Victory of Faith in Chicago

Party Opens Up New Facility in Midwest

The Movement has just taken a great step forward with the opening of a new building in Chicago. This facility represents a significant material acquisition for the Party, and it will be invaluable as a center for National Socialist activity in the Midwest.

The building is a solid-looking, two-story brick structure. (See photos, next page.) Hundreds of hours were spent modifying the building to make it secure and squared-away. It has been made into an official outlet of NS Publications, and has a public bookstore where Party literature is sold to interested Whites. All in all, it is an impressive example of applied National Socialism. Party comrades are invited to see it for themselves. The location is: 2424 S. Central Ave. in suburban Cicero. Visiting hours are from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays.

This achievement is not just an accomplishment in itself, but also an inspiring indication of the kind of people we have in our Party. It was a victory of faith — the result of over two-year's work and sacrifice on the part of our Chicago comrades. Without outside help, they raised the thousands of dollars it took to buy the building out of their own paychecks — *at the same time meeting their individual membership and supporter obligations.* They have demonstrated in their work what it means to be a National Socialist, and have shown just what DEDICATION can do.

Even though the building has been purchased, the Unit is still working to pay off a mortgage of nearly \$20,000 on it. Commander Koehl has asked for assistance for our Chicago comrades from any National Socialist who can help out. If every person reading this *Bulletin* were to emulate their example, the debt would be wiped out overnight. So let's not let them down!

Commander Visits Midwest Units

Nazis Map Plans for Elections

American Nazis were encouraged by the showing of their candidate for mayor of Milwaukee and will consider entering other election contests, their national commander said here Wednesday.

Matthew Koehl, of Arlington, Va., head of the National Socialist White Peoples Party said the 4,765 votes cast for Arthur Jones, Nazi candidate for mayor in the Feb. 17 primary, were just the tip of the

iceberg of Nazi sympathy here.

He rejected speculation that many of the voters did not know Jones was a Nazi. Koehl said in an interview that the candidate featured the swastika in all of his advertising.

The party proposes to send all blacks to Africa and to relocate all Jews on an island somewhere. It contends that the atrocities of Hitler Germany were exaggerated.

states) he had the utmost praise for the tremendous job the Chicago Unit had done in acquiring the new Party facility. He called it a MIRACLE of faith and will.

Commander Koehl recalled that by coincidence, Chicago National Socialists had held a meeting next door on the Leader's birthday several years ago. Back then there was no Party building in the city. But it was the loyalty, steadfastness, devotion and HARD WORK on the part of our Chicago comrades that made that situation change. He commented that the new facility will help in the fulfillment of the Three-year plan's goal of building the Party, and that it will be important as a center of information in the coming mass movement phase.

On 20 April, the Commander attended an Adolf Hitler birthday celebration held by the Milwaukee Unit. In his speech, he commended the Unit on its recent election effort in which nearly 5,000 votes were garnered. He stated that the Party campaigns in Milwaukee, Baltimore and St. Louis were only the beginnings of the Party's plan to run candidates for various local offices. He added that it did not matter whether we won or not at this stage but that it was important that we use the electoral process as a vehicle for exposing the Party to the public and to gain experience for even larger campaigns in the future. The use of the Swastika, he said, was essential in Party election campaigns because it provides undeniable proof of sympathy for National Socialism in the community. Without it, the results of our efforts would have been meaningless.

He went on to cite other progress the Party has made in recent months, notably the acquisition of the new office in Chicago.

That same evening, Party Comrade Art Jones appeared on WITI-TV to give a rebuttal to a news story about the recent conviction of Unit Leader Tony Schmitt and ST Dale Enders. (For details, see NS Bulletin No. 201.) In his statement, he pointed out that the National Socialists were the victims of a Jewish frame-up, and condemned the the Jews for their sneaky, cowardly and un-American efforts to suppress the truth.

The next day Commander Koehl met with reporters from various media. In an interview with WISN-TV, he said he was highly pleased with the results of the recent mayoral primary race in Milwaukee. He noted that the votes the Party candidate received were symbolic of the vast sympathy for the NSWPP in Milwaukee, projecting a figure of approximately 40,000 as a realistic estimate of the number of persons with National Socialist leanings in the greater metropolitan area.

The Commander was also interviewed by the *Milwaukee Journal*, which resulted in the article on page 2.

Congress Demonstrations Given Green Light

After some delay, Arlington County officials have finally granted the Party permission to participate in the Bicentennial parade. However, they are trying to restrict our participation to 10 persons — which is only a small fraction of the number we expect to be taking part in the activity. The Party is now contesting this limitation, demanding the right to have as many participants as any other group.

U.S. Park Police officials, meanwhile, are preparing to handle the thousands of people they expect to be on hand for the Congress rally in D.C. on Saturday, 3 July. According to present indications, this could well be the largest public rally the Party has ever had.

Three-year Plan Progress Report

The Three-year Plan is still lagging behind schedule. During the month of April we raised a total of \$614.64 in contrast to last month's total of \$547.58. All Party comrades should remember that if their Party is to succeed, they will have to raise an average of \$2,500 a month between now and April 1978. So far we are falling way short of that quota. Every month that our goal is not met means that in future months we will have to work that much more. In times past, Party comrades have always come through when the Movement needed their help. If this spirit of sacrifice and dedication is once again rekindled, the Party will have no difficulty in succeeding in this drive.

To date, we have raised a total of \$13,929.20. As indicated on the map, a few more states are responding to the appeal for nationwide participation in this effort. However, some states have failed to come through this time, and other states have been conspicuously absent since the maps have been printed. Once again, all it takes to put your state on the map is for you to send in a donation toward the Plan. So don't let your state be left out!

Congress Registration Deadline Being Extended One Week

The deadline to register for the Congress has been extended from 18 June to 25 June. If you haven't yet done so, be sure to send in your completed registration form by that time. The registration fee is only \$10 for the Saturday and Sunday sessions. For \$5 dollars extra, you may attend the workshop sessions on Monday morning. If you can attend only one day of the Congress, the fee is just \$5. For those attendees who will be bringing their family along, there is no charge for children 4 years old and younger.

For those attendees who have reserved accommodations, arrangements have been made allowing them to go directly to their rooms upon arrival in the Washington area.

Those comrades who have reserved rooms, but have not sent in the \$20 deposit, should do so as soon as possible. If a deposit is not received by Congress time, we will have no choice but to sign the particular room to some other comrade(s).

Another Splinter Group Formed; Jews Cheer

Jews in the San Francisco Bay area and across the country were heartened by the recent news that a brand-new "Nazi" splinter group has been formed. Apparently some of the individuals who starred in the recently-released documentary film, *The California Reich*, got big heads after seeing themselves on celluloid, and decided they didn't need their other comrades around the country anymore.

The latest minigroup emerged after what was supposed to have been an appropriate and orderly Hitler Birthday celebration by the San Francisco Unit was allowed to turn into a wild drinking party. Inasmuch as the local leader demonstrated that he had lost all control of the situation, refusing to give even a simple explanation of what had taken place as requested, Commander Koehl relieved him of his post and replaced him with Comrade Frederick Surber, who has been in charge of the ST in the Bay area. The new unit mailing address is: Box 7041 - Spreckles, CA 93962. All National Socialists in the Bay area are asked to give Comrade Surber all possible help and assistance in his new responsibilities.

The San Francisco Unit had earlier been under suspension after its former leadership had allowed repeated violations of Party rules. Among these were failure to account for the expenditure of unit monies, permitting unauthorized persons to have access to the local mailing list, and allowing Party meetings to deteriorate into alcoholic parties - the latter being deliberately encouraged by anti-Party elements in spite of warnings against these infiltrators by National Headquarters.

As reported in NS Bulletin No. 200, a new FBI-ADL Cointelpro operation is now under way against this Party. Local units should be especially vigilant against any similar attempts in their areas to disrupt the Party.

Persons wishing to take pictures or recordings of the Congress functions should contact National Headquarters immediately for permission. No unauthorized photography or recordings will be allowed.

A map of the Washington-Arlington area is being sent out with this *BULLETIN*. Pinpointed on the map are the locations of National Headquarters and Lafayette Park, where the Congress rally will be held. Also shown on the close-up map of the District are the major tourist sites.
