FURTHER CONGRESS DETAILS ANNOUNCED

The following are further details concerning the 10th Congress of the National Socialist White People's Party. All comrades who plan on attending the Congress should be finalizing their travel arrangements and all related matters at this time. These things should be taken care of right away, and not let go to the last moment.

REGISTRATION FORMS:

Those who wish to attend the Congress must mail in the enclosed registration form postmarked no later than **25 August**. The form should be accompanied by the appropriate registration fee.

ARRIVAL:

National Headquarters urges delegates to arrive in Arlington on Friday, 29 August, if at all possible. Anyone who can arrive earlier in order to help out with Congress preparations is encouraged to do so.

REGISTRATION IN ARLINGTON:

All comrades must register at National Headquarters before being allowed to attend the Congress. Registration times at NHQ will be as follows: Friday, 29 August, 2-12 p.m.; Saturday, 1 September, 8 a.m. to 12 noon, and 4-8 p.m. (*Note: No one will be allowed to attend the Congress whose dues or pledges are not paid up. Such delinquent dues or pledges may be paid to the Registration Officer, who will have a list of those comrades who are behind on their payments.*)

NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS:

To reach National Headquarters, go to the 2500 block of *Wilson Blvd.*, in Arlington. NHQ is located right on the corner of Wilson and N. Franklin Road. If you have problems finding NHQ, call the headquarters phone number (703) 524-2175, for directions. If you forget this number, remember that it is in the white pages of the phone book in bold-face letters.

TRANSPORTATION:

Those comrades still in need of transportation to the Congress should contact NHQ *immediately*. Comrades driving from various parts of the country may be able to provide rides for those who need them.

DEMONSTRATION:

There will be a uniformed demonstration on the morning of Saturday, 30 August. Those who wish to take part in the demonstration in uniform should take note of the grooming regulations for ST personnel listed below. (There will be something to do for those who wish to participate *out of uniform*, as well.)

GROOMING AND APPEARANCE:

All National Socialists are expected to look and act like members of the Master Race. Matters such as grooming and appearance should not be taken casually. Attending a Party Congress is a *privilege*. This privilege requires

that all attendees adhere to certain National Socialist standards relating to appearance and dress, as well as conduct and attitude.

Hair Length: All male Congress delegates must have proper haircuts. Those who wish to take part in the uniformed demonstration must have haircuts as specified below. All others should have their hair neatly trimmed and groomed. National Headquarters reserves the right to refuse admittance to any male delegate with outlandish or unreasonably long hair.

Moustaches: Same as hair.

Beards: All ST personnel and all others taking part in the public demonstration in uniform must be clean shaven. Other male attendees may have beards, providing they are well-trimmed and groomed.

Male Dress: Those taking part in the demonstration must have a basic ST uniform. At the Congress site, only full Party members, full NSYM members and regular members of the ST* are to wear the brown shirt. All other male attendees (including Probationary Members and Official Supporters) are to wear an ordinary shirt and tie. All male delegate should have a suit coat available. No freak or garish attire, such as blue jeans, bell-bottoms or sandals will be allowed. Similarly, no German military paraphrenalia will be permitted. Leisure suits are not encouraged, but are acceptable attire for male delegates for all sessions of the Congress.

Armbands: No armbands are to be worn off the Congress site premises.

Female Dress: NSWO members should wear proper NSWO dress. Women delegates should wear a dress or skirt and blouse in good taste. Skirts more than 3" above the knee, "hot pants," shorts, slacks or jeans are not proper attire for this occasion, and will not be allowed.

ST GROOMING STANDARDS AND UNIFORM:

Hair length: ST personnel and those not in the ST but who wish to take part in the public demonstration should have military-style haircuts.

Mustaches: Mustaches should be neatly trimmed and not extend over the lip or below the corner of the mouth

Basic ST Uniform: The basic ST uniform consists of brown (khaki) shirt (no epaulettes), combat boots (or black oxfords), black *straight-cut* trousers, silver buckle garrison belt, black tie (no wider than 3½"), Swastika armband and ST helmet. These last two items will be available at NHQ.

INTERVIEWS:

There will be NO interviews granted during the Congress (30 & 31 August). Comrades who desire an interview for any purpose either with the Commander of another national officer, before or after the Congress, should contact NHQ beforehand.

RESERVATIONS:

To avoid the confusion and delay of some past congresses, NHQ has decided to have all delegates make their own motel reservations. All attendees will receive a list of area motels which are of both good quality and near National Headquarters.

**A regular member of the ST is anyone who has submitted a complete ST application and who participates regularly—on an active or reserve basis—in ST activities.*

Spring Appeal Response Picking Up

The response to the Spring Appeal picked up somewhat in June. Although only \$989.80 was received in May (less than 10 percent), the total for June was \$2,440.30. This brings the grand total through 30 June to \$3,430.10, or 34.3 percent of our \$10,000 goal.

In past years the Spring Appeal ended on the last day of June. This year the appeal will be extended through the end of July, because of its late start and initially poor response.

A Deliberate Impropriety



Posters Ripped From Buses, Nazi Claims

The Gay Activists Alliance, for the most part pleased with the results of its Metrobus poster campaign last month, is now having to contend with a self-proclaimed Nazi who says he's been tearing down "Someone in Your Life is Gay" placards.

GAA president Mel Boozer says he received a letter June 24 signed by Jon Greer of Springfield, Va. Included with it were the remains of a torn up poster. Greer claimed he had "bagged over four dozen" posters to defend himself against "those advertisements' assault on my moral values and legal sensibilities."

Greer cited examples of the support he received in taking posters down. He said he drew cheers, that on drives on," and

At the end of the letter, Greer, who used plain stationery, cautioned Boozer not to "be inclined to overreach against my affiliation with the National Socialist White People's Party." However, if one was to dial the Nazi's "White Power" message line, the caller would hear a recording that attacked the GAA poster as a "perversion." The message continued in an anti-Gay tone, referring to Nazi Germany: "One would not find homosexuals running amuck in the streets attempting to spread their disease and toleration. One could find flagrant homosexuals in concentration camps. It is a pretty good

Anti-Queer Campaign Draws Fire

A Washington, D.C., homosexual group, the Gay Activists Alliance, recently won a court ruling which required the buses of the Washington-area Metro system to post pro-homosexual ads for the alliance as a public service! This insane ruling meant that taxpayers' money was used to subsidize what in effect were recruiting posters for the queer group.

Outraged at the decision, Comrade Jon Greer, who recently joined National Headquarters staff in Arlington, undertook a personal campaign to tear down the ads from Virginia buses. Comrade Greer tore down over fifty of the posters from different buses, often with a bus-load of passengers looking on in approval.

Only twice did he encounter opposition: Once from a lesbian Jewess who booed him until being stared into silence by the other passengers, and another time from a distraught faggot who unsuccessfully tried to prevent him from ripping down one of the placards. Besides these two incidents, everyone else who observed Comrade Greer's campaign was sympathetic.

Comrade Greer also sent a letter to one Melvin Boozer (Black head of the GAA) telling him of his campaign to tear down the posters and daring the queers to stop him. He enclosed the ripped-up remnants of one of the cardboard ads for good measure.

The GAA approached the Metro police and Virginia and Washington courts in an attempt to stop Comrade Greer's actions. The officials the queers contacted were clearly unsympathetic to the GAA, and no legal action was taken against him.

Despite a lengthy page one article denouncing him in a local homosexual publication, Comrade Greer reports no repercussions from his actions other than some late-night crank phone calls from men with strange sounding voices.

Warning: Imposters Attempting Ripoff

A group of mental defectives posing as National Socialists is currently attempting to rip off sincere National Socialists by asking for contributions to a hare-brained scheme to build a gigantic "memorial" to Adolf Hitler in Pomona, Calif.

These mental defectives are led by one John Hale McGee, who at different times has claimed to be the Archangel Michael and Jesus Christ. Now claiming to be the reincarnation of Adolf Hitler, this refugee from the funny farm heads a group calling itself the "American National Socialist Party." (This new ANSP has no connection with the pre-World War II "American National-Socialist Party" led by Peter Stahrenberg, which was a legitimate NS outfit.)

The letters which some Party comrades received soliciting funds for the megalomaniac schemes of this individual were signed by one Dale Gatewood, who himself was purged from the NSWPP in 1971 for extreme mental instability and treason.

Party comrades should be on the lookout for mail asking for contributions to the "Adolf Hitler Memorial Fund" or anything similar, originating from Pomona, Calif. There is no need to send these letters on to NHQ—just throw them in the garbage where they belong!

SPECIAL NOTE

As this issue of the NS BULLETIN was being completed Party Comrade Dominic Lewitzke met with a tragic and untimely death. Comrade Lewitzke served on National Headquarters staff as Membership Secretary and Corresponding Secretary. Until a replacement for Comrade Lewitzke can be found, there will be unavoidable delays in all matters concerning membership (dues and pledge acknowledgement, Swastika stamps, routine processing and so forth) as well as delays in all correspondence. We ask every comrade to be patient with these delays until a new staff member can be recruited and trained.

Further details on Comrade Lewitzke's death will appear in the next NS BULLETIN.

ACTIVITIES IN BRIEF

• The Indianapolis Unit reports that it is presently concentrating on anti-busing activities. Forced interracial busing is scheduled this Fall for school children on the east side of Indianapolis. In addition to attending numerous school board meetings, the Indianapolis comrades have distributed anti-busing literature to White residential neighborhoods.

• A team of National Socialists from the National Headquarters area distributed over 300 copies of the new *Remember the Liberty!* leaflet to military personnel and Department of Defense workers at the Pentagon on 20 June. The National Socialists conducted the distribution inside the building, taking advantage of a recent court ruling won by leftists which allows such activity.

• Supporter Richard Saxon was assaulted from behind by three Black males while distributing Party literature in South Oroville, Calif., on 27 June. Comrade Saxon, who was alone at the time of the attack, was not seriously injured.

• Other cities and areas reporting literature distributions during June include Cleveland, Chicago, Milwaukee and the North Country Unit (New York State).

• Pennsylvania Comrade James Maloney had two letters-to-the-editor printed in local papers during June. Both of the well-written letters dealt generally with White rights.



TWO-YEAR PLAN NOTES

FIRST QUARTER INTERIM REPORT

To: The Commander
From: Director Martin Kerr, Two-Year Plan Coordinator
Subject: Two-Year Plan Progress, 1 January through 30 June, 1980
Date: 2 July, 1980 YL-92

Introduction: As of 30 June, one quarter of the time allotted for the Two-Year Plan has elapsed. The purpose of this report is to examine the progress made towards achieving the goals of the Plan during this initial period by discussing both the areas in which it has been successful as well as the areas in which it has not been successful. It is hoped that such an analysis will serve to expedite the fulfillment of the Plan during its remaining year-and-a-half.

Overview: On the whole the Plan is proving to be a success. However, problems have arisen in a few areas which are limiting the advantages which the Party would otherwise enjoy as a result of the Plan.

Four Basic Goals: The four basic goals of the Plan are as follows:

1. The reorientation of Party propaganda so that it appeals to idealists rather than haters.
2. The thorough training of Party leadership cadres in the National Socialist world view.
3. The training of all Party members and activists in revolutionary skills.
4. The recruiting of capable full-time staff personnel for work in Arlington and Cicero.

Points two and three listed above have not yet been undertaken in a systematic manner. As per our original timetable, they are scheduled to be tackled during the second and third quarters (for point two) and the fourth quarter (point three) of the Plan.

Point one, the reorientation of Party propaganda, has been largely completed, both on a national and local level. Old, unsuitable literature and activities have been phased out, and new, superior literature and activities have replaced them to a large degree.

A tiny number of supporters have dissociated themselves from the Party as a result of the changes. In particular, those whose main motives in affiliating with the Movement were either hatred of Blacks or obsessive fascination with the ST uniform have dropped out. Other comrades have remained in the Party but are clearly unhappy with the changes, and have even withheld their support in a few rare instances. We believe that these comrades will come around as the success of the Plan mounts.

Point four, involving the recruitment of staff personnel, has proven to be the most stubborn problem we

have encountered. Our lack of success in this point has generated a ripple effect, which is being felt in every area of Party work.

Lack of personnel in just a few key positions has limited operations not just in Arlington and Cicero, but throughout the Movement.

For example, the lack of one person in the Party's editorial department meant that we were unable to produce a single issue of WHITE POWER during the first part of the Plan, because the available personnel were tied up with work that had a higher priority (THE NATIONAL SOCIALIST, NS Publications catalog, etc.).

The failure of the paper to appear caused Party morale to sag somewhat. This in turn resulted in a lack of enthusiasm in local units and subsequent curtailment of their activities. Also, this drooping morale caused some comrades not to donate to the Spring Appeal, which hurt us financially.

This story could be repeated in nearly every department. The failure of qualified persons to step forward for full-time Party work is having a negative effect throughout the Movement. *It is clear that we must give the highest priority to solving this problem—by whatever means necessary.*

Other areas:

- Despite our current financial difficulties, we were able to raise the salaries of full-time Party workers above the bare subsistence level.
- We purged from our ranks many of the undesirable elements that plagued us for two decades, in particular, mental defectives and persons who were not National Socialists but were using the Party to serve some right-wing ideology or their own egos.
- Some local units have been slow to develop new forms of activities which do not involve the ST uniform. We believe that this is partially due to the drooping morale mentioned above. Other comrades, however, have taken the initiative and developed innovative activities of their own.
- The reaction to the new line of propaganda has been overwhelmingly favorable. THE NATIONAL SOCIAL-

IST, the introductory brochure, the NS Publications catalog, and the new line of stickers and new leaflets have all met with enthusiastic approval, both by Party comrades and by White racialists outside the Movement. As a result, we have begun to attract higher quality recruits into the Party, and we have gained prestige throughout the racist movement.

Summary: It is correct to say that the Plan thus far has been a success. The success has not been unqualified, however, and there are three areas which we must concentrate on between now and the end of the year:

1. We absolutely *must* recruit staff personnel for Arlington and Cicero.

2. We must re-establish a regular publication schedule for **WHITE POWER**.
3. We must concentrate on developing new forms of local activities and on seeing that these activities are put into effect.

If we are able to accomplish all three of these goals and the other Two-Year Plan objectives mentioned above between now and 1 January 1981, we can expect 1981 to be a year of unprecedented Party growth and victory.
