SEVENTH CONTINENTAL CONGRESS HONORS AMERICA'S BIRTH

The Seventh Continental Congress of the National Socialist White People's Party was held in Arlington over the Independence Day weekend, 3-5 July.

Assembling under the slogan "FREE AMERICA!", delegates from all parts of the continent attended this historic gathering, held in conjunction with the Nation's Bicentennial celebration.

Party Holds Patriotic Demonstrations

On Saturday, 3 July, the Party participated in a patriotic parade in Arlington and held a rally in Washington, DC.

From 10 a.m. to noon, an ST honor-guard contingent, including a three-man drum corps and five flag bearers, represented the Party in Arlington County's Bicentennial parade. Our involvement in that community event went off without a hitch. The sight of squared-away ST men marching to a military-drum cadence, carrying American flags waving proudly in the breeze, drew continuous responses from the audience. Understandably, liberals, reactionaries and non-Whites were upset by what they saw, and replied with obscenities in disrespect of the occasion and despite the presence of women and children in the crowd. On the other hand, most of the Aryan citizens expressed their pleasure at seeing a parade contingent representing White Power. Out of over 100 groups involved in the parade, the National Socialist White People's Party was the only patriotic, anti-Communist, pro-White organization.

After the parade, the main body of the ST assembled in front of National Headquarters in preparation for the rally in Washington. The men were divided into three troops, identified by the color of their respective transport vehicles, painted red, white and blue. Each troop was given a specific task: Red's purpose was to provide initial security at the rally site, White's job was to guard the flags and Blue's was to set up the rally equipment. After the ST were thoroughly briefed by their troop leaders, ST Chief-of-Staff Cedric Syrdahl spoke to the men. He mentioned the possibility of violence being caused at the rally by Jewish or Marxist groups which had threatened the Party, and stressed the importance of being tough and determined in the face of the enemy. Reminding the men that the eyes of the Nation were going to be upon them that day, Capt. Syrdahl told them to remember that they represented our Race's finest and to act accordingly at all times.

After Capt. Syrdahl's inspirational instructions, the ST men boarded the transport trucks and rode into the Capital. As the column neared Lafayette Park, the rally site, a huge crowd on hand for the event came into view. It surged toward the trucks as they pulled up, but stopped short of the sidewalk when the ST men stormed out of the vehicles and formed into ranks. When the formation marched towards the center of the park the crowd readily parted to let it pass. Patriotic music blared from Party loudspeakers as the ST troops set up the rally platform, raised the flags and banners and formed a defensive perimeter.

When all was ready, the rally commenced before a crowd of hundreds. Harold Mantius of Mobile, AL, was the first speaker and acted as chairman throughout the rally. Other speakers included Baltimore Unit Leader Robert Lyons, Southern California District Leader Martin Kerr, Comrade Ralph Forbes of Arkansas and Comrade Art Jones of Milwaukee. The Party spokesmen each covered a different aspect of the racial-political situation America has faced during its 200 years of existence.

Nazis Draw Jeers In Gathering at Lafayette Park

The National Socialist White People's Party, armed with a parade permit for as many as 1,500 demonstrators, turned out about 50 brown-shirted helmeted members yesterday for its Lafayette Park "Bicentennial rally."

The demonstrators were substantially outnumbered by the U.S. Park Police who protegted them, the media who covered them and the crowd that booed and heckled them. There was one arrest for disorderly conduct when a man scuffled with an anti-

Nazi sign holder.
With the militant Jewish Defense
League intentionally absent from the
scene the Nazis were met at Lafayette Park instead by Christian evangelists holding aloft a banner that said, "Jesus Loves People."

"We think they need Jesus really bad Jesus loves all people, no matter who," explained Dick Flores, 21, a New

Orleans evangelist.
Other handmade signs that greeted
the swastika-wearing Nazis met hatewith hate. "Nazis Are Pigs," said one.

"Nazis Stink," read another.
After their participation in a Bicentennial parade in Arlington County vesterday morning, the Nazis arrived at Lafayette Park about 1:30 p.m., held their rally and departed in three trucks an hour later chanting, "White power! White power!"

The Nazis set up a small stage and

sound equipment in a grassy area on the cast side of the square. They then formed a ring around the platform, and stone-faced park police, including several black officers, formed a con-centric ring around them. While media camera crews and photographers fo-cused on the Nazis and park police, a metropolitan police film crew took pictures of the anti-Nazi crowd.

The speakers generally attacked Jews, who they said run the country, "niggers," The Washington Post, Time

POLICE PROTECT NAZIS

D.C.-The American Nazi Party held a rally directly across the street from the White House, on July 3. With the full protection of the National Capital Park Police. the Nazis were out "to remind America that its heritage is an essentially white heritage.

Over 500 workers, youth and communists, predominantly Angio-American, attended the rally, booing, jeering, and nearly disrupting the

In a show of contempt for the democratic ideals of the people of the US, the Nazis stated that, "as it was written in the Constitution, blacks are still three-fifths of a white man. They called for the rounding up and extermination of Negro and Jewish people. They urged all "true Aryans" to join them in their drive to restore "white power" and rid the country of a corrupt "liberal" government!

While many people agreed that the government, and especially the Republican and Democratic parties were corrupt, they militantly denounced what the Nazis stand for: vicious white chauvinism and fascist terror against minorities, workers and everything progressive in society.

The fact that the Nazis were allowed a permit from the government proves they have friends in high places. The permit was granted because they supposedly have constitutional rights and did not constitute a threat to "public property." Although they did not threaten property, they openly called for extermination of Negroes and other sections of the people. The Nazis, serving their capitalist masters, are shock troops against all progressive movements. They may not threaten "public property," but they are a clear threat to human lives, representing vicious terror and open murder,

The police and the courts saw no reason to prevent the Nazis from demonstrating, because they too serve the same masters. Prior to the monstration attempts were made to get a US District Court injunction to bar the demonstration. It was denied on the grounds that the 1st Amendment rights of the Nazis would be violated. But one week earlier, the same US District Court judge over-ruled the Washington City Council and abolished rent control. This allows city landlords to raise rents over 10% and get full compensation from the city's predominantly Negro residents. The class interests of the courts is clear!

At the demonstration 50 armed and helmeted police on horseback cordoned off and protected the Nazis from angry protesters!

from the raily and to take down picket signs, claiming that to picket was against the law the Nazis had the rights to the location. This was an overt demonstration of the real nature of the state apparatus. The tax dollars, the tremendous wealth produced by the workers, is used not for full employment, quality education and social welfara. No, this wealth is used to protect an organization dedicated to the murder of Negroes, the smashing of trade unions, the destruction of democracy and of all civil rights!

The working class must respond to this challenge; only a united movement of the workers and progressive people of this country can stop the development of fascism. It has already gone too far.

The national headquarters of the AFL-CIO is one block from the scene of the demonstration, but neither Meany nor any other labor buerau-crat took notice of this outrage, or organized their union brothers and sisters against these enemies of the unions.

Not one Negro organization was present to demonstrate. Neither the NAACP nor Urban League leadership was out front fighting. although the Jewish Defense League claims that they had contacted them. Apparently they had left town to celebrate the bicentennial of the revolution whose best accomplishments are in grave danger.

Despite the number of people present, there

was no organized, conscious resistance to the Nazis. This sort of spontaneous reaction must be transformed into a militant, organized force capable of defeating a highly disciplined enemy like the Nazis. If the workers and progressive people of this country are going to defeat the fascist offensive, they must begin now, on their blocks, in their clubs, unions, churches and PTAs. From the grass roots, Equal Rights Councils and Committees are meeting over the Labor Day week-end, to form the Equal Rights Congress. Only such an organization can begin to draw together the thousands and millions of people who hate fascism, chauvinism, discrimination, and want to fight against the Nazis, the Klan and all forms of oppression. The consolidation of the Equal Rights Congress represents a major step in the united defense of the Negro, the minorities, and of the entire working class and people of the US!

JDL Told To Boycott Nazi Rally

The militant Jewish Defense League ordered its members yesterday to stay away from an American Nazi rally at Lafayette Park today, charging that the sponsoring National Social-ist White People's Party had trained women and children "to serve as shields" in the expected "encounter."

Dr. William Perl, the 70-year-old chairman of the JDL of Greater Washington, who had earlier announced his group's intention to at-tend the rally and predicted a "bloodbath," said it was now "obvious that women and children hurt." would

"Therefore," Perl said in a statement issued yesterday, "the Jewish Defense League orders its members and asks all Jews to abstain from at-tending this Nazi rally."

Perl cited a report of a Nazi youth rally recently at 24th and N Streets NW and "our own intelligence" to back his assertion that children and women were being trained to be shields at La-fayette Park.

The "duty officer" answered the phone at the Nazi group's Arlington headquarters yesterday termed Perl's allegation "sheer stu-pidity, a lie."

"We do have a youth movement and a women's organization, but we don't train them to be shields or protect us. Our whole pur-pose is to protect them." said the man, who refused to give his name.

"A few days ago, they were screaming for Nazi blood," the man said. "This appears to be an empty ex-cuse for backing out of it. Hitting women and children has not stopped them in the past.

The Nazi permit from the Park Service is for up to 1, 500 demonstrators. The Nazi "duty officer" said some members would participate in Arlington's Bicentennial parade beginning at 10 a.m. today before the Lafayette Park rally, which is sched-

to 4.30 p.m. The Nazi spokesman said the two public appearances by the group were part of an "international congress" of Nazis from several countries meeting here today through Monday. The Lafay-ette Park rally "to most of us is the most important event," he said.

Ford Administration Okays **Nazi White House Demonstration**

WASHINGTON (JTA) - The Ford Administration rejected a demand by Washington area Jewish groups that President Ford rescind a permit for a eal neo-Nazis"White Power" rally in front of the

White House. The group was dressed in full Nazi egalia with storm trooper uniforms, swastika arm bands and Nazi flags for the demonstration timed for the Bicentennial weekend

The Administration's answer came at a meeting Sen. J. Glenn Bealt Jr. (R Md.) and Jewish com-munity leaders had with John Kyl, Assistant Secretary of the Interior and officials of the National Capital Parks Service and police. Members of Club Shalom, an organization of Holocaust survivors, made an impassioned appeal to Kyl for cancelling the permit

The Administration officials cited various park regulations and maintained that the permit would not be cancelled. A suggestion by Beall to change the location of the Nazi demonstration for a place

less central and safer was also rejected.

Dr. William Perl, chairman of the international council of the Jewish Defense League, said that the Nazi Party is a forbidden organization in all civilized countries," including Germany, He also stressed that "this is not a matter of offending Jews only, but all those who fought the Nazis in World War II and were killed by them," He said?'it is a betrayal of those buried here in Arlington Cemetery." Perl demanded that Ford personally step into the dispute and cancel the permit granted to the Nazis. Ford did not.

The audience was reminded that the Founding Fathers were all White racists who did not consider the Negro to be a person, but that today the rights of Whites were secondary to those of Blacks. The prophecy of Benjamin Franklin and other warnings concerning the Jews were quoted, noting that history has proved that their fears were not unfounded. If their advice had been heeded, the crowd was told, America would not be in a situation today where the Jews control the biggest banks, the media and the government. The famous remarks of such contemporary Americans as Spiro Agnew and General Brown about the Jews were used to further illustrate that fact.

This situation, the Party speakers said, all pointed to a need for a second American revolution, a revolution in the same sense and spirit of the first. But unlike the event of 200 years ago, this struggle would be to overthrow an alien, Jewish tyranny from within our Nation. Unless this revolution comes about and is successful, they said, White people of America were certain to lose their lives, liberties and the the right to control their destiny. The National Socialist White Peoples Party offers the only road to victory and salvation, the audience was told, and is preparing for this struggle now. If the Founding Fathers were alive today, one Party speaker said, they would be among the leaders of this National Socialist revolution today.

After the rally the ST boarded its trucks and returned to Arlington, chanting "White Power" and singing the Party battle song the entire way. Upon arrival at National Headquarters, the men disembarked and lined up once more in formation. Capt. Syrdahl called the troops to attention, and congratulated every man on his performance at the rally. The men were dismissed to attend the outdoor barbecue that had been prepared by members of the NSWO.

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
Violent reactions to the Party rally had been threatened by various groups, notably the Jewish Defense League, in hopes of intimidating U.S. Park officials into canceling our permit as a "precautionary measure against a possible illegal act." But they failed to bring this

about. The Jews had placed themselves in a bind — they suddenly realized they were going to have to back up their hot air that they were going to bring the rally to a bloody end. But the mere thought of taking on scores of disciplined Stormtroopers was enough to send the JDL kikes scampering off to Philadelphia for the weekend. In a pathetic attempt to cover up this cowardice, the Washington JDL leader performed a typically Jewish about-face and claimed he decided not to molest the Party "in the interests of preserving peace on America's 200th birthday"!

Other Jewish groups were slightly more subtle. They tried to pressure various government officials directly, including President Ford, into using their authority to cancel the Party's rally permit. But they too took no action against us, possibly because they were afraid of publicly challenging our constitutional rights. (For more details on these Jewish machinations, see the articles reproduced on page 2 and 4.)

There was no organized opposition to the Party rally, and Jews and Blacks only made up a small percentage of the crowd. A small clot of scum, consisting of pot-heads, gays and Bolshevik creeps congealed in a corner of the park and tried to cause annoyance. They held a few crudely made anti-National Socialist signs and attempted to drown out the Party speakers with chants. But they were too few in number and quickly became discouraged as the National Socialists hammered home point after point in favor of the Party's view. The rest of the audience, consisting largely of White tourists, heard the Party's message with no interference, and responded more and more favorably as the rally progressed.

Publicity of the event included widespread newspaper coverage, of which some examples are reproduced on pages 2 and 4. Two TV networks ran film-reports of the rally on their evening news broadcasts, which were seen over a large area of the East Coast. Local

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remarks was the National Socialist attitude, which he said is demonstrated above all by the qualities of determination, the willingness to serve and the performance of duty. This was exemplified by the famous saying in NS Germany, "I am nothing my Race is EVERYTHING!". He went on to say that for a National Socialist, nothing was impossible and that capitulation was unthinkable.

Southern California District Leader Martin Kerr spoke next on National Socialist solidarity. He described this as an intensified unity a determination to stand and fight. He further defined it by stating the four ingredients of solidarity: comradeship, ideological unity, discipline and loyalty. If any of theses characteristics was lacking in a member of the Movement, he said, his solidarity was broken. He warned that this is just what the enemies of National Socialism try to do — break our solidarity and thus weaken the Parly, As an example, Comrade Kerr named a few of the FBI-ADL COINTELPRO tactics used in attempts to do this, such as the setting up of splinter groups and rival organizations, causing dissent within the ranks with agent provocateurs and spreading rumors about Parly leaders.

Lastly, Party Comrade Ralph Forbes gave a spiritually uplifting speech entitled Faith, Loyalty and Perseverance. He metaphorically described the storm brewing over America today, and the necessity for National Socialists to think with the blood and the heart, to face the storm like eagles and soar above and conquer it. He concluded by asking all National Socialists present to join him in taking an oath of loyalty to the Party of Adolf Hitler and Lincoln Rockwell and to its Commander.

Sunday Morning Session Devoted to Local and Auxiliary Reports

The big event of the year, he said, was the city council race in which Comrade Wolfgang Schrodt won 7% of the total vote. The success of this election campaign has prompted them to plan to enter other races in the future. Comrade Lyons gave accounts of other activities

undertaken by the Unit, including a picket of Israel's Moshe Dayan and a vigil for a fallen policeman.

Chicago: Unit Leader Cedric Syrdahl outlined the tremendous progress the Party has been making in the greater ('hicago area. He said that the mood of the people of his city was beginning to change as a result of the persistent activism of the unit. The higgest accomplishment was, of course, the opening of the Midwest Regional Headquarters in Cicero. Capt. Syrdahl gave a complete history of the long struggle to acquire the facility. "Operation White Fence" as the project was dubbed, was started over three years ago when a visiting comrade made a donation to the Unit and suggested it be used to start a building fund. Every member of the Unit then raised \$1,000 each, and with a loan from a sympathetic bank agent, the downpayment on the building was made. Unit members worked every weekend on extensive remodeling that was needed until completion just before the building's grand opening on the Leader's birthday of this year. Capt. Syrdahl described the extensive facilities the new center has, which serves as an outlet for NS Publications. He added the comment that the new building would not become a clubhouse, as has happened with other organizations, but would be a base of operations in the Midwest Region and would be of invaluable service to the Movement in the years ahead. Our enemies have already come to realize this, as evidenced by the recent bomb attack on the center. In reference to that attack, Capt. Syrdahl paraphrased Nietzsche by saying "That which doesn't destroy us, makes us stronger." In conclusion, he asked for assistance in the task of keeping the building open, whether it be in the form of donations to help pay off the mortgage or by volunteering for full-time staff work at the headquarters.

Tracy-Stockton: Unit Secretary Rickey Cooper reported on the Party's situation in Northern California. He said that due to the large geographical area in which the unit operates, there are three separate P.O. boxes in different cities which the unit uses, Comrade Cooper then described several activities and speaking engagements undertaken by local Party comrades and told of the success of the White Power message units operating there.

Los Angeles: In his report, Unit Leader Martin Kerr described the difficult situation that existed when he returned from the Sixth Party Congress last year: two unit members were in jail with a combined total of \$110,000 bail set on them, manpower was extremely short and the Party was facing harassment from local authorities. Today, only 10 months later, he said, these problems no longer exist, partly as a result of four legal victories scored by the Party in L.A. The unit is stronger than ever now, and holds demonstrations, paper sales and speaking engagements regularly. Future plans for the unit include the acquisition of a more suitable local headquarters facility. In conclusion, Comrade Kerr thanked all Party comrades who had helped out the unit when it needed it the most.

St. Louis: Unit Leader Michael Allen reported that in recent months the St. Louis Unit has been holding activities regularly, at the rate of at least one a week, resulting in frequent TV and newspaper coverage. This publicity, along with the unit's other projects, is gradually winning the support of the White community. Among the more interesting efforts here was the local election campaign in which Comrade Allen won 6½% of the vote and the unit's continuing drive to outlaw Communism locally.

San Diego: Unit Organizer Gerald Pope spoke for the San Diego probationary unit. In response to the suggestion from the Commander that Party units seize upon a local issue of importance to White people, San Diego activists are concentrating on the problem of illegal.

immigration from Mexico. Newspaper ads, leaflets, demonstrations and a newly-acquired White Power Message unit are being used to publicize the unit's "Stop Illegal Aliens" campaign, with favorable results.

Minneapolis-St. Paul: Richard Persson, Secretary of the Minneapolis Probationary unit, gave an account of the recent rise of NS activism in the Twin Cities area. The most exciting of the several demonstrations held in the past year was the picket of a Zionist rally at which a number of fights broke out between the five ST men and some of the 8,000 Jews in attendance. Comrade Persson thanked the Milwaukee unit for much assistance in establishing a Party unit in his home town.

Milwaukee: Unit Leader Tony Schmitt stated that although the Milwaukee Unit had been involved in numerous activities since the last Party Congress, for reasons of time he could elaborate only on the most significant project undertaken by the unit this year: the primary election race for Mayor of Milwaukee. Comrade Schmitt said the unit started planning to field a Party candidate after a press

statement to a local newspaper in which the Commander said he would like to see the NSWPP challenge the Reds and Jews at the ballot box. The first step in fielding a candidate was to find a person with the necessary qualifications to run for public office. This was found in Comrade Art Jones, a Vietnam combat veteran and long-time Party activist. Next, they had to choose a position to run for — and without much hesitation the office of mayor was chosen, since it is the only position in the city that represents all of Milwaukee. After that, the unit began getting involved in the actual mechanics of a campaign. When it was learned that 1,500 signatures were required to put Art Jones' name on the ballot, the unit organized a petition drive, gathering the necessary endorsements from passersby on street corners and going door-to-door. The Jews got wind of this immediately, and launched a frenzied campaign to keep the National Socialist candidate from running in the contest. One of their first tricks was to try to disqualify the ballot petition on some inconsequential technicalities. This failed. In desperation, the Jews found some shabbas goy to run against Comrade Jones and spent thousands upon thousands of dollars in ads and other promotional gimmicks in hopes of denying the Party candidate a spot in the final election. The anit responded to this challenge by distributing over 70,000 specially designed campaign leaflets, broadcasting 114 radio and 12 TV commercials, and buying a large ad in the city's two major newspapers. This turned out to be the most visible campaign waged by any primary candidate in the election. It paid off with spectacular results — Comrade Jones beat out two Reds and a conservative Republican by winning almost 5,000 votes. Beyond that, the Party gained millions of dollars worth of publicity and won many new people lover to the Movement. Lastly, it proved three important points: (1) that it is not hard to run candidates for public office, (2) that there is a vast, invisible sympathy for the

Houston-Galveston: Organizer Jimmy Clendennen reported for the newly created Houston-Galveston probationary unit. In the few months of its existence, the unit has engaged in varied activities, including demonstrations against the Socialist Workers Party and the Democratic Party state conventions and attending as well as speaking at school board meetings. Comrade Clendennen said that in the future the unit plans to obtain a White Power Message and to field a candidate for local office.

Next came the auxiliary reports.

ST Chief-of-Staff Cedric Syrdahl gave a highly stirring speech on behalf of the Stormtroops, in which he outlined the historic importance of the ST in the future of America and our Race. In the difficult times ahead, we must look to Adolf Hitler and his example for inspiration, he said, for what the force of leadership did in the past can be done again here in this country. Wild applause greeted Capt. Syrdahl's closing remarks that "the ST must recognize that niggers and Jews have no rights. The ST are barbarians. We WANT to be barbarians — it is a NOBLE TITLE!"


The report for the National Socialist Women's Organization was given by National Organizer Loretta Syrdahl. She began by noting

the four-fold increase in membership of the NSWO since the last Party Congress, adding that a high percentage of the total membership has acquired or is obtaining a NSWO uniform. Activities of the NSWO, she said, have included the making of armbands and banners for the Party, helping to set up meetings and prepare meals at them, a picket of a Jewish race-mixer by the Milwaukee chapter and assisting in the remodeling of the Regional Headquarters building in Chicago. Mrs. Syrdahl concluded her report by naming one of the NSWO's most important tasks - that of setting a high moral and physical standard for White women everywhere and helping them to meet this goal.

The Congress then adjourned to an adjoining hall where a buffet luncheon was served to the delegates.

Commander Koehl Delivers State of the Party Address

The Congress reconvened at 2:30 in the afternoon. Chairman Mantius introduced Commander Koehl to the assembly, who proceeded to deliver the State of the Party Address.

The Commander began by listing significant accomplishments of the Party in the past year, notably, the success of the 1975 Fall Building Campaign which launched the Three Year Plan, the acquisition of a new Party center in Chicago, the three National Socialist election victories, and the establishment of set standards for viable unit structures.

The Commander then went over the two main problems faced by the Party: a shortage of manpower and money. He explained how a lack of personnel was adversely affecting Party operations at National Headquarters, as well as the Midwest Regional Headquarters, in several key areas and seriously hindering National Socialist growth potential. Concerning the financial situation, the Commander noted that while it is a fact that the Party now enjoys a higher income than it did in the early days, he reminded delegates that the Party has also grown considerably and that its needs have correspondingly increased. To enable it to recruit the professional help it requires, and to sustain further growth, greater financial means will be needed. The Three Year Plan has been instituted to overcome these two problems, and the Commander stressed the importance of everyone doing his share in that vital project.

The Commander went on to chart the direction the Party will take in the future. In the past - in Phase One - he explained, we sought publicity for publicity's sake. What we must do now in the Party's second phase is get good publicity, and disabuse people of false notions concerning National Socialism. We want to get people away from the Hollywood 'Nazi' stereotypes and win people over to our Party and create in them a desire to support us. The Commander continued: "We must become more American in our propaganda, addressing ourselves to American issues. Not in any cornball way or because this happens to be the Bicentennial year, but because we are Americans operating in an American political environment. We must sink deep roots into the national community and gain support by invoking its Aryan traditions and by using popular American symbols that the public can readily identify with.'

An area in which we must get involved in is elections, the Commander said. The success of this year's campaigns should encourage other local units to field candidates, he said, adding that it is really quite easy to get on the ballot. It is immaterial whether we win these elections right now, since the real value of election campaigns are the publicity and support they bring us as well as the public support they demonstrate.

A few developments in the past year should create significantopportunities for the Party. One of these is the increasing failure of the System to solve the basic problems of concern to White Americans, which is causing more and more people to look for a political alternative to the System's parties. The other development is the collapse of the Wallace movement. "We must move in and pick up the hard-core racists left behind by Wallace's political demise," he said.

Tying all these points together, the Commander said "We must build the Party step by step into an American institution and political force, as we continue to build steadily and consistently towards a true mass-movement phase." He reminded delegates to keep a true perspective of what we are trying to accomplish and remember that we are interested in what remains after the dust settles and all the hoopla dies down. He further reminded that "we are in a protracted struggle. To achieve our goals we must reject opportunistic adventurism and half-cocked, infantile terrorism, just as Lincoln Rockwell flatly repudiated these things. Commander Rockwell taught us a different way, to love our people, and to win their hearts and minds."

In conclusion, the Commander quoted a producer of a recent documentary film on the Party: "If the White people in the country found out what the National Socialist White People's Party stood for, a great number would be for it, it would become very dangerous." The Commander then said "Our job is to make the Party very dangerous to the enemies of the White race!"

Danish NS Leader Special Guest Speaker at World Union Session

Commander Koehl opened the afternoon session dealing with the World Union of National Socialists by reviewing that organization's functions and ideals. The National Socialist idea, he said, is valid wherever Aryan men exist on this earth. This universal Idea is represented in the World Union which Lincoln Rockwell founded in conjunction with European NS leaders in 1962. The Commander explained that while the task of the NSWPP is to advance National Socialism in America and to achieve political power; the purpose of WUNS is to uphold inviolate the National Socialist idea on a world-wide basis and to advance it philosophically and spiritually. He then concluded by introducing the next speaker, Povl Riis-Knudsen, leader of the Danish NS party and a man who has given invaluable assistance in developing the World Union of National Socialists.

Comrade Riis-Knudsen began his address by giving a typical European's view of America — a view that is distorted through the media which shows only the Jewish aspects of America, such as the materialism and perversion of cultural values that exist here. But he said there was another America not seen by Europe - an America made up of the finest Aryans, who were best represented by the comrades present in the hall. This is an indication of the paradox that America represents. While the world center of Jewish power is located in America, he said that nowhere in the world is there as much freedom to fight that power as in this country.

Comrade Riis-Knudsen then went on to describe the situation in Europe. That continent also has a severe racial problem, due to the unhindered flow of non-Whites from former French and British colonies. On the political front, National Socialism is much more hampered by the governments of Europe than it is in America. In many of those nations, National Socialism and the Swastika are illegal. In countries where it is not illegal, there exist "hate laws" which forbid the public discussion of the facts of race. Even if these obstacles were overcome however, and National Socialism were to gain power in a European country, it could not hope to withstand the inevitable reaction of a Jewish-controlled world, which would be to crush it militarily. This all points to one fact: that America is the only place in the world today where National Socialism can attain power and keep it. America is thus the battle ground of the White race, and the fate of Aryan man everywhere depends on what we now do here in America.

A report on the progress of the various National Socialist parties of Europe was then given by Comrade Riis-Knudsen. As part of his report on Germany, he read a letter addressed to the delegates of the Seventh Congress from Dr. Hans Severus Ziegler. Comrade Ziegler who was a close personal friend of the Leader as well as general manager of the Weimar Theater, and the man who set the guidelines for the purge of decadent and un-Aryan music in National Socialist Germany — encouraged American comrades to fight on uncompromisingly in the struggle of the National Socialist White People's Party and congratulated them for their service to the Movement.

After his speech, Comrade Riis-Knudsen presented Commander Koehl with a 4,500 year-old Aryan battle ax from prehistoric Denmark, as well as an Adolf Hitler commemorative medal as a token of comradeship from the National Socialists of Europe.

"The Lid on the Box"

The first speech of the Sunday evening session was given by Capt. Cedric Syrdahl, who predicted the fall of the decadent society that surrounds us. Drugs, degenerate music, anti-White TV programs were just symptoms of a diseased and dying civilization. National Socialism is the only solution to this state of affairs, he said.

The Captain then likened the National Socialist movement to a jigsaw puzzle. Each and every National Socialist represents a piece in this puzzle. Every one of us knows in heart what must be done but cannot piece the puzzle together by himself because he can only see a small portion of the complete whole. But a rare few men have seen the lid on the box that the puzzle came in and have seen the picture of what all the pieces would look like if put together. Adolf Hitler was one such man. Commander Rockwell was another. Today Commander Koehl is such a man and is carrying on the work begun by Adolf Hitler and continued by Lincoln Rockwell. "Follow Commander Koehl's orders," Capt. Syrdahl said, "for he is the one man in the country who knows what he is doing."

Commander's Keynote Address Highlight of Congress

The highlight of the Congress was the keynote address by Commander Koehl. He began by saying that while many people were celebrating what they called "200 years of freedom," freedom in America today is actually an illusion. The Commander declared, "Although our country was born a free, Aryan republic, the original American revolution has been betrayed and Americans are now under an alien control and domination that suppresses our liberties and threatens our existence. Just because an American can choose what brand of cereal or mouthwash he will use does not mean he has true freedom. Freedom is the ability of a people to control their destiny." The Founding Fathers, he said, would be shocked if they could see the condition of the country today, with its private Jewish control of the Nation's wealth and the tyranny of forced busing and integration on one hand and the anarchy of rampant crime and libertine permissiveness on the other. The Commander declared, "Our Founding Fathers did not wage a war against special privilige so we could be ruled by a Jewish oligarchy or be forced to live with hordes of alien racial minorities today."

"Today America is once more enslaved," the Commander said. "This is cause for a new revolutionary struggle, which we must undertake to FREE AMERICA from alien influence and domination. This calls for a new Declaration of Independence, backed up by the organized will to realize it and represented by the National Socialist movement."

Commander Koehl said that today the question of America's nationhood is still in doubt — it has yet to be born, it has still to become a nation in the true sense of the word. Accordingly, he said, our first task is to awaken Aryan consciousness, to give our race a sense of identity and community. Our second task is to gain power for America's Aryan majority. Our third task is to resolve the unresolved issues of the Civil War and reaffirm America's basic racial character as an Aryan nation instead of as a multi-racial society.

The Commander continued, "America needs national direction and purpose which National Socialism must provide." He said we must establish and reaffirm a basic set of Constitutional principles: (a) that this is an Aryan nation and only Aryans can be citizens, (b) that only citizens have rights, (c) that the state is not an end, but a means to an end, that being the good of the Race, (d) that the leadership principle should be a part of the governmental process at all levels, with government accessible to men of worth and merit and not mealy-mouthed opportunists, and (e) that to prevent tyranny a system of checks must exist, guaranteeing the right to keep and bear arms.

In reference to those persons who imply that we National Socialists are less than American, the Commander said that what they really mean is that they do not like the use of the Swastika, which is the *only hope* for the country. He stated, "I foresee a time when it will be impossible to think of patriotism without thinking of National Socialism and the National Socialist White People's Party!"

As we look back 200 years to the Nation's birth, the Commander said, we should also stop and consider what America will be like for our future generations 200 years from now. There are two possible alternatives: the White race could fail to achieve freedom and independence in this country and become a minority in its own land by the next century and disappear by 2176, or America's Aryan population will consolidate under the banner of National Socialism and forever establish the racial foundations of America as a White nation. What happens depends on the outcome of the National Socialist struggle.

The Commander concluded: "200 years ago our Founding Fathers undertook the first American revolution at great personal sacrifice. Today we who love this country have a sacred obligation to carry through a second American revolution. 200 years ago those early patriots pledged their lives, their fortunes and their sacred honor to win independence. Today we can do no less to secure our right to existence on this earth. And if we do, I am absolutely convinced, like the Fathers of this country, with a firm reliance on Divine Providence, WE TOO WILL SUCCEED!"

Ceremonies Conclude Event

After the Commander's keynote address ceremonies commenced with the issuing of special awards for notable service to the Party. Capt. Cedric Syrdahl accepted a specially designed plaque on behalf of the Chicago Unit for its outstanding efforts in acquiring a regional headquarters building. Comrade Joseph Davis of Arlington received a similar plaque in recognition of making the largest single material contribution to the Party. Comrades Wolfgang Schrodt of Baltimore, Art Jones of Milwaukee and Michael Allen of St. Louis were each issued Party Service Awards for their exceptional performance in representing the Party as candidates in local elections.

The Martyrs' ceremony concluded the Sunday evening session. As the flames of a crucible lit the darkened hall, the names of those National Socialist comrades who have died in the Struggle were called out. The delegates responded "PRESENT!" as symbolic proof that the Martyrs still live on in spirit. Finally, the Congress hall resounded to the strains of the Party Battle Song as every comrade joined in singing the National Socialist anthem.
