National Organizer Defends NS Right to Freedom of Speech

Party National Organizer Martin Kerr defended the Movement's right to free speech during a debate aired over WRC radio in Washington, D.C., on 10 February. Also participating in the broadcast were a Jewish delegate to the Maryland Assembly, a representative from the American Civil Liberties Union and a Negro moderator.

The program focused on a bill introduced into the Maryland Assembly by Delegate Luiz Simmons. Simmons' bill is one of a number of pieces of legislation which have been introduced on a state level in Maryland and elsewhere which seek to place severe restrictions on the activities of White racist organizations such as ours. In particular, Simmons' bill would make the distribution of so-called "hate literature" illegal in Maryland. (The term "hate literature" means, in effect, any thing that is pro-White and critical of the Jews or other non-Aryans.)

Simmons remarks during the discussion were mainly aimed at convincing White listeners how wonderful his proposed censorship of racial free speech would be. He also read from the new Party leaflet "Three Jewish Contributions to Western Civilization," and commented that this was the type of material his bill would outlaw.

Simmons was immediately put on the defensive by the remarks of National Organizer Kerr and the ACLU representative. The ACLU spokesman began by agreeing with Simmons that National Socialists were awful people, and that their ideas were vile, obnoxious and terribly upsetting. Just the same, he argued, even the horrible "Nazis" have the right to freedom of speech under the Bill of Rights and shouldn't

be silenced by way of special, unconstitutional legislation.

Comrade Kerr denounced Simmons' efforts to stifle NS free speech in a more forceful manner. He began by saying that he agreed with the ACLU representative that the bill in question was nothing more than a thinly-disguised attack on the First Amendment rights of White racials. Kerr noted that the proposed legislation would have the same effect as *prior restraint*, which the Supreme Court has ruled unconstitutional on numerous occasions.

The National Organizer went on to note that Simmons is a Jew and that it is certainly understandable that he wished to silence all criticisms directed against his people. Even so, Kerr said, no individual and no group is above criticism — not even the Jews.

Kerr went on to stress the fact that National Socialism is based on love of the White race, not hatred of other races. Bringing such matters as Black intellectual inferiority to public attention was not "hatred," he explained, but rather simply a reiteration of proven fact which the Party feels that White people should be aware of.

Comrade Kerr concluded by stating that the only realistic solution to the growing problem of racial hatred and violence is the solution that the National Socialist movement offers: the complete geographical and political separation of the races.

Public hearings on Simmons' bill are scheduled for mid-March. Comrade Kerr has offered to testify at the hearing on behalf of the Party and other White racials.

'What Can I Do To Help the Party Grow?'

The following article is intended primarily for those comrades who are newcomers to the Party. Just the same, it also contains insights and information that even longtime Movement activists will find of value, and which will help them advance the Party in their local areas.

Nearly every new Official Supporter writes National Headquarters asking this question shortly after they sign up. New Party comrades are always filled to bursting with enthusiasm, and are possessed by a burning impatience to bring the good word of National Socialism to the White people of their area. Unfortunately, in almost every case, the new Official Supporter is completely inexperienced and ignorant as to what needs to be done to help advance the Party.

Inspired by reports of Party activists in cities with long-established local units, new comrades often blunder ahead, trying to do too much too soon, with too little knowledge at their command and too few resources. As a result, their efforts often are unsuccessful, and this lack of success in turn leads to frustration and disappointment.

Other new comrades realize the magnitude of the task facing them in trying to build White Power, and it so intimidates them that they do nothing at all—which also leads to frustration and disappointment.

There are three things that every new OS can do to strengthen the Movement in his or her area. Although they are not necessarily flashy and exciting, and although they will not turn your community into an NS stronghold overnight, the following three activities are ones which every new comrade can undertake on his own with an extremely high chance of success, and which are within the financial resources of all National Socialists.

Furthermore, the following activities are not only possible, they are absolutely indispensable in laying the proper foundations for long-range Movement growth.

1. **Study National Socialism.** People do not join the National Socialist White People's Party because they are National Socialists, as strange as this may sound. With extremely few exceptions, people enter our ranks with only the vaguest notions as to what National Socialism is really all about. Rather, they sign up because they feel they are in basic agreement with what they perceive to be the general thrust of our program: They believe in White supremacy, they feel hostility towards non-Whites (in particular the Jews and Blacks) and they think something should be done to "clean up America."

But there is lot more to National Socialism than that—a whole lot more.

Before a new comrade can hope to recruit other Whites into the Party, he (or she) must first have a complete and thorough grasp of basic National Socialist ideology. Until you have educated yourself, there is no way you will be able to educate other people.

All the materials needed to begin one's study of the National Socialist world view are available from NS Publications in Cicero. *The Program of the National Socialist White People's Party*, in particular, is a document every Official Supporter should know backwards and forwards. Other essential basic texts include *In Hoc Signo Vinces* by George Lincoln Rockwell, *Some Guidelines for the Development of the National Socialist Movement* by Matt Koehl and *The Revolutionary Nature of National Socialism*, also by Commander Koehl.

Once these pamphlets have been mastered, some more difficult items should be studied. Adolf Hitler's *Mein Kampf* is undoubtedly a very tough book for most newcomers to read, but it is also absolutely essential for a clear understanding of National Socialism. Instead of trying to tackle the whole thing at once, start to finish, we recommend studying the following two key chapters: Nation and Race (Volume I, Chapter 11) and The State (Volume II, Chapter 2).

The Dispossessed Majority by Wilmot Robertson is a very valuable book that all National Socialists should also read. It deals with the racial scene in America—past and present—in an intelligent and informative manner. Although the author is not a National Socialist, there is very little in this book which we can find to disagree with.

When the student of National Socialism is finally ready for some advance reading, he can complete the rest of *Mein Kampf*. Also highly recommended at this stage are *Which Way Western Man* by William Gayley Simpson, *The Lightning and the Sun* by Savitri Devi and *The Turner Diaries* by Andrew Macdonald.

The above listing is meant to be suggestive, not inclusive—in other words, there is no reason to limit your studies to what is mentioned here. Every single book and booklet offered for sale by NS Publications will help you gain insight into National Socialism and the problems facing the Aryan race today.

Also, we should emphasize the importance of the regular reading of WHITE POWER (especially the ideological sections, such as Questions and Answers) and THE NATIONAL SOCIALIST, as well as articles which deal with our world view that appear in the NS BULLETIN.

Lastly, let us stress the necessity of studying these basic works completely and thoroughly. It is never adequate just to read through them quickly to get

a general idea of what they are about. You must know them inside and out. If you come to a passage somewhere you find difficult or impossible to understand, you should not hesitate to write or phone National Headquarters for an explanation. Only foolish or stupid comrades remain silent when they are puzzled by some aspect of National Socialism.

2. *Spreading the Good Word to Others.* Only after you have a thorough grasp of National Socialism are you ready to try and convert others to our Idea. The simplest and easiest way to do this is to distribute printed material produced by the Party, such as newspapers, leaflets, stickers, posters, business cards and the like.

Bulk quantities of back issues of WHITE POWER make good recruiting weapons, and are fairly inexpensive. Go through a White residential neighborhood in the evening or at night and leave one on each doorstep. In the morning each household will have something interesting and informative to read and discuss over breakfast.

In areas where it is legal to do so, you can put leaflets under the windshield wipers of cars in supermarket or shopping center parking lots.

Party business cards can be placed in books about Adolf Hitler and the Second World War in your local library. They make excellent bookmarks, and they are a good way to reach people who already are interested in National Socialism to some degree.

These are just a few suggestions on how one person can distribute literature. With a little thought and imagination, we are sure that you can come up with ways especially suited to the area in which you live.

Another more difficult method of recruiting is person-to-person contact with your family, friends and co-workers. Surely every Official Supporter knows someone who is in basic agreement with our Cause. If you approach these people in an intelligent and restrained manner, it is often possible to gain recruits.

Do not attempt to do this, however, by browbeating your relatives with lengthy lectures on how awful the Jews are every night at dinner. *Do not* try to recruit your co-workers on company time. *Do not* come across as someone who is insanely obsessed. Rather, present an accurate criticism of the way things are today and then explain the National Socialist alternative. Take your cue from the lead articles in WHITE POWER. (One hint: It is usually best not to get involved in discussions on the "holocaust" hoax unless someone asks you about it point blank. Such discussions tend to be time-consuming and pointless, and they detract from more important issues.)

Whether recruiting people you know personally or distributing Party literature to strangers, keep in mind that you will *never* experience any immediate success. If you approach 10 individuals, you might find only one or two of them to be even mildly receptive. Even then, it might take months or years before they will go as far as to subscribe to WHITE POWER.

You may distribute *thousands* of copies of WHITE POWER door-to-door before even a single positive response is received.

Understand that recruiting is a very slow process. If you set your expectations too high you are only setting yourself up for a disappointment. Also bear in mind that everything you do along the lines discussed here builds *silent support* for the Movement. Such support will not manifest itself immediately. View your recruiting efforts as though you are planting a small forest of trees. Every seed you sow will not become a mighty oak, and those that do may take many years, much nourishment and continuous watering before they mature.

3. *Build National Socialist Comradeship and Teamwork.* Studying National Socialism and spreading the good word to others are activities that may be undertaken by individuals acting alone. But they may also be done in connection with other Party comrades. One thing to keep in mind is that it always strengthens the Movement when comrades who live in the same city or geographical area know each other and can work well together.

New supporters who live in an area where there is a local unit are urged to get in touch with it and take an active role in its program of activities. (If you are unsure whether or not there is a unit in your area, contact National Headquarters.)

Many new Official Supporters who live in an area with no local unit are eager to start one as soon as they enter the Party. They don't realize that starting a local unit is a hard and hazardous task—and keeping it going once you have started it is even more difficult.

Before a local unit can be formed, much preliminary work must be done. The way to start out is *not* to go charging off and open a post office box in the Party's name, initiate contact with the local news media and hold a tiny public demonstration.

Before beginning organized political activity, all the comrades in a given area should get to know one another on a personal basis. Informal gatherings should be held at least once a month, during which a sense of friendship can develop. Prior to formally organizing a unit, these comrades meeting informally should consider forming a National Socialist study group, to facilitate the ideological development of all those involved. At some point, such a group may wish to consider distributing literature on an organized basis. Out of such social gatherings, study groups and literature distributions a sense of comradeship and teamwork will develop—and from this a local unit may someday grow.

The key thing is this: Just as an individual comrade should not try to educate others until he has educated himself, a group of comrades must be able to organize themselves before they should attempt to recruit and organize others.

Conclusion. Every Party comrade has his or her own special skills and abilities, and will be able to help the Movement grow in different ways. The foregoing is simply intended to get those who are new to the Party off on the right track. Once you have gained the proper foundations of know-

ledge and experience, you will be able to devise many activities of your own to help carry our Cause forward.

A few final notes: 99 American Whites out of 100 have never personally met a National Socialist. The people you come in contact with in the course of building National Socialism will judge the entire Movement by the impression you make on them. Be sure it is your best impression.

All comrades, no matter what they do for a living, should strive to present an image to the public that flatters the Movement. You should keep yourself well-groomed and neatly dressed and in good physical shape. You should be courteous and reasonable at all times, and you should exemplify such virtues as loyalty, courage, and dedication. Keep in mind that we are a revolutionary organization seeking to advance the interests of our Race at all costs.

Distributions Continue Despite Record Winter Cold

Braving the record snowfalls and sub-freezing temperatures which gripped the northern portion of the U.S. this winter, Party activists continued the mass distribution of National Socialist printed material throughout February.

Comrades of the Richard Biederman Unit distributed 900 copies of WHITE POWER and 700 leaflets in Minneapolis suburbs during the month. Additionally, sample copies of WHITE POWER and subscription information were mailed by the unit to all 380 public libraries in Minnesota.

Partly in response to efforts by a Jewish legislator to ban NS literature in Maryland, and partly in connection with a previously-planned distribution campaign, Party activists distributed 1,000 back issues of WHITE POWER in Rockville, Md., during February.

The organized dissemination of Party propaganda materials was also reported by local units in Chicago, Cleveland, Indianapolis and New Jersey-New York.

Although the door-to-door distribution of WHITE POWER may be tiresome and boring at times, and although it seldom brings immediate results, it is still a vitally necessary activity. The mass distribution of NS materials not only brings fresh blood into the Movement, it also builds silent grass roots support for our ideas and our Party which will prove invaluable in the years ahead.

A New Comrade Reports

Anti-NS Legislation

FRENCH COMRADE SHOT!

As NS BULLETIN 284 was going to press, National Headquarters received word that French National Socialist activist Marc Gillet had been ambushed and was reportedly in serious condition.

In an attack reminiscent of the January, 1930, assault that led to the death of Movement martyr Horst Wessel, Gillet was shot by an unknown assailant or assailants while in his apartment in Nice. Gillet was wounded in the chest and shoulder.

The news of this brutal incident was withheld from the American public by the news media, although it was widely reported in Jewish periodicals throughout the country.

Gillet, 23, was imprisoned for several months during 1980 and 1981 by the French government.

At first no specific charges were brought against him, but after a lengthy period of incarceration he was charged with "anti-Semitism" and sentenced to 18 months in prison. Gillet is the Nice organizer for the French NS organization F.N.E.

This attack is only one of a number of similar incidents which have occurred in the last two years. In October, 1980, F.N.E. leader Marc Fredericksen and two companions were hospitalized after being beaten and stabbed by a gang of Jewish thugs.

Last year F.N.E. comrade Michael Caignet was blinded and maimed after three Jewish assailants poured sulfuric acid over his face and upper body as he was walking down a Paris street.

So far, no arrests have been made in any of these attacks, although the assailants of Michael Caignet have been positively identified by the French police and numerous witnesses.

French Neo-Nazi Seriously Hurt

PARIS, (JTA) — A French neo-Nazi was seriously wounded this week by an anonymous assailant who shot him in the chest and shoulder.

Marc Gillet, 23, was shot in his apartment in Nice, by a man who, he said, he barely saw. His condition was described as serious by hospital sources.

Gillet was found guilty last May of neo-Nazi activities. A Nice court sentenced him to 18 months imprisonment but most of the sentence was suspended. He was accused of addressing threatening, violently anti-Semitic letters to Jewish leaders in the south of France.

The court also found him guilty of setting up the local branch of the FANE (Federation of European and National Action), the largest neo-Nazi organization in France which was outlawed by Parliament in 1980. Gillet's family says Jewish activists have been threatening him since his trial.
