Nazis Plan Bicentennial Rally in Park

Party Reserves a Site Across From White House

America's 200th birthday party has attracted some strange guests — the American Nazi party will hold a rally across the street from the White House on July 3 to celebrate the occasion.

The rally will champion white supremacy, its sponsors say, a version of the master race theory propounded by Adolph Hitler some years after the Declaration of Independence maintained that all men are created equal.

Those attending the Nazi gathering — along with other birthday guests celebrating elsewhere — will enjoy the comforting protection of the First Amendment to the Constitution under which the rights of free speech and

peaceable assembly are guaranteed.

NATIONAL Capital Parks confirmed this week that the Nazis, whose official name now is the National Socialist White People's Party, had reserved the northeast corner of Lafayette Park across Pennsylvania Avenue from the White House from 11:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on July 3. NCP is to issue a permit after see-

NCP is to issue a permit after seeing the organization's plans for physical structures on the site, such as the size of the stage. But this is just a formality, according to Mary Krug, an information officer for NCP.

National Capital Parks is the local arm of the National Park Service.

Krug said the Supreme Court has ruled that parklands must be made available to groups to exercise their First Amendment rights. The Park Service grants permits on a firstcome, first-served basis, she said. Only two things could lead to deni-

Only two things could lead to denial of a permit — that someone else has already booked the area, or that the Nazis present a clear and present danger to public safety.

NO OTHER organization has booked Lafayette Park during the period from July 2 through July 5. Krugsaid.

Continued From B-1 Nazi leader Matt Koehl told NCP that 1,500 members are expected to attend the rally. Koehl said the program would include marching and patriotic music, banners — and perhaps picket signs.

Kochl was not available for comment yesterday. A duty officer who answered the phone and declined to identify himself said, "We will be holding the rally to remind white Americans that this is their country.

"We want to take the opportunity of the Bicentennial to emphasize the true American heritage, which is essentially a white heritage. White men founded, built, fought and died for this country. The whole concept of America is the concept of the white people who created it."

The American Nazi party was founded by the late George Lincoln Rockwell in 1959. "Adolph Hitler is the founder of our movement. The swastika is the emblem," the duty officer said. The Congress is already receiving extensive media publicity, including the newspaper articles reproduced herein. Several Washington area TV stations have reported on the Party's preparations, noting the fact that a permit to hold a rally in Lafayette Park (adjacent to the White House) has been obtained. One station devoted over 5 minutes of coverage to the NSWPP when it interviewed Arlington Unit Organizer Frank Knight about the difficulties encountered with county officials in getting permission to participate in local patriotic parades. Nazis' Want Parade Spot White Peoples Party to March in Arlington, Fairfax City July 4 Parades?

"Storm troopers" for the National Socialist White Peoples Party who marched in Arlington County's Fourth of July parade last year claim they're encountering problems in their bid for a return engagement to this year's event to this year's event.

Party members have turned to Fairfax City for an invitation to that jurisdiction's Independence Day pa-rade, but will not be allowed to participate, a city official told the Jour-

nal Rita Sobel, organizer of the Arlington parade, has denied that members of the party — formerly known as the American Nazl Party — are being discouraged from entering the owner this war.

the event this year. Board members of Parade for Ar-lington's Independence Day (PAID) met Tuesday and told the Journal they will send a parade marching application to the National Socialist White Peoples Party (NSWPP) soon.

But Fairfax City spokesman Rob-ert A. Becker flatly said he will not send a parade application to the group.

"Obviously they want to march in the parade with their swastikas and their armbands, and I'll be damned if

I think that's appropriate to the pa-rade," Becker said. The NSWPP maintains its national headquarters in a small building at 2507 N. Franklin St., near the Claren-don great of Arlington

don area of Arlington. "We are a community organiza-

tion, and also a national organization with active units all across the United States," said Thomas Knight, Arlington organizer for the party. 'We want to participate in the pa rade as a community-based organization

Knight said it would be "only appropriate" for his group to take part in patriotic events during 1976, the Bicentennial year. "I think it actually conforms very

Sobel about a month ago to ask how to enter NSWPP marchers in the Arlington parade. Last year some 15 uniformed party members partici-pated, he safd.

Knight claimed Ms. Sobel told him the parade was probably filled up, but that she would call him later to

confirm that information. After their initial conversation, Knight said, Ms. Sobel never responded to messages he left on her automatic telephone answering ma-

"Nobody told him he couldn't be in the parade," Ms. Sobel said this week. "I didn't tell him anything. L didn't even talk to the man." She said shedidn't remember hear

ing any messages from the NSWPP

"If they (NSWPP) have had diffi-culty, we were not aware of it," said Norman Worthington, a director of PAID.

Worthington said that last year the party's marching unit "was in the parade, and we never had any diffi-

culty with them in the parade." Though some parade-watchers later complained about NSWPP's participation in the event, PAID members said, other groups were also the focus of criticism from spectators.

Knight said that, in last year's parade, "we were very well-received in fact, so well-received that it sur-prised me."

He said spectators "came up and asked us questions, and some of them even those our hands. A lot of them offered money to us for a copy of our newspaper."

In Fairfax Clty, Becker predicted, the presence of the marching "storm troopers," would probably not be so

troopers, would propaply not be so well-received. "The citizens would react with some degree of indignation, and rightfully so," he said. "It would

The parade "has a great deal to do with Democratic ideals. I hardly see how the American Nazi philosophy contributes to that theme," Becker said.

Becker said he consulted with Ms. Sobel about the NSWPP marchers and was told he should allow them to

"She told me I don't have any choice but to let them in our parade because it's a Constitutional issue," he said

Arlington parade organizers "obvi-ously led them (NSWPP) to believe their parade was closed, and now it appears they're trying to palm them off on me," he said. Knight, 25, and a party member for

five years, said local residents may be the victims of the "Hollywood

stereotype of a Nazi," "People think of the sabre scar, the monocle and the German accent," he said. "We aren't the stereotyped

said. "We aren't the stereotyped hate-mongers that Hollywood and the newspapers portray us to be." If the NSWPP marching unit can-not appear in either of this year' pa-rades — both of which will be held July 3 — it will be "just an out-and-out infringement upon our rights." out infringement upon our rights,' Knight claimed.

He said local officials might fear NSWPP marchers would provoke citizen criticism, but "there's some-thing more important than that, and that's doing what's right."

"I can appreciate their positions but I cannot tolerate their stands," Knight said.

Duty Officer Jerry Jones, who shot and killed a deranged psychopath in defense of the Los Angeles headquarters, was released on 3 March from the L.A. county jail. He had been incarcerated for over 8 months awaiting trial before that date. Comrade Jones was found guilty of second-degree murder and sentenced to 5 years probation.

Two charges of assault with a deadly weapon have been dropped in the case of Duty Officer Clyde Bingham, who was also involved in the 15 August shooting incident. (He was locked up for over three months before being bailed out last November) However, the anti-NS prosecution in his case was not satisfied with the decision, and has charged him with "brandishing a weapon not in defense of persons or property". He is due to appear in court on May 13 to face this latest bit of harassment.

Los Angeles ST Confront Reds

On Saturday, 13 March, two teams of uniformed ST under the command of TL Martin Kerr held a demonstration in front of the Socialist Workers' Party bookstore in Pasadena.

The cowardly Trotskyites secured themselves in the safety of their building as the ST marched before them. During the one hour picket, chants of "White Power," "Communism is Jewish," and "We Want Dead Reds" were sounded by the National Socialists.

As the ST formed up to depart, four cowardly reds tried a sneak attack on the last member of the column, but were unsucessful due to the alert actions of the ST operations officer. The teams were only momentarily detained, and marched away without further incidents."

The SWP gave a slightly different account of the incident in their rag, The Militant, which is reproduced on the next page. That evening the L.A. Unit held a meeting which was attended by 37 National Socialists and Party sympathizers. During the gathering a battle offering was collected and 3 probationary troopers took the Stormtroop Oath.

Power," "We want dead reds," and "Communism is Jewish." The Nazis picketed for about an hour, then lined up in military formation. After receiving whispered instructions from the leader of the group, they turned and marched single file past the bookstore.

Manuel Barrera, a socialist campaign supporter, was standing to the side of the picket line waiting for the Nazis to leave when one of them shoved him with his elbow. Barrera moved back, further away from the line of the Nazis. The last Nazi in line struck the socialist with his elbow and knee as he passed him, then squared off with his fists up, waiting for Barrera to respond.

The socialist refused to be provoked. The Nazis then departed.

Barrera then went to the Pasadena police and filed charges against his assailant, providing the authorities with the license-plate number of the **VOLUME 40/NUMBER 12**

Nazi's car.

Police should have no problem identifying the Nazi, since they were given a picture of the attacker taken by a photographer.

This is not the first time Nazis have harassed Pasadena socialists.

On the evening of the bookstore's public opening, men later identified by the police as Nazis were seen writing down license-plate numbers of nearby cars parked there for the program.

The following night, air-gun pellets were shot through the office's front window.

The Nazi party has made Pasadena a focal point of its activity, exploiting the racism of the antibusing movement here

Meanwhile, a protest meeting has been called for March 19 against Nazi violence, and broad community sup-port for the meeting is being solicited by Pasadena socialists.

Party Subject of Documentary Film

Due to the increasing emergence of the NSWPP into the American political scene, two professional film-makers made the Party the subject of their latest movie. Titled "The California Reich," it specifically centers on activists and activities in San Francisco, Tracy and Los Angeles. It's makers claim it to be an objective documentary, but the film has many ragged edges which tend to represent the Party in a less than favorable light. Even so, the Jews have condemned it for its portrayal of National Socialists as average White Americans, the kind an audience might identify with, instead of in terms of Hollywood stereotypes.

The very first thing one must consider about Walter F. Parkey' and Keith F. Critchlow's powerful Oscar-nominat-ed documentary "The California Riech," which opens to-day at the Fox Village with a return engagement of "The Ban in the Glass Booch," is whether it should have been made in the first place. t Walter F.

German NS Trial

The trial of 9 National Socialist comrades in Germany during the months of January and February has concluded with the conviction of all nine, who were charged with attempting to revive National Socialism there, with the NSKG (Nationalsozialistiche Kampfgruppe).

The judge, however, imposed surprisingly light sentences of fines and suspended prison terms on seven of the men, and the other two he declined to sentence at all, despite their conviction, which he had the option to do under West German law.

On the last day of the trial comrades from all over Germany came, numbering almost 100 people, to give support and protest against the persecution of National Socialists under the Bonn regime. 50 were allowed into the visitors' gallery of the courtroom, while the rest passed out leaflets outside the courthouse, denouncing all anti-NS show-trials in Germany, before being stopped by the police.

Hess Anniversary

Local units are reminded that 10 May is the 35th anniversary of the 1941 peace mission of Rudolf Hess, who flew to Britain with an offer from Adolf Hitler to end the fratricidal war in the West. Britain's alcoholic Prime Minister Churchill, a puppet for Jewish and Communist interests, imprisoned Hess without a hearing. After accusing Hess of ficticious "war crimes" at Nuremberg during the infamous orgy of Talmudic bloodlust which sent eleven National Socialist martyrs to the gallows, he was imprisoned in the fortress of Spandau, where he remains to this day.

The weekend of 8-9 May is suggested for pro-Hess demonstrations and vigils to keep the world aware of the injustice perpetrated against the 86-year-old Prisoner of Peace.
