Commander Addresses Chicago, Michigan Audiences

Commander Matt Koehl spoke to two audiences during the first part of July. His first address was to a meeting sponsored by Bob Miles' Free Association Forum, in Howell, Michigan. A few days later he spoke to a select group of Party leaders and activists from Chicago and Milwaukee at the Midwest Regional Headquarters in Cicero.

In his Cicero speech, delivered 12 July, the Commander stressed the importance of the Two-Year Plan in the Party's development. The overall purpose of the Plan is to educate and prepare the Party for the struggles which lie ahead. In doing this, we must eliminate many harmful misconceptions which have grown up around our National Socialist ideology. In particular, we must purge the Movement of various types of right-wing nonsense which have afflicted it.

Another major task which we face is to make both the leadership and rank and file of the Movement understand who our most dangerous enemy is: the Jewish-dominated System that rules the U.S. today.

The Commander said that we must stress that our job is not to save or reform the Old Order, but to bring this corrupt abomination down so that a New Order, responsive to the vital needs and interests of the Aryan race can be formed.

In criticizing what he termed "meaningless Yankee Doodle patriotism," the Commander explained that National Socialist patriotism is not based on hollow red, white and blue flag-waving, but on the reality of race.

The Commander compared and contrasted the concepts of *nation*, *country* and *state*, which so many people confuse with one another. The *nation* consists of *people*—people which share a common racial, cul-

tural and linguistic background. The *country* consists of the *land* on which the nation (or people) lives. The *state* consists of the *government* which rules the nation and the country.

The United States is not a true nation, the Commander said, because of its multi-racial composition. Rather, it is several different nations—a White nation, a Black nation, a Chicano nation, a Puerto Rican nation, a Jewish nation and so forth—each with conflicting interests and designs. As National Socialists, we are loyal only to our White racial brothers and sisters, and not to every individual who happens to live within the boundaries of the United States, regardless of his or her race.

Furthermore, as National Socialists, we owe no loyalty at all to the present government—or state—which has shown a callous disregard for the rights and welfare of White people. "Yankee Doodle patriotism" which embraces loyalty to the present government just because it sits in Washington and drapes itself in red, white and blue is completely repugnant to us as racial revolutionaries, who put the interests of our people above all other considerations.

Right-wingers are part and parcel of the whole anti-White System, and thus are part of the disease—not part of the cure they pretend to be.

Commander Koehl had explained many of these same concepts three days earlier, when he spoke to the FAF in Michigan. He told the audience there that the talk of the rightwing is hopelessly outdated. While the rightwingers worry about what some hypothetical Communist government might one day do to the White people of America, the present System is already doing it! It is the Federal government, for example, which is responsible for busing and integration, for massive non-White immigration, for the rape of the environment—not the Communists in Moscow

or Peking.

We must understand that the present government is not "our" government, not a government by, of and for White people.

The Commander concluded by calling upon White people to show the same courage that the early American colonists and the Confederate States showed in fighting for independence from governments they felt were unresponsive to their needs.

Appeal Total Announced

Only \$2,155.83 was received in donations towards the Spring Appeal during its final month, resulting in the worst overall response for a fund-raising campaign in recent Party history. Altogether, \$5,585.93 was donated to the drive, which opened in late May and ran through the end of July.

The target set for the appeal was \$10,000. The amount contributed was just over half of that—56 percent of the total goal.

The failure to raise the full amount means that there will be a temporary cutback in some Party operations, and a further delay in the issuance of Party publications. These financial difficulties are expected to last until Party income is back to normal after the yearly summer lull.

National Socialists Participate in "Captive Nations Day" March

National Socialists from the Greater New York area under the leadership of New Jersey Party Organizer Eugene Palensar participated in the 22nd annual "Captive Nations Day" parade and rally held in New York City on 13 July. The term "captive nations" refers to those countries which presently languish under Communist dictatorship. The event is held in major U.S. cities to show solidarity with such occupied peoples and to promote support for their liberation.

The National Socialists, in civilian clothes, carried a number of signs, one of which bore the Party's name and address to identify the NS contingent and to encourage interested persons to get in touch with the Party. After participating in the 25-block march without incident, the National Socialists continued to mingle with the crowd at the rally site, exchanging ideas and making contacts with many individuals and organizations present representing the captive nations.

Party activists who participated in the event report that it was a complete success from a National Socialist standpoint, and that they will continue to work among such anti-Red emigre groups.

Party Policy

Use of 50-Star Flag Discontinued

The Commander has announced that, effective immediately, the 50-star American flag will no longer be used by the Party. In its place the 13-star "Betsy Ross flag" has been adopted.

The Commander explained that the 50-star flag symbolizes the decadent, multi-racial monstrosity that the United States has become. It is the flag of the System, and as such it is *not* the flag of National Socialist revolutionaries—nor any White American for that matter.

The Betsy Ross flag on the other hand represents what this country was at the time of its foundation as well as being a symbol of what our Forefathers wanted it to remain, and thus is a more proper and fitting sign of the type of patriotism we National Socialists endorse.

Henceforth, the Betsy Ross flag is to fly from all Party installations and will be carried in public demonstrations in lieu of the 50-star flag.

DOMINIC LEWITZKE

On the afternoon of 22 July 1980, Party Comrade Dominic Lewitzke took his own life. Comrade Lewitzke had first come in contact with the Party in 1976, and had served as an activist and organizer in Yuma, Arizona, and Chicago prior to joining the National Headquarters staff in 1978. Most recently he had filled the positions of Membership Secretary and Corresponding Secretary at NHQ.

We are unable to pinpoint the exact reason that Comrade Lewitzke chose to take his own life. We do know, however, that he was troubled by personal circumstances and given to bouts of severe depression. We believe that his death resulted from an impulsive act undertaken during the depths of one of these periods.

The National Headquarters staff joins with Commander Koehl and National Socialist comrades throughout the world in mourning the loss of Dominic Lewitzke. He was an upstanding member of his race and a dedicated National Socialist revolutionary.

TWO-YEAR PLAN NOTES

National Socialist Celebrations and Holidays

An important part of Movement activities that is sometimes overlooked is National Socialist holidays. Properly organized, NS holidays present the perfect opportunity to combine the political, social and spiritual aspects of the Movement in a single day's activity.

Years of experience have determined that the following is the best way for a local unit (or any group of comrades) to commemorate a Movement anniversary: First, a public activity of some sort is held, preferably one in keeping with the general theme of the holiday being celebrated. For example, 10 May has been declared World Peace Day, in memory of Rudolf Hess' flight to bring peace between National Socialist Germany and Great Britain in 1941. Hence, World Peace Day activities should center around either the idea of peace or of freedom for Rudolf Hess.

The public activity need not be a high-profile, uniformed ST demonstration. Sometimes a simple wreath-laying or even a WHITE POWER street sale or door-to-door distribution can be just as effective. The thing to remember is that NS holidays (usually celebrated on weekends) are an ideal time to get a large number of comrades together, and that this opportunity should be seized upon for a major public activity. Besides helping to advance the Party, such activities prevent the commemoration of NS holidays from turning into bourgeois tea parties or closet "Nazi" dress-up occasions.

Second, following the public activity, it is appropriate to have some sort of social gathering. In warm months, for example, a picnic is perfect. Such social gatherings are a good way to introduce new people to the Movement, and to involve one's friends and family. Oftentimes, someone who would be hesitant to attend a public activity will be willing to come to a private social gathering—where they can be brought in closer to the Movement and even recruited for future activities.

Although the consumption of beer and other alcoholic beverages is strictly forbidden in connection with formal Party activities—whether public or private—beer drinking may be permitted at non-political social functions, at the discretion of the local Party organizer, provided it is kept within the bounds of moderation. Drunkenness can never be tolerated in connection with any Party functions, and all those who attend these activities must realize that.

Following a late-morning or early-afternoon public activity, and a mid-afternoon social gathering, it is a good idea to reserve the evening for a formal Party meeting and ceremonies. (Those interested in how

such meetings and ceremonies should be conducted should contact National Headquarters.)

In this manner the political, social and spiritual aspects of the Movement can be combined in a single day's activities, in the form of public activity, informal social gathering (such as a picnic) and formal meeting and ceremonies, respectively.

The following are major holidays on the National Socialist calendar. While it is not necessary to celebrate each and every one of these anniversaries every year, Party comrades (and especially local units) should try to commemorate as many of them as possible:

- 22 January—Matt Koehl's birthday (1935)
- 30 January—Beginning of the Third Reich (1933)
- 9 March—Lincoln Rockwell's birthday (1918)
Founding of the NSWPP (8 March 1959)
- 20 April—Birth of Adolf Hitler (1889)
- 30 April—Departure of Adolf Hitler (1945)
- 10 May—World Peace Day (Rudolf Hess' flight to Britain, 1941)
- 4 July—Signing of Declaration of Independence, First American Revolution (1776)
- 25 August—Assassination of Lincoln Rockwell (1967)
- 16 October—Murder of the Nuremberg Martyrs (1946)
- 9 November—White Pride Day (Also Martyrs' Day, in commemoration of the Munich Revolt and Massacre of 9 November, 1923)

West German comrades have reported an increase in the persecution of National Socialist activists by the Bonn regime throughout occupied West Germany recently. Large numbers of comrades have been arrested and otherwise harassed by the police. National Socialists in countries where the Movement is legal have a special obligation to aid those comrades in occupied Germany and other lands who must wage the struggle for our world view under more difficult and dangerous conditions.

In future Party publications we will be publishing a full list of National Socialist activists currently imprisoned by the Bonn regime. At this time, however, we ask all Party comrades to give their support to the family of Comrade Kurt Mueller. Not only has Comrade Mueller been imprisoned, but his family has been subjected to vicious and unwarranted harassment by the West German police.

A special fund has been established to help the Mueller family survive while the head of their household is in prison. Send your contributions and letters of support to:

ACTIVITIES IN BRIEF

• Three activities in opposition to the draft and Zionism were held by comrades in Cleveland during July. Cleveland National Socialists distributed hundreds of "Say No to the Draft" leaflets and displayed signs carrying the same message on 15, 26 and 30 July. Anti-draft actions by Party activists also took place on 21 July (the first day of draft registration) in Arlington, on Catalina Island (Calif.) and in Oroville (Calif.). No incidents were reported in connection with any of these events. The Oroville anti-draft action received a mention in the local System press.

• Party comrades in Cleveland held a uniformed WHITE POWER sale on 16 August. Some 55 copies of the new introductory issue of the paper were sold, and \$19.28 in donations was received.

• Units in the following cities and areas report the organized distribution of Party propaganda materials during July and August: Arlington, Baltimore, Chicago, Cleveland, Indianapolis, Los Angeles and Milwaukee.

• A letter to the editor of the *Dallas Times Herald* by Official Supporter Alan Hulen was published on 4 July. Comrade Hulen's letter defended the Party from an attack made on it by an earlier letter-writer, and upheld the concept of White people's rights.

• The Indiana State Chapter of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation is evidently more concerned with its public image than it is with finding a cure for CF—a usually fatal genetic disease that strikes almost exclusively White people of Northern European ancestry. The chapter refused a no-strings-attached donation made to it in July by the Indianapolis Unit of the Party, commenting that "it is the policy of the Foundation not to accept political contributions."
