The National Socialist White People's Party, on behalf of one of its members, Mr. Charles H. White, of Asheville, North Carolina, wishes to call to the attention of the United States Justice Department, the Press, and all interested persons the following incidents.

Last Saturday, Mr. White and several other Party members and supporters attempted to peacefully demonstrate in opposition to Democrat Vice Presidential candidate Edmund Muskie on the occasion of Muskie's visit to the Asheville airport. When they began their demonstration, they were attacked, beaten, and kicked by members of the Asheville Police Department.

Mr. White went to the office of the Buncombe County Sheriff's office, seeking warrants for the arrest of his attackers. He was bodily thrown out by deputies.

When Mr. White then attempted to file a complaint with the local office of the FBI, his life was threatened by a Special Agent of the FBI. Mr. White has provided the attached affidavit describing the incident.

AFFIDAVIT OF CHARLES H. WHITE AND MRS. PAT INGLE

On October 12, 1968, at or about 7:30 p.m., Special Agent Robert S. Moore, of the Asheville, North Carolina, office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, did willfully and flagrantly violate Title 18, Chapter 13, Section 245 (b) (1) (B), United States Code (as amended by Public Law 90-284, of April 11, 1968). Specifically, the aforementioned Special Agent Robert S. Moore threatened to kill Charles H. White, a citizen of the United States residing at 61 Westwood Place, Asheville, North Carolina, members of his family, and certain of his friends. The threats by Special Agent Robert S. Moore against Charles H. White consisted in the following statements, or very similar statements not differing substantially from the following:

"You sorry son of a bitch. If you try to file a complaint, I will blow all of your group's goddamned brains out. I do not give a goddamn if you write to the President. If you do, I will kill you for sure. If I knew where you were now, I would come blow your brains out. If you come to the (FBI) office (in Asheville), you will not leave the building alive."

These threats were made during the course of a telephone conversation between Robert S. Moore and Charles H. White, as Charles H. White attempted to obtain information from the Asheville, North Carolina, office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation about filing a complaint of violation of his Constitutionally protected rights by local North Carolina law-enforcement officers who had viciously attacked him.

Mrs. Pat Ingle, a United States citizen residing at 76 Dale Street, Asheville, North Carolina, was with Charles H. White during this telephone conversation and heard all the above-mentioned threats.

Charles M. White, in fear for his life because of the above-mentioned threats, now requests the Attorney General of the United States to immediately prosecute Special Agent Robert S. Moore for the illegal act cited above, and he furthermore requests that positive and immediate steps be taken to protect him from injury, intimidation, and further threats of injury by Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation or other persons.

I hereby swear under oath, in proper form of law and under the penalties of perjury, that all of the foregoing information is true and correct in every essential detail.

The section of the law cited in the affidavit reads as follows:

"Whoever, whether or not acting under color of law, by force or threat of force willfully injures, intimidates or interferes with, or attempts to injure, intimidate or interfere with any person because he is or has been, or in order to intimidate such person or any other person or any class of persons from participating in or enjoying any benefit, service, privilege, program, facility, or activity provided or administered by the United States shall be fined not more than \$1,000.00, or imprisoned not more than one year, or both; and if bodily injury results shall be fined not more than \$10,000, or imprisoned not more than ten years, or both; and if death results shall be subject to imprisonment for any term of years or for life."
