National Socialists Visit Red Anti-Zionist Rally

A dozen National Socialist activists paid a fun-filled visit to an anti-Zionist rally called by the Reds on 11 September. The demonstration was attended by 3,000 people, making it the largest anti-Israel protest ever to take place in the U.S.

For 23 years the NSWPP has spearheaded the anti-Zionist movement in the United States. Using the battle-cry *Dump Israel!*, it has never missed an opportunity to speak out or demonstrate against U.S. support for the Jewish state in Palestine. The Communists, on the other hand, have been much more reluctant to criticize American aid to Zionist imperialism.

Since the latest Jewish outrage in Lebanon, however, the Reds have been attempting to exploit the rising

anti-Israel sentiment by stressing the anti-Zionist nature of Marxism.

To remind the Communists just who it is who has been leading the anti-Zionist struggle these many years, three teams of National Socialists decided to distribute some NS literature at the 11 September demonstration. Since they had no illusions about how the Reds would react to the distribution of NS material at their rally, the plan was for the White Power activists to scatter hundreds of leaflets into the air at the height of the protest, and then depart before the Communists had realized what had happened.

The whole plan was based on the element of surprise. Unfortunately, that advantage was denied the National Socialists. They arrived at the site of the demonstration far in advance of the main body of marchers. The long wait allowed the Communist security crew, which had also arrived early, a chance to notice that there was a group of strangers loitering in the park, and that they were carrying half-concealed bundles of leaflets. One comrade commented later, "They weren't sure what we were up to—but they knew we were up to something!" Two or three Red goons were quickly assigned to watch each NS activist.

The National Socialists refused to be intimidated and decided to go ahead with their plan, if for no other reason than to show

their complete contempt for the heavy-handed efforts of the Reds to scare them off.

At the proper moment, one NS activist calmly climbed up on a park bench. A few yards away Red security guards eyed him warily. Without hesitation he launched into a brief but fiery oration, stunning the mixed audience of Communists and Arabs.

"Death to Zionism!" he shouted. *"Long live Palestine! Long live the White people's revolution! White Power!"*

And with that he hurled his bundle of leaflets skyward, and other comrades throughout the park followed his lead.

That was the easy part. The second half of the action was more difficult: The NS activists had to make their way to the truck which was waiting for them with its motor running—before the Reds could lay hands on them.

As it turned out, the inevitable fight didn't occur until the National Socialists were almost to their

vehicle. They traded punches with the Reds, who outnumbered them about two-to-one, and then jumped on the truck. As the Party activists climbed aboard, the Marxists made one last desperate attempt to get them. One Communist who got a little too close was booted in the face and was sent sprawling. Others tried to prevent the vehicle from leaving. They failed, and the pick-up shot forward, leaving the Reds cursing furiously and impotently on the sidewalk.

Soon afterwards, a detachment of mounted police arrived and pushed the Communists back into the park.

Meanwhile, the organizers of the rally were trying to re-establish order, urging their followers to ignore the "provocation." Some of the Reds, however, were too busy studying the NS material to heed the speaker.

The three leaflets distributed by the Party activists were *Racial Comrades of the Left!*, *The Begin Story*, and *Marx, Race and the Third World*.

ACTIVITIES IN BRIEF

• A letter from Party Member Scott Mosby to the *Milwaukee Journal* was printed on 26 September. The letter is reproduced here. Comrade Mosby's letter was much more hard-hitting before the *Journal's* censors got through with it, but just the same it has drawn some good response. Although Comrade Mosby received three threatening telephone calls from irate Jews, he also received two calls from people who agree with our stand on the Middle East—and who have since been sent Party literature.

• Commander Matt Koehl and a delegation of National Headquarters staff members joined with National Socialists from New York and New Jersey in honoring the 76th birthday of longtime Movement veteran August Klapprott on 5 September. Comrade Klapprott was a leader of the German-American Bund in his younger days.

• Comrades from the Washington, D.C., area held an anti-crime demonstration in Lafayette Park, across from the White House, on 4 September. A huge sign blasting the current unjust, inefficient judicial system was displayed, and leaflets explaining the NS position on crime and punishment were distributed to passersby.

• Members of the Chicago and Indianapolis units held a picnic in Westchester Woods, Ill., on 4 September, to help strengthen the comradeship and solidarity between the activists of these two cities. The National Socialists enjoyed traditional picnic fare, engaged in informal discussions on NS topics, and played softball.

• A garage sale was held by the Cleveland Unit during September, which raised \$100 for the Movement. The sum was generously donated by the unit to the National Headquarters operating fund.

• Hundreds of copies of WHITE POWER and the leaflet "Three Jewish Contributions to Western Civilization" were distributed in Northern New Jersey during September. In nearby New York City, a massive sticker raid was held in the vicinity of the United Nations. The Indianapolis Unit reports distributing 100 back issues of WHITE POWER during the month.

The Yiddish term "shabbes goy" refers to a gentile who does labor for those of the Jewish faith during their holy days. It also describes the so-called Christian militia doing the dirty work for the Israelis during Rosh Hashanah.

Thus far, the upper echelon of the Israeli government has pleaded ignorance of any involvement in the massacre of innocent Palestinians. Should Begin be gracious enough to admit that Israeli troops could have at least staved off the massacre, he'll shrug it off as some form of divine retribution for the 6 million martyred Jews during the Holocaust.

Quite frankly, the Jewish holocaust is ancient history and not to be dredged up as justification for each and every Israeli massacre of innocents.

Begin can press his luck only so far. Sometime, some other Mideast nation will grow weary of Israeli colonialism and genocide and give Begin a holocaust to remember!

Literature Tables in Arlington Spread the Good Word

"If the people won't come to the headquarters, we'll have to bring the headquarters to the people." Using this as their motto, activists from the National Headquarters area began a new program to spread the good word of National Socialism in Arlington in September.

The activity devised by the comrades consisted of simply setting up a table covered with stacks of WHITE POWER and other Party literature in some busy public location.

A sign reading "Help Build a New Order" or "Fight for White Rights" was placed in front of the table, and two neatly dressed and neatly groomed Party comrades sat behind it or next to it. The literature was distributed free to any person who expressed a sincere interest in the Movement, but a donation can was also prominently featured for those who wished to make an immediate contribution to the White people's struggle.

Although they were assured in advance by Arlington County officials that this activity was perfectly legal and needed no permit, the activists were initially harassed by the police. They refused to back down or be intimidated. Eventually the comrades established their right to distribute literature, and relations with the authorities were smoothed over.

One National Socialist reported his experiences manning a literature table:

At first the response was slow. A lot of Whites were hesitant to come up to us. Others approached the table but refused to even touch the literature. That didn't bother us, though, because we didn't expect to convert every single White person who walked by. We were seeking quality—not quantity—responses.

Over a period of time, we got to talk to a number of Whites who were sympathetic to the Party. We gave them literature (including the Party program) and we encouraged them to subscribe to WHITE POWER.

Some people came up to us with an extremely hostile attitude. All they knew (or thought they knew) about us was what they had seen on television. They thought that we were baby-murderers or something. But after speaking to us for a while, they realized that the old anti-NS stereotypes which they had been fed were a lot of crap. They left with a much more favorable impression of the Movement than they had had before.

Of course, some people aren't so open-minded. Those sitting at the tables report that they were subjected to a steady stream of insults and obscenities from Jews and other implacably anti-NS elements.

On one occasion, a woman overturned a table which had been temporarily left unguarded. The comrades

set the table back up and took precautions to see that that would not happen again.

These literature tables are proving to be an effective and inexpensive way to get our message out to the public in a low-key fashion. Units and activists who are interested in trying this out in their own area should contact National Headquarters for further details.

Label Those Dues, Pledges and Contributions!

A number of comrades have gotten into the habit of sending checks or money orders to National Headquarters without any explanation as to what they are to be applied towards. This practice leads to confusion and delays, and causes a little bit of extra work for the National Headquarters staff.

In the interest of efficiency, we request that all monies remitted to NHQ be accompanied by a note clearly stating what the sum is for (dues, pledges, gifts or NS Publications purchases). In the case of dues and pledges, the month the amount is for should also be indicated.

It would further ease the workload in Arlington if separate checks or money orders were written when money for more than one purpose is included in the same envelope. For example, Official Supporter pledges and NS Publications purchases should not be combined in the same check, because pledges and sales are deposited separately at the bank. Likewise, dues, gifts, loans and so forth also should not be combined.

The attention of all Party comrades to these details concerning remittances will be greatly appreciated.
