## Register Now for the Seventh Continental Congress!

Enclosed with this *Bulletin* are the registration forms for the Party Congress to be held in Washington, DC, from 3 to 5 July. All full and probationary Party Members, Official Supporters, members of the National Socialist Youth Movement, members of the National Socialist Women's Organization and Stormtroopers — in good standing and signed up before 1 April 1976 — are invited to attend and are urged to fill out the form and send it to NHQ as soon as possible. (If you are presently not in good standing, send your dues or pledge in to National Headquarters right away so you'll be able to attend. If you have signed up on or after 1 April 1976, and are in good standing, you may still attend upon the accepted recommendation of any full Party Member in good standing.)

The registration fee is only \$10 this year for the two days — *which includes two meals*. For just \$5 extra — or a total of \$15 — an attendee may take part in a series of workshops on Monday, during which breakfast will be served. (The low registration fee was decided upon to help cut costs for those comrades who must travel a great distance to reach the Congress site and to encourage a *maximum* attendance.)

This Congress promises to be the most exciting ever, due to the fact that it occurs in the midst of America's Bicentennial celebration. The public rally and demonstrations planned for the holiday weekend have a far greater potential for reaching White people than that of any previous Party demonstration, as the Nation's capital will be overflowing with tourists and spectators on hand for the festivities. Just as significant is the fact that the entire country's attention will be focused on the events in and around the District of Columbia. This means the media will be out in force, and the Party will undoubtedly receive extensive coverage. To make the best impression, to have the greatest impact on the Whites of America we must have a *record turnout* to the Congress. Every National Socialist should consider it his patriotic and racial duty to attend and participate.

### MILWAUKEE NATIONAL SOCIALIST ECLIPSES REDS IN RACE FOR MAYOR!

In a seven-way contest, Party Comrade Arthur J. Jones won two and a half times the total votes of two Marxist candidates for mayor of Milwaukee and shut out a third candidate whose sole announced purpose was to stop Jones.

The two Red candidates, Teana Wright and Bernard Senter, representing the U.S. Labor Party and the Trotskyite Socialist Workers Party, garnered a mere 3.6 percent of the vote between them in the 17 Feb. primary, while anti-NS stooge, Douglas Tebo, got just 4 percent. Jones received 4,765 votes, or 5.5 percent of the total, placing fourth in the race. Runnerup Jan Olson, who will face incumbent Mayor Henry Maier in the 6 April general election, got only 11 percent of the votes, while a third candidate received a 6.4 total. Local Jews sponsored Olson and gave him their bloc support in an anxious effort to keep Jones out of the general election.

Bad winter weather caused a record low voter turnout of just 32 percent. Whether Jones could have overcome the Jewish bloc vote if every eligible person had voted — giving him a projected 14,871 votes — is problematical. With a normal turnout, he would have received nearly 10,000 votes!

It should be borne in mind, of course, that many sympathetic Whites — especially young people and others disgusted with the whole political process — weren't even registered. Conservatively, these people number at least 10,000. If we add them to sympathizers among Milwaukee's registered voters, we come up with a figure of roughly 25,000. This doesn't even include the White suburbs. If we take the entire metropolitan area into consideration, we can reasonably assess current NS sympathy in Milwaukee at approximately *40,000 persons!* The big job now is to recruit them.

Starting from scratch less than two months earlier, and despite the lack of financial and organizational resources, the National Socialist White Peoples Party was nevertheless able to mount a campaign which turned a ho-hum, politics-as-usual contest into a desperate "stop the Nazis" drive by our enemies. And that is perhaps the best comment on our whole operation. It was a great start for our Milwaukee comrades. We wish them well as they continue their wonderful efforts to further the Cause of National Socialism.

In the meantime, Comrades Tony Schmitt and Art Jones wish to express their personal thanks to all those National Socialist comrades around the country who contributed to the election fund and gave them their support.

# Paper Critical of Nazi Votes

The vote received by Nazi candidate Arthur Jones in Milwaukee's February mayoral primary apparently is causing concern in other parts of the country.

According to Religious News Service, the Courier-Journal, official newspaper of the Catholic Diocese of Rochester, N.Y., carried this comment in its March 1 issue:

"We think that when an American heartland city can come up with 4,765 votes for an avowed bigot in a light primary vote, there is indeed something rotten in the State of Wisconsin. And the time to worry is now."

The newspaper apparently thought Jones came in third. Actually, he placed fourth. Roman R. Blenski was third with 5,545 votes.

The paper recalled Jones' television ads showing him "with an American flag on one side and a Nazi flag with a huge swastika on the other."

And it rejected suggestions that many Milwaukeeans voted for Jones because he had a common name, not knowing his views. The paper called that possible explanation "perhaps... true Chamber of Commerce puffery."

To The Journal: I would like to comment on a recent letter about the Milwaukee Nazis. Mrs. S. K. stated that Milwaukeeans must now be humiliated by this small group of sick troublemakers with nothing more to do than revive the ugly ghost of Nazism.

I would like to ask why we have so many movies about Nazis. My son even went to see "The Hiding Place." He went with his sophomore German class. I am Austrian, and I was seven years old when I was put into a concentration camp. I was in the camp with about one million people for nearly three years. I was held by the Communists.

My grandparents, my sister and 500,000 Germans died. Do you hear us complain? Did you ever see a movie about us in the concentration camps? The Jews never tell you what good Hitler did for the people—the many apartments, houses and factories he built. Millions of people had work after the depression in Germany.

Now in the US 32 years after the war's end, they still try to brainwash the school children about Hitler and the Nazis. I would recommend that Mrs. S. K. and all the other people like her study both sides of nazism before expressing their views to the public.

# Big Maier Margin; Olson Second

As expected, Mayor Maier rolled up a huge vote margin in Tuesday's primary election, while Jan Olson, a plant security guard, finished second.

The two will face each other in the April 6 general election. Maier will be an overwhelming

favorite to win his fifth four-year term in City Hall.

Arthur Jones, 28, candidate of the National Socialist White People's (Nazi) Party, finished fourth behind Maier, Olson and Roman Blenski.

Olson, 30, was backed by the Coalition of Organizations

Against Nazism, which worked for the defeat of Jones.

The Nazi issue provided just about the only interest in the mayoral primary contest dominated by Maier.

None of Maier's six challengers ran major campaigns, but Jones probably ran the strongest of the six.

The Nazi candidate was able to afford professionally prepared radio commercials and newspaper ads.

His candidacy added to the growing visibility in recent years of Milwaukee's tiny Nazi movement.

Capitalizing on the recent Milwaukee school desegregation order of Federal Judge John W. Reynolds, Jones said he would encourage massive civil disobedience if forced busing was ordered in Milwaukee.

A Vietnam veteran, Jones called himself "the white people's candidate" and urged elimination of affirmative action programs aimed at hiring women and blacks.

Jones said Milwaukee Jews should match their contributions to Israel with donations to Milwaukee. He used the Nazi swastika in his campaign literature.

Jones works for a fast food chain.

Olson, a former high school teacher and a local Democratic Party activist, did not enter the race as an anti-Nazi candidate but the anti-Nazi coalition rallied around him.

# Nazi Supporters Frightening, Too

Arthur J. Jones, confirmed Nazi, racist and anti-Semitism supporter in his candidacy for mayor of Milwaukee by 4,765 votes.

It is frightening and incredible that so many Milwaukeeans supported a man whose party's announced goals are the deportation of blacks to Africa and hatred of Jews.

That support means there are 4,765 persons running loose in the city who apparently are waiting for the return of Hitler or a reasonable facsimile.

But the thought is so outrageous that most people here believe that this horror,

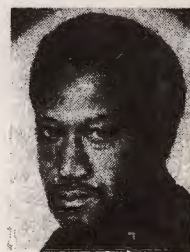
this Godless pursuit, will go away like a bad dream.

A year ago it was believed that there were only a handful of card carrying Nazis in Milwaukee and another dozen or so closet supporters. But the mayoral race has unveiled others.

What sort of person would follow a party whose history is bathed in blood and shows little sign of changing?

More important, what can be done about a legion that advocates the death of others?

Nothing, quite obviously, unless the Nazis put their

beliefs into action. Announced intent is not enough to warrant action by the police unless the threat is directed against a US president or a celebrity.

Consequently, Jews will have to look over their shoulders, each hoping he or she will not be the catalyst for police to act.

But not so strangely, authorities do not wait for an act of violence when a militant black group is doing the threatening. They are quickly on the scene with hobnailed boots, riot helmets, shotguns and dogs.

Yet authorities have reacted tamely toward the Ku Klux Klan, a group that parades in bed sheets and pillow cases and holds rallies at which the speakers announce their intentions against blacks.

Apparently the hands of law enforcers are tied when it comes to routing militant white groups that threaten harm, but all the stops are pulled for black groups.

I wonder how Jews feel about that arrangement.

# Milwaukee Jews Unite To Shunt Nazi Off Ballot

MILWAUKEE, Wis. (P-O) — faced with a Nazi running for mayor, the Jewish community temporarily abandoned its fratricidal argument over how to respond to resurgent Nazis here, and united to deal this particular one a resounding defeat.

Arthur J. Jones, an official of the National Socialist White People's Party, came in fourth in a field of seven candidates in the Milwaukee primary election.

MAYOR HENRY MAIER, a man with national recognition easily topped the field, as expected, with 60,112 votes.

Jan Olson, a former teacher and currently an industrial plant guard, won second place with 9,543 votes and will mount the hopeless challenge to Maier in April's election.

The Nazi, Jones, got 4,765 votes, finishing behind the third ranked candidate, Roman Blenski, who got 5,545 despite the burden of a conviction for illegal charity solicitations. Three other also-rans split 6,000 votes between them.

In the last couple of weeks before the election the Jewish community was faced with the distinct possibility that the Nazi might top the field of non-descript opponents to Mayor Maier and thus gain a platform for expounding his anti-Semitic and racist philosophy for two more months. A Nazi candidate would also embarrass the city nationally.

REPRESENTATIVES from various parts of the community surveyed the field and agreed to join in a Friends for Olson Committee to push his candidacy.

The problem was that Olson was a complete unknown, with

no platform except that "Maier has been around too long." Olson also had no organization and no money for advertising. Another problem was that Maier, a friend of the Jewish community, might not understand its abandonment of him to advocate votes for an unknown.

A whirlwind campaign raised several hundred dollars for Olson in a week, and a small amount of newspaper and radio advertising was bought. The entire Jewish community was also circled to advise it that the best way to keep the Nazi off the final ballot was to vote for Olson. Both daily newspapers seconded the advice editorially.

JONES, MEANWHILE, filed an official report that showed he had collected \$2,629 for his campaign, with more to come, far more than the other challengers to Maier. He placed more newspaper and radio advertising than all other candidates except the mayor.

National headquarters of the Nazi party, in Arlington, Va., printed \$814 worth of campaign literature for Jones. No print shop in Milwaukee would accept the job because the literature carried the Nazi emblem. Most of the other donations were from the small band of known Milwaukee Nazis.

Jones attempted to capitalize on a federal court decision that demanded school integration and may lead to forced busing. Observers said that might have brought some votes, and that his showing certainly was no indication there was any significant Nazi sympathy here.

JEWISH PRECINCTS turned in respectable votes for Olson, but Jones was no threat in any precinct, as it turned out.



### Three-year Plan Moving Slowly

The Party's drive to raise \$88,888 by 1978 is lagging a bit. During the months of January and February \$1,664.17 was raised, which is only 33% of what we should have raised in the same time period. This amount gives us a grand total of 12,768.68 collected so far.

All National Socialists who have contributed to the Plan can take pride in the fact that they have helped out in this extremely important project of the Party. But it should be noted that many comrades have not yet done their share. We hardly need to remind them of how vital this drive is to the ultimate success of the Party and to the future of the White race.

### Court Victory in El Monte

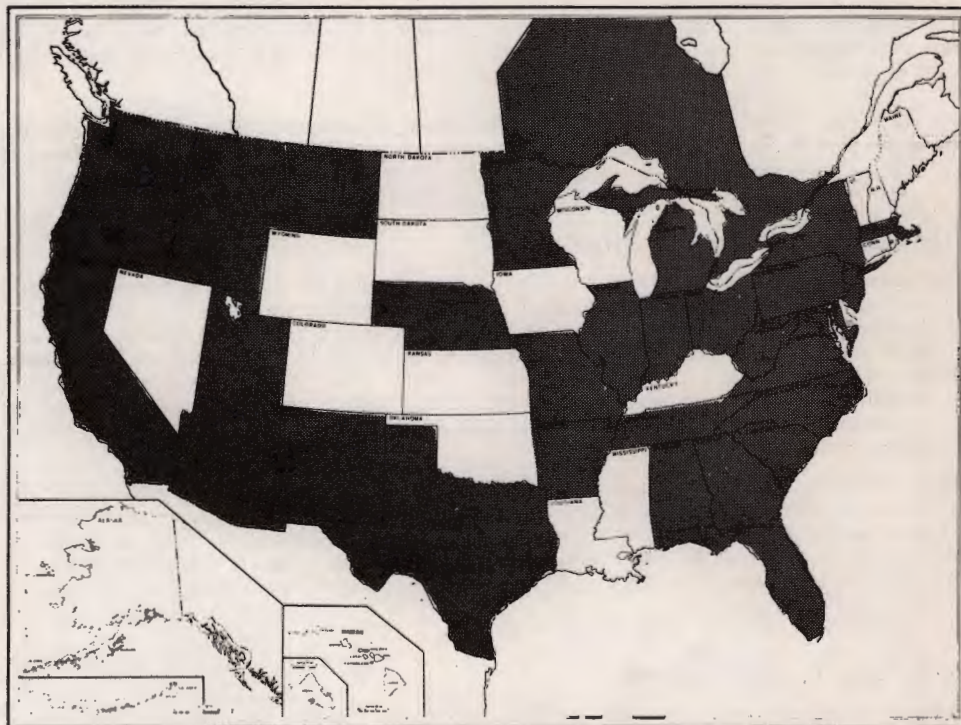
After nearly a year of legal battles, the Los Angeles Unit has won the right to distribute the Party newspaper in the city of El Monte, and collect voluntary contributions of 35 ¢ a paper.

In the past, the city had arbitrarily maintained that the distribution of WHITE POWER was illegal. To test this anti-NS stand, TL Martin Kerr allowed himself to be arrested in March of 1975 by "selling" the newspaper on a El Monte street corner. He was charged with conducting a business without a license.

TL Kerr went to court in April, 1975, and appeared before a Jewish prosecutor and an extremely hostile judge. The judge was so anti-NS that he refused Comrade Kerr the right to a public defender, even though he could not afford to hire an attorney.

## C.L. Gold

National Headquarters was saddened to hear of the recent death of long-time Party Supporter C.L. Gold of Shelby, NC. Comrade Gold, who was involved in the Movement since the time of Commander Rockwell, died suddenly on 14 February after a brief illness. He will be remembered by National Socialists as they carry on the fight for the Cause to which Comrade Gold had devoted himself.

He was also refused a jury trial, despite the fact he requested one. Forced to present the Party's case on his own, Kerr argued that distributing a political newspaper and collecting donations is not a business and therefore would not need a license. He cited the El Monte municipal code and the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution to back up his stand. But the judge was not influenced by these points and found Comrade Kerr guilty and fined him \$25.

Although denied legal aid, Comrade Kerr appealed the decision on his own. On October 2, 1975, the case was heard by the appellate division of the Los Angeles County Superior Court, and shortly afterwards the decision of the El Monte municipal court was overturned. The Superior Court cited two reasons in reversing the decision: (1) Mr. Kerr was not carrying on a business by distributing the paper, and (2) he was illegally denied his right to a jury trial.

After some more legal hocus-pocus, taking nearly four months, the Party was finally granted the right to conduct paper sales in El Monte.

The Los Angeles Unit has meanwhile been keeping up its steady pace of activity. In the past couple months, several hundred papers have been sold in street-corner sales in Los Angeles, Hollywood and El Monte. Activists report that many White people were glad to see them standing up for the White race and gave them extra contributions. On several sales the ST utilized walkie-talkies to co-ordinate separate teams on different corners and to test their value in emergency situations.

Recently Party spokesman have given presentations on the Movement to interested students at Long Beach City College and East Los Angeles College. Despite the presence of Mexicans and Blacks in the audiences, no incidents occurred and their talks were well received by the White students.

Los Angeles ST have also been holding regular Stormtroop meetings on weekends at the local Party headquarters. Activities at the sessions have included calisthenics, long-distance running, boxing, marching, close-order drill and political indoctrination.

### Tracy Unit Attracting Attention

Tracy-Stockton Unit Secretary Rickey Cooper reports that the persistent efforts of local activists are resulting in widespread publicity for the Movement. The Unit's White Power Message service is in continuous operation and is reaching thousands of people every week. The message recently has become the center of controversy at a local radio station, KSTN, which has a call-in program offering the opinions of area residents. During the past weeks the radio program has received a flood of calls from people who wanted to give their views about the WPM. Jews, Blacks and liberals condemned the Party's pro-White viewpoint, while many White listeners called in support of the message. In the various comments, the WPM's telephone number was almost always mentioned. Since the program was aired several times a day, hundreds of people have heard the number and dialed the message to hear it for themselves.

Many Northern California activists have been using extensive amounts of Party literature to gain attention in their communities. In Fresno activists have distributed hundreds of WHITE POWER newspapers to concerned White residents in racially troubled neighborhoods and have stuffed leaflets and Boat Tickets in lockers at Fresno high schools. Similar distributions have been taking place in Sacramento. In response to this activity, the local chapter of the NAACP broadcasted a special television program on the "Nazi hate group" which was disrupting their integration efforts in area schools.
