'Computer Age' Appeal Over the Top!

The special appeal to “Help the Party Enter the Computer Age” was successfully concluded in July. Some \$1,529.35 was donated to the drive during the month. Added to the \$3,232.35 raised in May and June, the total as of 31 July was \$4,761.70—or just over 95 percent of the \$5,000 goal.

However, the Party received an additional \$1,000 contribution in July, which was not at first slated to go towards the computer fund. In the interest of completing the campaign as soon as possible to expedite the purchase of the Party's computer, the Commander has applied this sum to the “Computer Age” appeal. This gives us a grand total of \$5,761.77 as of the end of July—with some contributions continuing to arrive in August as this issue of the NS BULLETIN is being prepared.

The Commander and the Party staff workers in Arlington and Cicero wish to extend their sincerest thanks to all of those comrades who contributed to this vital fund-raising drive. We are especially appreciative of those National Socialists who donated to the appeal two or three or even four times. All those who gave to the campaign have made this important step into the future possible for the Party.

Indianapolis Comrades Counterattack!

After being forced to defend themselves against vicious anti-NS attacks by the mayor, the city government and the news media for three full months, Party comrades in Indianapolis took the offensive in July. Local National Socialists, with the assistance of Commander Koehl, gave a series of media interviews throughout the month which should go a long way in correcting the hostile and distorted image previously projected of the Party by the news media.

On 14 July, as part of an organizational tour to Indianapolis, Commander Koehl and Unit Organizer Clayton Roots gave an interview to the *Indianapolis Star*. The interview resulted in articles in both the *Star* and its sister publication, the *Indianapolis News*, in which the Party was allowed to give its position on the right of National Socialists to be members of the police and fire departments. That same day, the Commander spoke for a full hour on WIFE radio.

On 20 July, Comrade Richard Sharp gave an interview to WIBC-Radio, which was played every hour that day on the station's news program. It was the attempt to fire Comrade Sharp, a police officer, which led to the ongoing controversy.

A feeble attempt to get Comrade Roots dismissed from his

job as a firefighter was deflected after the *Star* and *News* interviews appeared. Mayoral aide Thomas J. Henry described Mayor William Hudnut as “extremely upset” because of Comrade Roots' media interviews, but City Attorney Jack Ryan reluctantly admitted to reporters that the city was unable to fire NS public employees simply on the basis of their racial and political beliefs.

Fire Chief Donald F. Strietelmeir came to the defense of Comrade Roots, describing him to the press as an “outstanding fireman” who has “not done anything that would be detrimental to the fire department.” Prof. Thomas P. Lambert, who was part of the anti-NS prosecution team at the Nuremberg kangaroo court after the Second World War, also came to the defense of the Movement, perhaps because of a guilty conscience over his actions of 25 years ago.

“I would not want to see a flatly stated rule to deep all Nazis from government employment,” Lambert said at a lunch of the American Bar Association.




Second NS Leadership School a Success

The second annual leadership school for selected Party organizers and activists was held in Cicero, Ill., over the Fourth of July weekend. Some two-dozen Party members and supporters, primarily from the Midwest, participated in this year's course.

As in the 1980 school, the curriculum was divided into three sections: The NS world view, NS methods of persuasion and NS organization. In addition to formal lectures and examinations, those who attended the school also participated in lively question-and-answer sessions and discussion periods with the instructors. Instructors at this year's school included Commander Koehl, National Organizer Martin Kerr and Party

comrades Norman Anspach, Joseph Davis and Harold Mantius, among others. Also present was WUNS European Deputy Povl Riis-Knudsen.

These schools have been instituted in connection with the Two-Year Plan. Two of the four primary goals of the plan are the "Thorough ideological training of Party leadership cadres" and the "Training of all Party members and activists in revolutionary skills." The NS leadership schools go a long way to fulfilling these goals.

These schools will also be the basis for a home-study course on National Socialism which will be made available in the future.

The National Socialist Women's Organization

The National Socialist Women's Organization is the women's auxiliary formation of the National Socialist White People's Party. The NSWO was authorized by Commander Matt Koehl in February 1975.

The NSWO is made up of Aryan women who desire to play an active role in the struggle for National Socialism and White Power.

NSWO members have three primary responsibilities:

(1) To train themselves in the National Socialist attitude and outlook and to foster the ideals of National Socialist womanhood;

(2) To recruit other Aryan women into the National Socialist movement; and

(3) To assist Party operations in areas where there is a local Party unit, whenever possible. While the NSWO and its individual members are encouraged to attend and help organize Party activities, they are prohibited under their charter from engaging in street combat or Stormtroop demonstrations.

Membership in the NSWO is open to any Aryan woman in the U.S. or Canada, 14 years of age or older, who is in basic agreement with the Party's 12-point program and who wishes to take an active part in the fight for National Socialism and who desires to live her life in accordance with the NSWO motto of "Duty, Faith and Beauty." Some Thoughts About Comradeship

Webster's New World Dictionary tells us the meaning of the word "comrade" is: 1) "A friend: close companion," and 2) "One who shares interests and activities in common with others." For National Socialists, both of these meanings should be considered.

When we think of the phrase "Party comrade," we should think not only of an associate who happens to have the same racial and political convictions we do, but someone who is also a friend.

The level of Party organization known as a "unit" should be a personal level of organization. The way to achieve a solid base for developing comradeship is to get to know people in your unit personally. Ideally, the Party should be thought of as one large family.

Naturally, not everyone will become close friends with everyone else. Individuals have different personalities, and sometimes they clash. However, the way to build a good bond is not to point out all of the things you don't have in common with someone, but rather to discover what you do have in common and work from there. One thing we all have in common is National Socialism, so we can start from that.

From time to time *agent provocateurs* are sent into our ranks for the purpose of disrupting some local unit or another. They always play on weakness and the petty differences which sometimes arise between even the most loyal Party comrades. All individuals involved in a relationship—whether business or personal—can be transformed into enemies if they do not have a strong bond between them. Provocateurs spread rumors and turn comrades against one another. On occasion they are quite successful, and after the dust has settled it is clear that they are responsible for instigating such things. But by the time they are recognized for the troublemakers they are, it may be too late. The local unit in question may be completely shattered, at worst, or have its progress set back, at best. Yet provocateurs or no provocateurs, we have only ourselves to blame for this dilemma.

If our comradeship is a strong bond, if it is like steel, no agent, no matter how clever or determined, can break it. Only when our comradeship is a weak link can our enemies prevail in such situations. If we are truly comrades in a common struggle, it is impossible for someone to turn us against each other effectively. It is only through a weak and imperfect sense of comradeship that our enemies can do this.

Comradeship should be one of our greatest strengths. It is what will hold us together in times of great trial. If we cannot unite ourselves, and set an example, we will never be able to unite our Race. Comradeship and National Socialism go hand in hand. If we work at it, it will be one of our greatest assets. If we do not, the lack of it will be our undoing.

QUESTION CORNER

Q: Every couple months our unit receives some printed garbage in our post office box from one "NS" splinter group or another, attacking the Commander and our Party in the most outrageous fashion. Why doesn't WHITE POWER or the NS BULLETIN do an expose on these groups like we did with Frank Collin/Cohn?

A: It is longstanding Party policy not to respond to smears directed against us. There are three main reasons for this:

1. We don't want to waste our time on bothering to refute such nonsense. *Any* response to attacks by anti-Commander, anti-Party elements only encourages the attackers, who often have nothing better to do with their time than sit around typing up lengthy and insane denunciations of Matt Koehl and other Party officers. Any answer we would give would only bring on a new smear, and before long we would be spending an entirely disproportionate amount of our time on the ridiculous allegations raised by these marginal critics.
2. Merely responding to these attacks gives them a respectability and credibility they do not deserve.
3. In nearly every case, the charges levelled against the Commander and the Party are so ridiculous and detached from reality that they in effect discredit those who are spreading them as well—if not better—than anything we could do.

With Frank Collin/Cohn—Jewish "Nazi" darling of the news media—it was a different story. This sick, sick, sick self-hating half-Jew was being used by the Jews to embarrass and cripple the entire NS movement. In his case it was a matter of exposing a very real (if only temporary) danger, not just responding to some petty, lying attack by those who are jealous of Matt Koehl's leadership and the NSWPP's success.
