Dear Sir or Madam:

You are invited to attend the first ASSEMBLY OF RACIST MOVEMENTS, to be held in Washington, D. C., on the weekend of April 20-21, 1968.

This will be a LEADERSHIP conference, not a mass-membership gathering. We are more interested in quality than quantity, in attendance. Our only aim toward "equality" is that ALL organizations and viewpoints within the racist movement be represented. We have not purposely excluded anyone, and additional invitations will be issued as we become aware of any oversights. Our only stipulation is that those attending have demonstrated — in deeds or words — an allegiance to the premise that RACE is of prime importance in human affairs. This first conference will be limited to WHITE, AMERICAN (U. S. and Canadian) racists, but our title was purposely chosen to accommodate organizations from overseas, and even groups representing other races, at a later date.

The assembly is NOT intended as an effort toward "unity," but rather toward COOPERATION. It will be an attempt to clarify and magnify areas of agreement rather than of differences. The purposes will be : (1) to delineate the goals of White racist organizations in America, and (thereby) to establish the racist movement as a distinct entity in the public's eye; and, (2) to develop channels of cooperation on those issues on which we already substantially agree.

There has been an increasing realization within the White Wing, and especially within recent months, that the time has come for a major overhaul of our approach toward achieving victory. We know now that many of our erstwhile allies have been more a hindrance than a help; that world events have changed since many of our stands were taken; that perhaps we are too far out of touch with the average citizen to be able to win him over; and that we must experiment more boldly both in techniques and in alignment of forces. We can no longer be "conservative" when there is no longer anything to conserve. We cannot quote 1920 concepts and expect a 1970 audience to accept them. There are, of course, Eternal Truths; and racists, being closest to Nature, hold the tightest rein on reality. But can a sick world be made to take its medicine? The answer to that question will determine our success or failure.

In addition to clarifying our ideology, we must also discipline our movement — or face certain defeat. Internal warfare MUST BE STOPPED. It's killing off our leaders faster than we can develop them. Somehow we must reduce WARFARE to COMPETITION. None of us should fear honest competition or legitimate debate. It strengthens us. But short-sighted "leaders" who can see no further than their next-door neighbor, and who deliberately pick quarrels within our own ranks, even while the real enemy is knocking on the door, MUST BE DISCIPLINED. This can be accomplished only when we establish a feeling of WHITE COHESION. We must make the advantages of cooperation so great, and the disadvantages of dissension so unbearable, that there is automatic adherence

to a disciplinary code. This will be our only salvation. The age of chaos so earnestly promoted by our enemies is close at hand. Who can doubt that? Since the reins of power are never left slack, the question is, will we be strong enough to seize them, or will we fail by default? We can achieve the beginning of unity NOW, even while we disagree on the details of ways and means toward a final victory. There are several significant areas in which we can already begin to act in unison — IF we can overcome the personal pride and antagonisms that have separated us so long. We are individualists, yes, and our enemies work together much better because they are collectivists, but will we permit our most admirable trait to become our downfall? The pride of the White Man was meant to save him, not to lead him to vainglorious ruin.

The ASSEMBLY OF RACIST MOVEMENTS will be a vital first step in CONCERTED action by the White Wing in this country — and at what better time than two days before Martin Luther King pitches his black "Tent City" outside the walls of Congress? And what better opportunity for unified action?


Since this will be an exploratory conference, and since there has been no opportunity to agree on protocol prior to the meeting, rules and procedural arrangements will be held to a minimum. Those attending will be designated as either DELEGATES or OBSERVERS. Delegates (only) will vote on the business of the assembly. Observers will serve on committees, participate in discussions and act as advisors. Delegates and Observers will be SELF-DESIGNATED. Any political racist ACTIVIST may appoint himself a Delegate, although only one delegate will be permitted from each organization. Groups with active, well-established regional or local headquarters may designate a Delegate from each such unit. Writers, editors, publishers and additional "interested persons," especially those not desiring publicity, should designate themselves OBSERVERS. The number of Observers will not be limited, within reason. To avoid obstructionists or provocateurs, flagrant violations of these guidelines will not be tolerated.

The assembly will NOT BE PUBLICIZED prior to the meeting. The results, if substantial enough, will be released to the press on terms agreeable to all Delegates.

Please give serious consideration to attending this assembly, since its success depends on the calibre of the Delegates. All hatchets and shooting-irons must be checked at the door. Come prepared to participate in an event which will be not only the beginning of a new and vital White ground-swell, but could well be a turning point in world history.

I hope to see you in Washington next month.
