Dear Friend,

The investigation of the murder of George Lincoln Rockwell continues, BUT MANY OF THE FACTS ARE BEING DENIED TO THE PUBLIC.

Just as in the shooting of President Kennedy in 1963, a supposed assassin has been apprehended, and a chorus of the press and officials has begun to lead us to believe that one man ONLY, and one man ALONE, performed the deed. Common sense and much of the evidence indicates otherwise.

Believe me, I have looked into the case. I have talked with almost everyone involved, including investigators for the Arlington police, and I can truthfully report to you at this time that THERE IS NO DIRECT EVIDENCE THAT THE ACCUSED JOHN PATLER FIRED THE SHOTS WHICH KILLED ROCKWELL. And even the circumstantial evidence weakens when looked into carefully.

THERE IS A LOT NOT BEING TOLD TO THE PUBLIC. Patler's lawyers have been isolated by the press so that only one viewpoint has been presented. Despite the old adage that "there are two sides to every question," THEY WANT US TO BELIEVE THAT THIS IS AN EXCEPTION.


I am firmly convinced that this man, John Patler, CAN NOT and WILL NOT get a fair trial under present circumstances. He has already been convicted by the press. Witnesses have been advised not to speak to his attorneys. Investigators in his behalf have been threatened and intimidated. And, worst of all, HE HAS NO FUNDS to defend himself adequately, when only by a thorough and complete investigation using professional, EXPENSIVE methods, can he hope to prove his innocence.

I believe that justice should be done. I know that you do, too — and so will many others ONCE THEY KNOW THE FACTS. I have made arrangements for you TO KNOW THESE FACTS. I have hired a hall, and have invited Patler's attorneys to be present. Alice Patler, John's wife, has also promised to be there. YOU ARE INVITED TO THIS MEETING. It will be held at the George Mason Hotel, South Washington and Prince Streets, Alexandria, Virginia, on Sunday, November 19th, at 2:00 PM.

I will ask for contributions at the meeting, AFTER YOU HAVE HEARD THE FACTS. You will NOT BE PRESSURED into contributing. If you come with an open mind and a respect for Justice, I feel certain you will want to help. All funds collected will be handed directly to Patler's attorneys to aid the investigation and preparation of his case.

Since I do not want to be accused of "interfering with justice," this will be a PRIVATE, CLOSED-DOOR meeting, by invitation only. This letter is your invitation — you are welcome to bring family and friends. Seldom will we have an opportunity to participate first-hand in such a momentous occasion. I hope you will join me there.
