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STATEMENT ON THE ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT AGAINST PRESIDENT REAGAN

The National Socialist White People's Party is aware of news media reports linking would-be presidential assassin John W. Hinckley, Jr., with a so-called "neo-Nazi" splinter group in Chicago. Upon first hearing these rumors we conducted a complete and thorough search of our files to determine whether or not John Hinckley had any past association with our organization. This exhaustive search revealed that no one with that name has ever been a member or supporter of our Party. Likewise, he has never subscribed to Party publications or purchased materials from our mail-order outlet, NS Publications, in Chicago.

The National Socialist White People's Party, now as in the past, denounces the use of political terrorism to further the aims of the National Socialist movement. Not through acts of violence directed at human beings or property, but rather only through winning the hearts and minds of White people to our Cause will we be successful.

The vast majority of the membership and supportership of our Party consists of a quiet, normal cross-section of White America. Our Party goes to great lengths to screen out those with serious psychological problems, those with criminal tendencies or those with a propensity towards violence. In fact, in the recent past a Party member served as a guard at the White House under presidents Ford and Carter. Similarly, the Party has members and supporters who are policemen or who serve in other positions involved in suppressing the crime and violence which is becoming increasingly rampant throughout American society.

Our Party actually acts as a restraining influence on individuals who might otherwise turn to violence. There are many, many White people who are angry at both politicians and non-White minority groups—and often rightly so. Our Party channels the anger and frustration these individuals feel into constructive political work. If our Party did not exist, there would be substantially more political terrorism in our society.
