stated that the National Socialists were much better looking, their appearance much more disciplined and in good order, than the National Guard booth directly adjacent. The Japanese in the booth on the other side of the Milwaukee unit told the media people that the Nazis were very courteous and helpful!

## Comrade Knight Wins Anti-Discrimination Case

Comrade Thomas Knight, formerly of San Diego, emerged victorious recently from his long battle with anti-Party officials who were responsible for firing him last March. Comrade Knight worked at the San Diego Veterans Hospital until he was fired without notice for becoming active in his area — so active that pressure was brought to bear upon his superiors at the hospital. Since that time, he has pursued the issue with the hospital through the Civil Service Commission. The Commission, faced with such a blatant display of selective political discrimination, pressed the hospital until finally they relented. Comrade Knight, although having to travel between his new home in Arlington and San Diego to state his case in public hearings, and finally winning, has decided to tell the hospital where to shove their job. He will continue to live in Arlington and carry on in his post as local organizer.

## Nazi Party To Step Up Recruitment

Members of the local Nazi Party, whose booth at the Wisconsin State Fair created controversy until it closed down, are planning to double their demonstrations and recruitment efforts in Milwaukee this fall, one of the group's leaders said Sunday.

Anthony Schmitt, a spokesman for the local chapter of the National Socialist White People's (Nazi) Party, said the group is planning campaigns "that will pound more heavily on our schools and factories" and to begin a "very stringent campaign" to boycott Jewish stores and merchants.

Schmitt said the group also is planning a door to door literature distribution campaign in some of Milwaukee's "borderline neighborhoods," which he defined as areas of the city on the near Northwest and South Sides that are experiencing racial changes.

Schmitt said the group has a "much larger and stronger youth group that we will be using for recruitment in the schools."

He emphasized that "it's all going to be very legal. There's not going to be any beatings or anything like that."

Schmitt admitted Sunday that the group had received "bad responses from pupils" at Bay View High School on the South Side and Custer High School on the West Side. He added, however, that responses were good at other schools, such as Edison Junior High School on the West Side.

The planned boycott of stores and merchants who are Jewish will probably center on the larger stores, he said. The

only firm he would identify was Kohl's Food Stores.

Schmitt also claimed that the booth at the fair "was very successful." He said many persons bought literature and "I really think that if we had been permitted to stay open during the fair, we would have sold out our stock."

Schmitt said those who wanted to buy literature or support the group did so in a "behind the scenes" manner so that the public at the fair, which he called hostile to the group, did not take notice of the Nazi support. The group voluntarily closed its booth Thursday for the good of the fair, a State Fair spokesman said.

About 10 booths had separated the Jewish and Nazi groups.

Bypassers hurled taunts at the small group in the Nazi booth yesterday, creating concern among state fair officials that fights would break out.

The Nazi group sold "white power" tee shirts for \$3 and white power bumper stickers for 35 cents.

Meanwhile, at the Jewish booth, films and slides of Nazi atrocities against the Jews during World War II shown. ## Nazis Have Right to Booth, Fair Told

The chairman of the State Fair Board said Thursday that Atty. Gen. Bronson La Follette had advised him that it would be an unconstitutional infringement of the right of free speech to close a State Fair booth operated by the local Nazi Party.

Francis Ferguson, chairman, said he called La Follette Thursday in response to urgings from County Supervisor Fred Tabak and State Rep. Gary Barczak (D-West Allis) that the board void its contract with the Nazis.

When the Nazis applied for space in March, Ferguson said, the board asked for an attorney general's opinion on the question. That office then advised that, no matter how distasteful it might seem to rent space to the Nazis, the board had no choice, Ferguson said.

He said he was told that since the Nazis are a registered political party they legally could not be refused a booth to distribute literature.

Tabak and Barczak said the Nazis should not be allowed to run a booth because they created the possibility of a civil disturbance.

Ferguson said the Nazis had been told, "like all groups, if there is any trouble we will boot them out."

Thursday morning about four Nazis distributed literature at the booth. There were no reported incidents.

In the same aisle, on the opposite end of the South Exhibit Hall, the Zionist Organization of America, Milwaukee Dis

tributed literature. Tabak said about 20 people had called him to say they were boycotting the fair because of the Nazi booth.

Barczak, in whose district the fairgrounds are located, said in a letter Wednesday to Ferguson: "To expect all those attending the fair to act tolerantly towards the Nazi is naive to say the least."

ACLU Says OK  
William Lynch, executive director of the Wisconsin Civil Liberties Union, said Thursday that the Nazis should be allowed to distribute literature.

"The first amendment protects unpopular speech," Lynch said, "even speech advocating violations of principles of equality on the basis of race and religion."

"Freedom of speech must be protected for all groups, no matter how unpopular or obnoxious their views may be," Tabak and Barczak said they thought community safety was more important than a 1968 informal opinion by the attorney general advising that the Nazis, as a political party, were eligible to rent space.

Tabak said the Nazi group was not a political party because, although it was registered with the State Elections Board, it had not filed an up to date financial report.

"How do you expect to control an already explosive situation that up until this time has mainly been confined to private gatherings in the metropolitan Milwaukee area rather than thrusting it into the largest publicly attended event in the state?"

No additional security besides the regular State Fair Police has been called in because of the presence of the Nazis, according to George Brenard, fair publicity director.

The Jewish booth, operated by the Milwaukee chapters of the Concerned Jewish Citizens and the Zionist Organization of America, remained open last night but was not in operation today.

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Bypassers hurled taunts at the small group in the Nazi booth yesterday, creating concern among state fair officials that fights would break out.

Following the closing, a spokesman for the fair said it believed "there were more appropriate times and circumstances for the expression of political and social views."

A spokesman for the Nazi group said it had pulled out "for the good of the state fair."

## Nazi, Jewish Fair Booths to Close

The Nazi Party and a Jewish group agreed Thursday night to close their booths at the State Fair after a Milwaukee man was arrested as he allegedly assaulted a Nazi booth worker.

State Fair officials emphasized that the agreement by both sides to discontinue operations for the duration of the fair was voluntary.

By the fair's 10 p.m. closing time, the Nazis had removed their materials in keeping with the agreement.

The Jewish group was expected to remove its display Friday morning.

The arrest occurred when the man climbed over the Nazi display counter and tried to choke a booth worker, police said.

The altercation climaxed a day of frequent angry arguments between fairgoers and the Nazis.

The Nazi booth, sponsored by the local chapter of the National Socialist White People's Party, drew some of the biggest crowds of any booth on the fair's opening day.

The Jewish booth, a dozen

booths away in the south wing of the Exhibit Hall, drew sparser, more somber crowds.

Earlier efforts by public officials and representatives of Jewish organizations to force the Nazi booth to close were thwarted by a state attorney general's opinion that such a move would be an infringement of free speech.

The statement issued by fair officials Thursday night said the Nazis agreed to close their display "for what they called 'the good of the State Fair.'"

Upon being advised that the Nazi booth would be closed, the Jewish group agreed to close its booth, also stating it

would be for the good of the fair, the statement said.

"The State Fair emphasized that it will continue to respect the rights of free speech and free assembly of all groups," the statement said.

People stood six and seven deep at times in front of the Nazi table that sold "White Power" T-shirts for \$3 or "White Power" bumper stickers for 35 cents, alongside Adolf Hitler's "Mein Kampf."

The young men in the booth with red swastika armbands often found themselves deluged with mostly hostile remarks by visitors to the booth.

A uniformed policeman stood a short distance from the Nazi booth all day Thursday, keeping an eye on activity there.

The debates usually started

after one of the Nazis erupted into a tirade on how the brain of a black person is physically smaller than that of a white man.

The Nazis called the black race inferior and said the Jews "have eased their way into power and must be forced out."

A black man, obviously gritting his teeth to restrain himself, tore up a leaflet, tossed it on the Nazi table and said, "This is my country, too, and I'm staying right here. We can all work this out if we try, but this is not going to help any."

He walked off as most of the 30 persons remaining at the booth applauded.

After standing in the background for some time, a middle aged man in a tattered straw

that pointed at one of the Nazis and screamed:

"Do you read the Bible? Just tell me. Have you ever read the Bible?"

"No," replied the young Nazi. "I don't need to read it. As long as I don't rip off anyone, no bad can come to me."

"Ahhh!" the man cried, as he threw up his arms and stalked off.

Directly next to the Nazi booth was the information booth for the Wisconsin National Guard. A spokesman there said that as far as he knew, "it's just coincidence" that the guard booth was assigned that spot.

A dozen booths down the corridor from the Nazi display was the one sponsored by the Concerned Jewish Citizens and the Zionist Organization of America.

The Jewish group showed a strip of bulldozers shoving bodies into huge graves, children starving in Nazi prisons and families being hanged by a noose.

Usually, far fewer persons were at the Jewish booth than at the Nazi booth.

The difference seemed to be that many of those who left the Nazi booth were angry while many of those who left the Jewish booth were

## Nazi Party to Have Booth In State Fair Exhibit Hall

The local Nazi Party has rented an exhibition booth at the 1975 Wisconsin State Fair, fair officials confirmed Tuesday.

"We were told there was no way we could prevent them (the Nazis) from renting a booth as long as they abide by all the rules of the fair," said George Brenard, fair publicity director.

Brenard said fair officials had consulted the attorney general's office on rental of a booth to the Nazis.

He said the Nazis were registered as a state political party and thus must be rented space like other political parties.

The Nazi booth will be in the south wing of the Exhibit Hall.

Brenard said he did not know what activities would take place at the booth. "I imagine they will do what other political parties do," he said.

Fair regulations limit the passing out of political materials by candidates or parties to booths and prohibit such activity elsewhere on the grounds.

In 1968, fair officials attempted to deny exhibition space to Kaleidoscope because they said the contents of the underground newspaper were "inappropriate for children or family units."

The fair permitted the newspaper to be sold at a booth at

ter the attorney general's office said it would be unconstitutional to ban its sale unless it violated some law.

### St. Louis Unit Declares War On Marxism!

On 19 July, Comrade Michael Allen led members of the St. Louis unit in a declaration of war on Communist-Jew treason, represented by the marxist Socialist Workers Party.

Announcing the unit's intention to the press to promote legislation to completely outlaw the rampant marxism throughout the city, Comrade Allen was subjected to a bitter attack from local Reds, resulting in over \$500 damage to his car and subjecting him and his family to unending terrorizing phone calls from the cowardly swine.

On 19 July, beginning at 8:00 a.m., local radio KXOK aired taped recordings of comrade Allen's declaration of war on communist traitors. The station also aired frantic demands from Jew SWP leader Peter Seidman for police protection for his marxist followers.

The ST men began picketing the SWP headquarters later in the day, where a motley gang of about 20 Reds gathered. Although the marxists heavily outnumbered the ST, their defense consisted solely of heckling and obscene gestures.

While the picket progressed, comrade Allen was interviewed by newsmen of TV station 2, which aired an objective report on its evening newscast, laying emphasis on the Party's pro-White, anti-communist, anti-Jewish platform.

### No Escape

Until modern anti-Semitism, Jews attempted to escape Jew-hatred by converting. In theory, the fact that the Jew now "saw the light" and adopted Christianity, guaranteed that he would be accepted by non-Jewish society. Modern anti-Semitism put an end to that by postulating a "racial Jew" which meant nothing less than "once a Jew always a Jew." Jewish blood became the criteria now so that mere religious conversion was irrelevant. Thus, in Germany, Jews who had converted or whose grandfathers had converted and who were happily assimilating and forgetting their Jewish past were shocked to be told by Adolf Hitler that they were — in his eyes — still Jewish.

The American Nazis, in the form of the Nationalist Socialist White peoples Party (NSWPP) slavishly follows the old Nazi ideology and a clear indication of its thinking may be seen in a recent issue of the White Power paper, organ of the Nazis.

In an article titled "Jewish Cabal Rules America," the Nazis begin by stating that the "real power" in America does not lie with the elected officials but with the appointed men. Then they proceed to tick off a list of government officials and say:

"Perhaps you noticed a pattern here. There is something that everyone of these persons has in common. As if by some strange coincidence, each one happens to share the same ethnic background and they aren't Irish or German or English or Swedish or French. Mysteriously, they all turn out to be Jews."

Now since among the prominent officials mentioned are such names as James Schlesinger and William Simon, we are at a loss to understand what the Nazis mean by talking about "Jews". But the explanation comes immediately:

"In several instances they profess Christian affiliation. William Simon claims to be a Catholic, Casper Weinberger an Episcopalian and James Schlesinger a Lutheran. But all of them are racial Jews."

And the Nazis add yet another lulu:

"In this respect it is interesting to note that according to Stephen Birmingham...our unelected Vice President Nelson Rockefeller is

descended from Marrano Jews of Portugal and Spain.

"Is it really just one big coincidence that such an enormous monopoly of political power has devolved upon these Jews to the exclusion of persons of other ethnic backgrounds? Hardly, unless we are to continue to believe in Fairy Godmothers and happy tales of good guys in white hats winning democratic elections."

The "racial Jew" becomes, therefore, the last blockage of the Jewish "escape" hatch. The Jew who seeks to escape his heritage and identity is suddenly trapped by the Nazis who make it clear that there is nothing that will save him from their sick minds and racial obsessions.

The article, by the way, is "embellished" by three photos of Kissinger, Arthur Burns and Schlesinger. The captions under them read:

"Henry Kissinger — As Secretary of State, this Jew dictates America's foreign policy. He is responsible for the fiasco in Vietnam as well as for the sellout of U.S. interests to the Communist superpowers Russia and China.

"Arthur Burns — As chairman of the powerful Federal Reserve System this Jew controls the money supply of the entire United States. By manipulation the prime interest rate he can cause inflation and mass unemployment.

"James Schlesinger — As Secretary of Defense and head of America's military establishment, this Jew sabotaged U.S. defenses against communism in Western Europe by diverting arms supplies to Israel during the October 1973 war."

Yet another favorite target of the Nazis is Attorney General Edward Levi who comes under fire for such things as the following:

"And who is so anxious to disarm the White people of this country by taking their private firearms away, and who is responsible for sending the FBI around to spy and play dirty tricks on so-called free Americans who happen to oppose forced busing and race mixing? You guessed it — none other than our new Attorney General Edward Hirsch Levi."

The Nazis campaign against the Jews is in high gear and the time to put an end to them by any means possible is now.



# Nazi Rally Against Marxism

At the hub of the Central West End, the American Nazi Party yesterday took what its leader here described as "the first step to have Marxism outlawed, completely forbidden, in St. Louis."

Michael Allen, marching up and down in front of the Socialist Workers Party headquarters at 4660 Maryland Avenue in full Nazi uniform, said that the Nazis in St. Louis intend to continue picketing the Socialist Workers, and will soon "arrange a meeting with Mayor John Poelker for the introduction of legislation banning Marxism." Allen said that his organization would open a bookstore carrying Nazi writings and establish a 24-hour-a-day "White Power" telephone number for recruitment of members.

Allen, 23 years old, a Breckenridge Hills factory worker, and his lieutenant, Jerry Brinkley, 21, also a factory worker, wore high black paratrooper boots, black trousers, khaki shirts with swastika armbands and white helmets with chin guards.

Peter Seidman, an organizer for the Socialist Workers Party here, stood on the sidewalk with other members of his party, as well as teenagers in shorts and bare feet and well-dressed shoppers who had stopped to watch.

Seidman said that a serious escalation of violence nationally against members of his organization had caused him to seek police protection when he learned of the Nazis' plan to picket yesterday.

"The Nazis have issued a death threat against our leadership and carried out armed attacks in Boston and Los Angeles. In view of the record, their presence as a

force constitutes a threat," he said before the Nazis arrived.

But the two marchers, carrying signs "Hitler was Right," outlaw Marxism" appeared less threatening than amusing to some of the passers-by.

"They gotta be kidding," said Miss Myra Robnak, 26, looking at them with a slack-jawed grin of amazement. "And look at that American Flag on his shirt. Get that — an American Flag and a swastika. Ridiculous, absurd."

Another woman emerged from a florist shop carrying a large cactus, gingerly walked between the two Nazis, and got into a large black station wagon. She opened the door,

cried, "You make me ashamed to be a German," slammed it and drove off.

Nearby Mrs. Mary Carr, 37, of Black Jack, stood passing literature of the party, officially called the National Socialist White People's Party.

She wore moccasins, blue jeans and a yellow polo shirt against which hung what she described as a "Nazi mother's cross — if you had eight or more children you were awarded one. I have had 13,

so I passed," Mrs. Carr said.

She said that she is a Nazi Party member because "I am against race-mixing and Jews controlling America."

A crowd gathered around her and someone asked how she intended to achieve an all-white America. "You strive for it, you work for it, you go out in the streets and die for it," she said.

But there was no violence on Maryland and Euclid Avenues yesterday, just verbal jousts.
