Milwaukee Unit Puts System on the Spot

Once again the Milwaukee Unit has put the local establishment in an awkward position. This time the city's school board was exposed as a pack of anti-White hypocrites after it denied a request for the use of a high school auditorium for a Party rally. The board committee - which had permitted Communists and kosher conservatives to use the same facility - suddenly decided to change its rules and not permit the use of school facilities to any group that "discriminates" in its membership. This blatantly unconstitutional act has set off a new round of controversy in Milwaukee, which was extensively reported in the city's newspapers. (See clippings reproduced below for details.)

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On 17 July unit members disrupted a talk given by a U.S congressman at an anti-busing meeting. Comrade Art Jones was quick to ask the supposed "anti-buser" several pointed questions which quickly exposed the representative as a phony and an anti-White opportunist. The Party's involvement in the meeting was covered by a local TV station and was reported in the *Milwaukee Journal*. (Article reproduced below.)

The unit has also been holding regular paper sales at shopping centers and busy city street corners every weekend. The most exciting of these occurred on Saturday, 31 July, which saw the Blacks and Jews out in force.

On that day the National Socialists took positions on Wisconsin avenue in downtown Milwaukee and began selling WHITE POWER newspapers. It wasn't long before the activists were picketed by members of the so-called Concerned Jewish Citizens - which consisted in this case of one senile Jewess and a yet-to-be-bar-mitzvahed Hebrew. Although several other CJC members were present, they remained content hiding behind potted plants on the other side of the street. After the pathetic "picket," a gang of Blacks started a verbal confrontation with a 16-year-old NSYM member. He easily refuted the simple-minded Afro arguments, which caused one large ape to attack the young National Socialist in a frenzy. This gave the ST an excellent opportunity to chastise the uppity Blacks. In a twinkling of an eye the big buck nigger was sent sprawling in the street and the remainder of the Blacks were quickly scattered. Police escorted the terrified Negro to safety, and the activity concluded without further incident.

Nazi Rally to Protest Integration

The Milwaukee unit of the Nazi party is planning an anti-integration rally at Bay View High School from 8 to 10 p.m. Aug. 20. A request for use of the building will be considered by the School Board's Finance and Facilities Committee at its meeting at 8 p.m. July 22. The purpose of the rally, according to a letter from the local unit of the party, is "to discuss the background behind forced integration and how to legally resist forced integration and/or court ordered busing in Milwaukee." In the letter to the School Board, Arthur J. Jones, director of public relations for the Milwaukee unit of the National Socialist White People's Party, said there was precedent for the board's granting the request for use of the school building.

Effort Planned To Block Nazis

Some Milwaukee School Board members plan to try to stop the National Socialist White People's Party (Nazi) from using Bay View High School for a public rally next month. Director Maurice McSweeney, said Monday that he hopes to hold the request in committee long enough to change the board rules so that the Nazi request could be denied. McSweeney is chairman of the board's Finance and Facilities Committee, which will hear the Nazi request on Thursday. Board rules now would force the board to permit the rally. The Nazi Party has asked to have the South Side high school auditorium from 8 to 9 p.m. Aug. 20 to "discuss the background behind forced integration and how to legally resist forced integration and/or court ordered busing in Milwaukee." McSweeney hopes to change board rules so that the board can refuse use of any of the system's buildings to organizations that discriminate in their membership policies. Jones said the party was a registered political party in the state, that he had received considerable support opposing forced integration when he ran for mayor, and that the Nazi Party was not called a subversive organization by any agency of the government. Jones also noted that the Revolutionary Communist Party held a May Day rally at Holmes School and that the Wisconsin Legislative and Research Committee, which he called an ultraconservative group, was allowed to use the Bay View auditorium for an antibusing rally earlier this year.

Nazi Bid Puts Board on Spot

All groups that discriminate in their memberships — be they the National Socialist White People's (Nazi) Party, a men's club or an ethnic or religious group — may find Milwaukee Public School buildings closed to them for meetings under School Board policy changes suggested Thursday night.

The board's Finance and Facilities Committee, meeting to hear a request from the local Nazi Party to use Bay View High School for an anti-busing rally, voted to reject all building permit requests until it can review placing the membership clause in the policy.

Members Warned

However, the committee members were warned that if they change the rules to prohibit groups that discriminate in membership, the rules would apply not only to organizations such as the Nazis, but also to such groups as men's clubs, dance groups or others that have a specific nationality, religious or sex membership policy.

Patrick McDonnell, assistant city attorney assigned to the School Board, said that if the board decides to include the new clause, it must be prepared to consistently enforce it.

"Therefore, if that (policy) is created, we have to objectively enforce it, be it a religious group or an ethnic group," McDonnell said.

The matter now goes to the board's Rules and Legislation Committee.

Nearly all of the debate Thursday centered on permitting the Nazis to hold the rally

next month at Bay View, rather than on the larger issue of rearranging the board's permit policy.

A series of several speakers from veteran, Jewish and community groups, including James Groppi, pleaded with the board to reject the Nazi request.

Cites Two Freedoms

School Board Director Donald O'Connell, countering arguments that rejection of the Nazi bid would be an infringement of free speech, labeled the controversy one of "freedom of speech versus the safety of the community."

However, the Nazi use of the South Side high school did get support from the Wisconsin Civil Liberties Union (WCLU) and from School Board Director Anthony S. Busalacchi.

Terry Shelton, executive director of the WCLU, said the board's attempt to ban the Nazi group by changing its present building permit policy after the group had applied under the old policy is "abhorrent."

He noted that courts have found regularly, including in a case by Federal Judge John W. Reynolds, that a public group cannot deny a person or organization the right to speak simply because it does not agree with the topic.

Ironically, Shelton pointed out, if the board maintains that school buildings cannot be used by groups that discriminate, "the School Board, which has practiced racial discrimination, would have to stop meeting in any of its own school buildings."

Plan Would Bar Nazis at Schools

Milwaukee public schools should be closed to all activities not directly related to schools, the School Board's Finance and Facilities Committee recommended Thursday.

The committee action, if approved by the board Aug. 3, would mean that veterans' groups, church groups and other similar organizations could not hold their meetings in any public schools, pending a decision in a Federal Court suit on the matter.

The action came as the committee was considering a request for the use of Bay View High School for an anti-integration rally.

The Milwaukee unit of the Nazi Party had requested permission to use Bay View High School Aug. 20 for a rally "to discuss the background behind forced integration and how to legally resist forced integration and/or court ordered busing in Milwaukee."

Maurice McSweeney, chairman of the committee, said later that he would suggest that the board reconsider its present policy allowing use of schools by many outside groups, with the idea of keeping out only groups that practice racial discrimination.

During an open hearing preceding the committee's action, Burton Polansky, representing the Coalition

Against Nazism, said the Nazis followed a policy of racial and religious discrimination and should not be allowed to use a public school for their meetings.

James Mallas, representing the Allied Veterans Council of Milwaukee County, said the Nazis' predecessors in Germany used beer halls for their meetings and suggested that the Milwaukee Nazis do the same thing.

"They (the taverns) have many halls to rent," he said. "They (the Nazis) don't have to come to the school."

Terry Shelton, acting director of the Wisconsin Civil Liberties Union, defended the right of the Nazis to use the school. He said changing the board's rules now would appear to be anti-Nazi instead of antisdiscrimination.

Referring to McSweeney's suggestion, Shelton said keeping all groups that practice racial discrimination out of schools would, in effect, keep out the School Board because the board recently was found guilty of practicing racial discrimination.

Arthur Jones, public relations director for the Nazi Party here, calling the board members idiots and cowards, said they were afraid to let the Nazis present the facts on racial integration although they allowed a Communist group to use a school last May 1.

Arlington ST Wins Fight for Maryland Community

After an initial struggle, the Arlington ST has defeated Jewish and reactionary attempts to prevent the Party from spreading its racial message in Marlow Heights, a small, racially troubled suburban community in Maryland.

The ST ran into difficulty in this area while on a routine literature distribution several weeks earlier. At that time, a team of ST stationed on a busy street corner was attacked by a mob of Blacks and so-called Whites incited by a Jewish used-car salesman. The National Socialists refused to retreat from their position and fought off their attackers until ordered to leave by police. Despite the more than 5-to-1 odds, our men sustained no serious injuries.

The unit decided to establish once and for all the Party's right to demonstrate for White Power in Marlow Heights without interference. On 10 July, two teams of ST under the command of TL Clyde Bingham returned to that community and stationed themselves on the same corner. Within a matter of minutes a crowd numbering over 70 persons — of which half were non-White and anti-NS — had gathered around the National Socialist demonstrators. As expected, the same Jews and reactionaries emerged from the used-car lot and attempted to agitate the crowd to attack. But this time the scum failed to work up enough courage to fight, even though the odds were about the same as before. The anti-NS elements of the crowd soon became discouraged at their inability to act against the ST and quickly dispersed. Seeing this, many Whites then approached the National Socialists and bought papers, asked for leaflets and made favorable comments about the ST men's courage and willingness to oppose local Blacks. The demonstration continued in this manner for over an hour and concluded without incident.

Thus the ST has laid the groundwork for future Party activity in that Maryland suburb and has won the respect of many area Whites.

Nazis Plan Move Into Pasadena

The Southern California chapter of the National Socialist White People's (Nazi) Party has announced plans to move its headquarters from El Monte to Pasadena.

The acting district leader of the party, Martin Kerr, told the Star-News that the Nazis intend to open a Pasadena headquarters in the late summer.

He declined, however, to specify the location or the exact date of the move, citing "security reasons." He said the party was looking at several properties.

It was also learned Monday that investigators from the Los Angeles County district attorney's office and the Pasadena police were making efforts to discover where the party intended to settle.

An investigator for the district attorney's office, Wendell Smith, said his office was "keeping an eye" on the Nazis, although he added that no full-scale investigation is under way.

The Nazis announced more than a year ago that they intended to focus their recruiting and organizing efforts in Pasadena, which they view as fertile ground for their doctrine of

white supremacy.

Last fall, the party became a focus of controversy when a black Pasadena minister, the Rev. Harrison Bailey, was reportedly found suspended from a tree with backwards swastikas drawn on his t-shirt. The party denied any involvement in the incident.

The Nazis have also picketed against pornography in Pasadena and were the subject of a court injunction more than a year ago forbidding them from appearing on Pasadena's school campuses.

At the aging, two-story home that now serves the party on El Monte's Peck Road, Kerr said the Nazis intended to move away from confrontation tactics toward "positive, community-based programs."

"We're a political organization," Kerr said. "We don't start trouble

and we don't break the law ... I want to break out of this image of uniforms and marches and do community work."

Kerr declined to further specify the party's tactics, but he said its members would attend school board meetings and perhaps run candidates for local office in 1977.

The party's announcement that it would move its headquarters Kerr said, followed a recent meeting attended by party leaders and members of the Pasadena police department at the Pasadena Hilton Hotel.

Kerr said the party's general aims were outlined at the meeting and that the police were assured that the group's activities would be peaceful.

Pasadena Police Chief Robert McGowan confirmed Monday that Pasadena officers had attended the meeting in their official

capacities. But he declined to comment on what was discussed.

Last fall, when tension over the Bailey incident was at a peak, the chief wrote a letter to Kerr warning him that the party was "never welcome" in Pasadena by the police.

McGowan reaffirmed that statement Monday and said his department would monitor the Nazis closely for any violations of the law.

The Nazis have encountered trouble in the past with authorities in El Monte, who have cited their headquarters for alleged violations of the zoning code.

Kerr said he had requested that the party move from El Monte soon after he became the acting district leader in April. He added that the home there did not serve the party's purposes.

Party Well Received on Chicago's Southwest Side

The Party is gaining increasing support from the White citizen's of Chicago's southwest side, which has large areas of White communities being threatened with Black invasion. The Chicago Unit has been concentrating its activities there, and has found the White populace very receptive to the Party's viewpoint.

Its most recent activity in this area took place 25 July. Party activists in full uniform took the unit's WHITE POWER bus out to the southwest side and began distributing literature. As the bus circled the area, the ST men passed out leaflets and the Party newspapers. Racially-aware Whites snapped up the literature and cheered the National Socialists on. Many elderly people thanked the ST for their "good work." Police on the scene were friendly and polite, and cheerfully explained to outraged Blacks passing the area that "the Nazis have every right to be here." The activists later took the bus to area parks where still more literature was distributed.

Meanwhile, unit activists have been conducting door-to-door literature distributions in the same area as well.

Party Activists Net Newspaper Coverage in Minneapolis

The recent increase of NS activism by the Minneapolis-St. Paul probationary unit has received the attention of the local media. Examples of the newspaper coverage on the Party are reproduced below.

'Soul patrol' aims to thwart racial strife

A North Side residents patrol has been activated despite the loss of American Red Cross vehicles originally promised for the operation, spokesmen for a local black coalition said Monday.

Residents will use their own vehicles to monitor areas of the city for potential racial flare-ups, according to Ron Edwards and Spike Moss of the United Black Front, a coalition that includes the Minneapolis Urban League.

"Past performance proves that legally constituted agencies would refuse to protect the black community in violent situations," Edwards said at a press conference yesterday.

The Red Cross decided not to lend

the vehicles after Minneapolis Police Chief Carl Johnson said June 30 that the police department "cannot as a matter of police policy endorse" the citizen patrols.

Edwards said there was antiblack sentiment within the Minneapolis police force and cited a recent newspaper article in which a local Nazi said police and Nazis were natural allies.

Johnson said Edwards' statements were assumptions.

"We have no control over what is printed in the newspaper," he said, referring to the Nazi's comments. "We are not the natural ally of any extremist party."

Johnson noted that the coalition's letter to him was closed, "Yours in Vigilance."

Asked, at the press conference, if "vigilance" connoted vigilante activity, Edwards responded negatively.

"The Nazis are the vigilantes," he said.

Edwards said the patrol would carry no guns. He declined to give the number of participants or cars involved, calling the information classified.

The support from the city began to erode yesterday when Police Chief Carl Johnson issued a statement saying the police department couldn't endorse the patrols, mainly out of fear that the city might face lawsuits as a result.

"I didn't want to get into the position of endorsing one citizen patrol and then have to endorse all the others," said Johnson. "I mean the Nazi Party could decide they wanted to start a patrol, and if I endorsed one I would have to do it for the other."

Johnson said the patrols are legal and that the department supports their efforts to keep the streets safe for citizens who feel they are the recent victims of groups such as the American Nazi Party.

demonstrate if it doesn't stop."

The soul patrol was formed by black groups that allege that white racists have been attacking blacks on the north side and that the police have not intervened.

Rumble said today that "agitators" are attempting to stir up the community against them. The press conference continued for about 15 minutes until a police official told the Nazis to continue their meeting in the hallway outside.

Patrol plan on despite 3 setbacks

The proposed northside citizen patrols have lost the support of the police, the mayor and the Red Cross, but the project may still get under way.

The patrols were to begin soon, using Red Cross staff vehicles equipped with citizen's band radios and running on gas and oil bought from the city.

BACKERS OF THE project say they still have the backing of Benjamin Berger, Minneapolis businessman, who has agreed to pay for gasoline and oil used by the patrols.

It wasn't clear, though, where the vehicles might come from to replace those of the Red Cross.

The neighborhood patrols were being organized by a coalition of 35 north side agencies and community groups. They were intended to thwart racial disturbances and violent incidents that recently have raised concern among residents of the area.

Nazi demands 'soul patrol' halt; warns demonstrations possible

Four Nazis held a press conference in the outer office of the Minneapolis chief of police today.

Michael Rumble, the Nazi spokesman, said his group was demanding an "end of the so-called 'soul patrol' on the north side because they (patrol members) have proven to be stupid and irresponsible."

Rumble said that if the patrol does not end, "the whites will eventually get behind us. We will

TV reporter finds self involved in Nazi story

Like most reporters, Lou Harvin has had his share of tough, ticklish interviews. But Tuesday morning's assignment was more sensitive than usual.

The scene was the hallway outside the Minneapolis police chief's office at city hall. Reporters and photographers were gathered around four men dressed in brown shirts with swastika armbands.

The man with the microphone in his hand was Harvin, 26, a reporter for KSTP-TV. Harvin is black.

The man with the microphone in his face was Mike Rumble, 20, spokesman for a small group of Twin Cities Nazis, formally known as the National Socialist White Peoples Party. Rumble is white.

Rumble and his buddies recently have been handing out Nazi hate leaflets aimed mostly at blacks. Authorities think their numbers are small, perhaps fewer than 20 hard core members. But their rhetoric includes vicious racial slurs.

"Blacks ought to be shipped back to Africa," Rumble was saying.

"What if I don't want to go?" Harvin asked. "I don't want to go back and millions of others don't either."

"I'm sure you will because when we come to power we'll make it pretty tough on you," Rumble said boldly.

He went on to claim that the country would be much better off as an all-white society. Then a reporter reminded him that whites were intruders on this continent so why shouldn't all the whites be shipped back to Europe. Rumble swallowed hard and said that

might not be a bad idea.

"I'm thinking all during the interview that this guy hates my guts," Harvin, the only black reporter on the scene, said afterward. He admitted that the delicate subject made it more than a typical assignment.

"My feeling is usually one of detachment. I mean, I don't care what a guy says. It doesn't bother me one way or the other. But this time I kept thinking that I really want to stick this guy. I mean, make him look bad. But you can't do that," Harvin said. "He makes himself look bad. Just let him talk and he'll hang himself."

Rumble and the three other Nazis had come to the chief's office demanding to see a file that the police reportedly are maintaining on local Nazi activity. They claim such a file is in violation of their civil and privacy rights.

Police chief Carl Johnson wasn't in the building. Lt. Steve Simons emerged from the chief's office to say that the police had no such file and suggested that the group file suit. They said they would.

They also told reporters they were proud of their swastika armbands. But only Rumble would identify himself.

The three others were a 21-year-old man and a 37-year-old man from South Minneapolis and a 15-year-old blond youth from the North Side who said his parents were in complete sympathy with his beliefs and supported his party fanaticism.

Commander Interviewed by "Crawdaddy" Magazine

Reprinted below is an excerpt of an article appearing in the August issue of *Crawdaddy Magazine* (a leftist counter-culture publication) which dealt with an interview given by Commander Koehl.

THE AMERICAN REICH

It took months to set up an interview with Matt Koehl. After my credentials were checked out, after they ascertained that I was not a Jew, after I submitted to a thorough testicle-fondling search for weapons, and after I had been told not to show up looking like a slob, then I met Matt Koehl. (Midwest leader Cedric Syrdahl later apologized for the "hard-assed" treatment, but, as he told me, they could not be absolutely sure that my photographer and I were not an assassination squad sent by the Jewish Defense League.)

Once all the paranoia had been given its full play, Koehl marched into the room. Six pairs of jackboots snapped to attention in unison. The brownshirts were ordered "at ease" and assumed their posts surrounding us. We began after a sturdy shake-his-hand-and-look-'em-in-the-eye from Koehl. "Your literature," I told him, "proposes that once your Party comes to power that all American blacks be sent to Africa..."

"Right!" he answered quickly. "What do you propose to do to the Jews?" I wondered.

"The white man brought the blacks over here against their wills and tried to put them into white society," he answered. "It was a terrible mistake. It is the source of so much of our headache today. It can be solved when we undertake a serious repatriation program. The Jews, however, are different. They came in here as intruders, sticking their long noses into our business, trying to run our affairs, telling us what we should do from the highest levels of government down to every aspect of our culture—and distorting it. We've given them the benefit of the doubt about their story that they were persecuted and mistreated elsewhere and we welcomed them to our shores..."

"In the future Aryan America there will be no room for a Jewish parasite colony. Therefore we are going to have to remove their presence. I believe we should not export our problem to some other country, sending our Jews to Canada or Mexico or somewhere. Maybe we can find a big island somewhere in the middle of the ocean where they can go and perform hard and honest work just like anybody else, and if it kills them, well then it is their tough luck. The world of the future will have no room for parasites."

"Could you tell me about neo-Nazi groups in the prison system?" I asked. "I can affirm that there are National Socialist groups in virtually every prison of

any size in this country. We get a flood of mail from inmates—white guys—who have been incarcerated for one reason or another, who are a bit screwed up in this screwed up society and instead of looking to political alternatives they turned to crime. We always hold out the hand of salvation to sinners. If they can straighten up and go right when they are released, we stay in touch with them."

"Are there any women in your group?"

"We are a bit under-represented on the distaff side," said Koehl. "I think it is somewhat significant in that we are attracting more women than we have in the past. We are living in revolutionary times. The revolution is not here yet, but it is coming. As we get closer and closer to the ferment which is building up, we're going to be attracting more women. Being revolutionaries in pre-revolutionary times, we are not in a position to offer security to anyone. We offer risk and danger. The feminine psychology, excluding bull dykes, has a craving for security. We've had guys injured. We've ended up in jail. Some guys have had their names in the paper and lost their jobs. The women know these things and unless they are dedicated idealists, they say, 'Well, honey, stay home.' This is changing, however. The system is becoming a threat to womanhood. We are becoming the saviors rather than the threat."

(After the interview, a Nazi women's auxiliary was formed, the National Socialist Women's Organization. Their dress uniform is a long, dark skirt with a white blouse complimented by a demure scarf. And, of course, the fashionable National Socialist would not be caught dead without a swastika armband.)

"Do you expect your revolution to happen in this generation's lifetime?" I wondered.

"I believe that the whole process—so much has happened—it will take a while to clean things up. It's going to be the work of generations, but we will make the start before the turn of the century. We will lay the political foundation for the start of recovery. That is what we propose to do."

"I've read that you do not hold the common opinion that six million Jews were murdered by the Third Reich..."

"Six million? Where did you get that figure? Shall we try for eighteen? Twenty-four? It's pure mythology, picking numbers out of a hat. There is no factual basis to it. It's simply a propagandistic myth kept alive for over a generation since he war, artificially kept alive by the media where they dig up bodies that they say are



Jewish bodies, but this is not necessarily the case. In most cases, I suspect, they are dead Germans who were massacred by both the Communists and the Western Allies. At Nuremberg there was photographic evidence introduced purported to be concentration camp victims all piled up and covered with lime—they were Dresden air raid victims. Things like this have happened repeatedly. The International Red Cross in 1947 placed the number of persons who died in internment centers in Europe—not only in Germany but also outside Germany—between 1939 and 1945 at 300,000. This includes the number of people who died of things like old age and typhoid outbreaks and food shortages. Red Cross convoys were attacked by Allied planes while on route to concentration camps. These convoys contained food and medical supplies. I've talked to eyewitnesses who had been in camps or guarded camps."

"Does it bother you, that the white race is the minority on a world-wide scale?"

"I think the problem is much more serious than that, in that the numerical proportions are moving against the survival chances of the white race. There definitely has to be a reversal of this trend."

"Are you opposed to abortion?"

"That depends on who is being aborted," Koehl asserted. "I believe that it is a crime of the grossest magnitude to abort an unborn white child, assuming it is healthy and that it is of sound mind and body. I believe that it is murder. On the other hand, if you have an instance where some white girl has been raped by some baboon in the ghetto and as a result of this some creature is coming into this world—some kind of monstrosity—I would say it would be an act of the highest humanity to abort such a perversion of life."

"We do not necessarily hate any group," Koehl continued. "This is one accusation that is thrown up against us, that we are a bunch of hate mongers, that we are obsessed with hate, that we want to mis-

treat people. Actually, our philosophy starts with a love for our own kind, our own race. If some group, I don't care who it is, if they threaten our race—which we are trying to preserve—we are going to oppose them, we are going to resist them, with everything we've got."

"You seem concerned that the white race could become extinct..."

"It could, in a couple generations, if it were up to apathy and if there were no National Socialist movement. But thank God there is a National Socialist movement."

After the interview Koehl retired to a back room to complete work on his speech to be delivered later that evening to the Chicago members and supporters of the NSWPP.

During the course of the meeting, Koehl led his assembled followers in a lively rendition of the "National Socialist Battle Song," a ditty written by Rockwell sung to the tune of "Horst Wessel Lied":

Three-Year Plan Quota Exceeded in June

In response to the Commander's appeal for aid for our Chicago comrades — who are struggling to pay off the mortgage on the new Midwest headquarters building — National Socialists made a great step in furthering the Three-Year Plan goals in June. A total of \$2,612.92 was contributed, of which a large part was earmarked for the new Party center. This figure exceeds our monthly quota of \$2,500 that was set in order to raise \$88,888 by 20 April 1978.

In addition, comrades from a record 34 states and two provinces gave to the Plan in June. (See map below left.) This represents the closest we have yet come to our monthly goal of filling the map out. The results of June show what can be accomplished with a little extra effort by members and supporters of the Party. All comrades who helped to bring about this success are to be congratulated for their exceptional response.

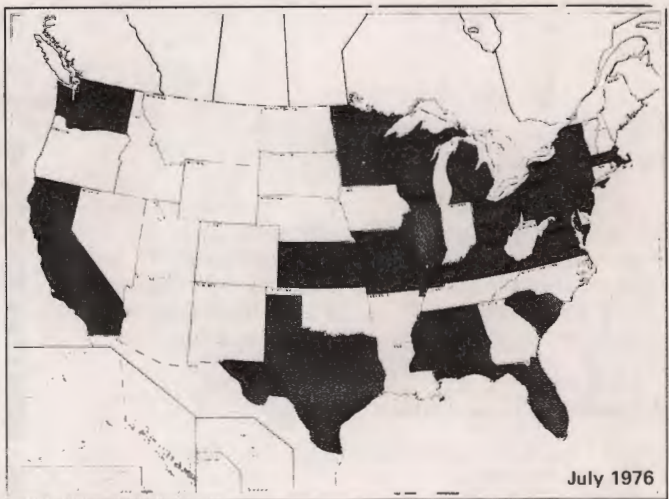
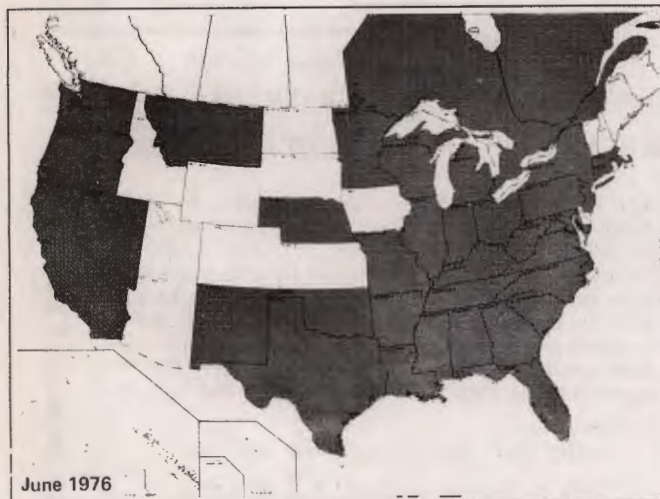
In July \$420.03 was contributed to the Plan by comrades from 21 states. In addition, \$709 was raised in a special collection for the Midwest headquarters at the Seventh Party Congress on 4 July.

To date, we have raised an overall total of \$18,331.99 in the Three-Year Plan. This is approximately 21% of our goal for the drive, with only 21 months left to the 20 April 1978 deadline.
