Subject: "HATE" CONVENTION.

1. In the past year, a powerful undercurrent of bitterness and squabbling has developed in the right-wing movement, resulting in many of us working at cross-purposes.
2. I, personally, do not believe that this is all the result of "jealousy", pettiness, and insincerity. It is too easy to ascribe the misunderstandings with the other fellow strictly to his "jealousy" or "small-mindedness", etc. Instead, I think that the cause of much of the squabbling and unpleasantness is due to lack of communications.
3. Fields tells Mullins something, who tells somebody in California, who passes it on to a guy in New Jersey, who whispers it to me all garbled up, and I get mad, --or it goes the other way around. Getting to the bottom of it is impossible, all spread out, as we are. And developing any kind of cooperation is out of the question as things stand now.
3. The enemy, too, has his little squabbles, sometimes sticking sharp ice-picks into each other's soft pink brains, as they did with Comrade Trotsky a while back. But they are not so undisciplined that they allow this sort of thing to interfere with their overall world-effort. The master-strategy, as handed down by the All-High Hebrew from Sanhedrin headquarters unites all the enemy, from the university don in tweeds, down through the liberal swine-pen, and all the way down to his gutter-fighters on the lower East Side.
4. We, on the other hand, indulge our egos and emotions by actually fighting one another sometimes harder than we do the enemy. James Warner, for instance, has actually gone to the Internal Revenue Department and complained that I did not pay the proper withholding and other taxes from his "wages", --an act which could mean the penitentiary, if proved true. (Mr. Warner will not get his thirty pieces of silver, however, because I have been scrupulously careful to prepare for just such a thing. I have bent over backwards to report everything, and then some, to Mr. Kaplin's tax hounds).
5. There is no "saving" Mr. Warner after such a treacherous and vicious act. But I cannot believe the rest of the movement wants any part of Warner and his private vendetta with me.

Further, I believe that the top leaders of the movement who are being sent this letter, can benefit tremendously by getting together and arranging COOPERATION instead of mutually disadvantageous squabbling and bitterness. I believe that we are the "gutter fighters" who have their place in the movement, but that the Birchers, even, the "Constitutionalists", -and all the rest, including the "segregation" groups, also have their place. Organized on levels of operation, -sending each other individuals who do not fit our particular "level" of activity, cooperating to keep the enemy chasing our set-up "wind-mills", coining catch-phrases which then "mysteriously" appear in all our stuff, the way the Daily Worker's phrases wind up in State Department documents, etc. --organized in this interlocking manner, our different groups will stop the silly effort to COMPETE with each other, and concentrate on Driving to POWER, so we can, at last STOP what we keep talking about so much.
7. For these reasons, and also for the plain, old-fashioned fun of good-fellowship among our fellow "hate-mongers" from around the Country, we would like to invite all right-wing and anti-Jewish leaders to our National "Hate" Conference here in Arlington on July 2, 3, and 4.

8. We have just acquired an unbelievable new place for our growing storm-troop, and can assure those who need them, very comfortable accommodations. Our new place is only five minutes from the headquarters, but is in the middle of eighteen wooded acres, secure from prying eyes of reporters, etc. Entrance to the estate is by a private road almost a quarter of a mile long. The house itself is a grand old "Southern mansion" with nineteen rooms, three baths and every facility.

9. I am aware of the terror this invitation will strike into some hearts. Some of you, I suspect, will envision me waiting here like a spider with Edward R. Murrow, Ghet Scumley and David Stinkley and a battery of TV cameras ready to "smear" all takers of the invitation as "Nazis" from coast-to-coast.

10. Therefore, I am putting into writing my absolute pledge, in the name of the master himself, Adolf Hitler, that those who accept our invitation will enjoy complete security in their persons and names. In fact, those who are still leery of us bad Nazis can be assured I will arrange private get-togethers at a place of THEIR choosing, so that there will be no chance of compromise or embarrassment.



At the get-together, I will make available the complete, unexpurgated manuscript of the book I have written, which is causing consternation in the right-wing, and will entertain all suggestions for deletions, changes, etc. Those who fail to take advantage of this utterly sincere offer, can certainly not complain later that they have been "smeared" unfairly.

12. I can also promise that this will be unlike any other right-wing get-together you have ever seen. I have been to many of them, and they always follow the same frustrating pattern; -speeches, private jockeying for position, struggles to reach wording for "resolutions" and programs, --and then more speeches that "this time we will WIN!" etc etc. --followed by explanations, at a later date, as to why it proved impossible to carry out any of the program at all. In three years of hard fighting, we have learned the secrets of ACTION, -and this is our first national convention. Regardless of what progress we make with our guests, you will sit in on a hard driving convention which will show almost immediate results and send the Jews scurrying to the ADI with more of the complaints they have been pouring upon the harried heads of this little hate society.

13. We are all set up to offer our guests the ultimate in a pleasant time, with barbeques, study sessions, beer-busts, --and whatever you want. I again assure every invited guest he, -or she, -will NOT, repeat NOT, -be exposed or mentioned in any way, unless he or she authorizes such mention in writing. I will stake my reputation and honor in the movement on that.

14. Write us a note, or simply return this letter with notations of who you are and when you will get here, etc. We'll see that you don't regret it.
