
Milwaukee Unit Puts System on the Spot

Once again the Milwaukee Unit has put the local establishment in an awkward position. This time the city's school board was exposed as a pack of anti-White hypocrites after it denied a request for the use of a high school auditorium for a Party rally. The board committee – which had permitted Communists and kosher conservatives to use the same facility – suddenly decided to change its rules and not permit the use of school facilities to any group that "discriminates" in its membership. This blatantly unconstitutional act has set off a new round of controversy in Milwaukee, which was extensively reported in the city's newspapers. (See clippings reproduced below for details.

On 17 July unit members disrupted a talk given by a U.S congressman at an anti-busing meeting. Comrade Art Jones was quick to ask the supposed "anti-buser" several pointed questions which quickly exposed the representative as a phony and an anti-White opportunist. The Party's involvement in the meeting was covered by a local TV station and was reported in the *Milwaukee Journal*. (Article reproduced below.)

The unit has also been holding regular paper sales at shopping centers and busy city street corners every weekend. The most exciting of these occurred on Saturday, 31 July, which saw the Blacks and Jews out in force.

On that day the National Socialists took positions on Wisconsin avenue in downtown Milwaukee and began selling WHITE POWER newspapers. It wasn't long before the activists were picketed by members of the so-called Concerned Jewish Citizens - which consisted in this case of one senile Jewess and a yet-to-be-bar-mitzvahed Hebrew. Although several other CJC members were present, they remained content hiding behind potted plants on the other side of the street. After the pathetic "picket," a gang of Blacks started a verbal confrontation with a 16-year-old NSYM member. He easily refuted the simple-minded Afro arguments, which caused one large ape to attack the young National Socialist in a frenzy. This gave the ST an excellent opportunity to chastise the uppity Blacks. In a twinkling of an eye the big buck nigger was sent sprawling in the street and the remainder of the Blacks were quickly scattered. Police escorted the terrified Negro to safety, and the activity concluded without further incident.

The matter now goes to the board's Rules and Legis-lation Committee.

A series of several speak-ers from veteran, Jewish and community groups, including lames Groppi, pleaded with the board to reject the Nazi request.

Cites Two Freedoms

School Board Director Donaid O'Connell, countering arguments that rejection of the Nazi bid would be an. infringement of free speech, labeled the controversy one of "freedom of speech versus the safety of the communit-v."

Novever, the Nazl use of the South Side high shool did get support from the Wiscon-sin Civil -Liberties Union (WCLU) and from School Board Director Anthony S. Buselacchi. Terry Shelton, executive director of the WCLU, said the board's attempt to ban the Nazl group by changing Tis present building permit policy after the group had applied under the old policy is "abhorent." He noted that courts have found regularly, including in a case by Federal Judge John W. Reynolds, that a public group cannot deny a person of organization the right to speak simply because it does not agree with the topic. Ironically, Shelton pointed

not agree with the topic. Ironically, Sheiton pointed out, if the board maintains that school buildings cannot be used by groups that dis-criminate, "the School Board, which has practiced ractal discrimination, would have to stop meeting in any of its own school buildings."

Arlington ST Wins Fight for Maryland Community

After an initial struggle, the Arlington ST has defeated Jewish and reactionary attempts to prevent the Party from spreading its racial message in Marlow Heights, a small, racially troubled suburban community in Maryland.

The ST ran into difficulty in this area while on a routine literature distribution several weeks earlier. At that time, a team of ST stationed on a busy street corner was attacked by a mob of Blacks and so-called Whites incited by a Jewish used-car salesman. The National Socialists refused to retreat from their position and fought off their attackers until ordered to leave by police. Despite the more than 5-to-1 odds, our men sustained no serious injuries.

The unit decided to establish once and for all the Party's right to demonstrate for White Power in Marlow Heights without interference. On 10 July, two teams of ST under the command of TL Clyde Bingham returned to that community and stationed themselves on the same corner. Within a matter of minutes a crowd numbering over 70 persons - of which half were non-White and anti-NS - had gathered around the National Socialist demonstrators. As expected, the same Jews and reactionaries emerged from the used-car lot and attempted to agitate the crowd to attack. But this time the scum failed to work up enough courage to fight, even though the odds were about the same as before. The anti-NS elements of the crowd soon became discouraged at their inability to act against the ST and quickly dispersed. Seeing this, many Whites then approached the National Socialists and bought papers, asked for leaflets and made favorable comments about the ST men's courage and willingness to oppose local Blacks. The demonstration continued in this manner for over an hour and concluded without incident.

Thus the ST has laid the groundwork for future Party activity in that Maryland suburb and has won the respect of many area Whites.

use a public school for their meetings. James Mallas, representing the Allied Veterans Council of Milwaukee County, said the Nazis' predecessors in Germany used beer hails for their meetings and suggested that the Milwaukee Nazis do the same thing.

Terry Shelton, acting di-rector of the Wisconsin Civil Liberties Union, defended the right of the Nazis-to use the school. He said changing the, board's rules now would ormasr to he anti-Nazi instead board's rules now would appear to be anti-Nazi instead of antidiscrimination.

Referring to McSweeney's suggestion, Shelton said keeping all groups that prac-tice racial discrimination out of schools would, in effect, keep out the School Board because the board recently was found guilty of practic-ing racial discrimination.

Arthur Jones, public rela-tions director for the Nazi Party here, calling the board members idiots and cowards, said they were afraid to let the Nazis present the facts on racial integration although they allowed a Communist group to use a school last May 1.

Its most recent activity in this area took place 25 July. Party activists in full uniform took the unit's WHITE POWER bus out to the southwest side and began distributing literature. As the bus circled the area, the ST men passed out leaflets and the Party newspapers. Racially-aware Whites snapped up the literature and cheered the National Socialists on. Many elderly people thanked the ST for their "good work." Police on the scene were friendly and polite, and cheerfully explained to outraged Blacks passing the area that "the Nazis have every right to be here." The activists later took the bus to area parks where still more literature was distributed.

Meanwhile, unit activists have been conducting door-to-door literature distributions in the same area as well.

Party Activists Net Newspaper Coverage in Minneapolis

"The Nazis are the vigilantes," he said.

Edwards said the patrol would car-ry no guns. He declined to give the number of participants or cars in-volved, calling the information classified.

TV reporter finds self involved in Nazi story

Like most reporters. Lou Harvin has had his share of tough, ticklish interviews. But Tuesday morning's assignment was more sensitive than usual.

The scene was the hallway outside the Minneapolis police chief's of-fice at city hall. Reporters and photographers were gathered around four men dressed in bro shirts with swastika armbands, d in brown

The man with the microphone in his hand was Harvin, 26, a reporter for KSTP-TV. Harvin is black.

The man with the microphone in his face was Mike Rumble, 20, spokesman for a small group of Twin Cities Nazis, formally known as the National Socialist White Peoples Party, Rumble is white,

Rumble and his buddies recently have been handing out Nazi hate leaflets aimed mostly at blacks. Authorities think their numbers are small, perhaps fewer than 20 hard core members. But their rhetoric includes vicious racial slurs.

"Blacks ought to be shipped back to Africa." Rumble was saying. "What if I don't want to go?" Har-vin asked. "I don't want to go back vin asked. "I don't want to go?" Har-ind millions of others don't https://



"I'm sure you will because when we come to power we'll make it pretty tough on you," Rumble said boldly.

"I'm thinking all during the inter-view that this guy hates my guts." Harvin, the only black reporter on the scene, said afterward. He ad-mitted that the delicate subject matted made it more than a typical regimenant.

"My feeling is usually one of de-tachment. I mean, I don't care what a guy says. It doesn't bother me one way or the other. But this time I kept thinking that I really want to stick this guy. I mean, make him look bad. But you can't do that," Harvin said. "He makes himself look had. Just let him talk and he'll hang himself."

Police chief Carl Johnson wasn't in Police chief Carl Jonnson wasn't in the building. Lt. Steve Simons emerged from the chief's office to say that the police had no such file and suggested that the group file suft. They said they would.

They also told reporters they were proud of their swastika armbands. But only Rumble would identify himself.

The three others were a 21-year-old man and a 37-year-old man from South Minneapolis and a 15-year-old hiond youth from the North Side who said his parents were in complete sympathy with his heliefs and supported his party fanaticism.

The proposed northside citizen patrois-have lost the support of the police, the mayor and the Red Cross, but the project may still get under way. The patrois were to begin soon, using Red Cross staff vehicles equipped with citizen's band radios and running on gas and oil bought from the city.

BACKERS OF THE project say they still have the will to go ahead, and they still have the backing of Benjamin Berger, Minneapolis busi-nessman, who has agreed to pay for gasoline and oil used by the patrols.



Commander Interviewed by "Crawdaddy" Magazine

Reprinted below is an excerpt of an article appearing in the August issue of Crawdaddy Magazine (a leftist counter-culture publication) which dealt with an interview given by Commander Koehl.

FRANK H. NILES


