ABOUT THE SPEAKER

John Tyndall has for the past 26 years been a dedicated campaigner for the cause of British Nationalism. Born in 1934, he entered political activity in his early 20s, not long after his demobilisation from the Army. After being active in a number of patriotic organisations, he joined the National Front in 1968 and rose to become its leader in 1972, in which capacity he served, with one brief break, until January 1980, when he resigned his office. The years of his tenure of leadership of the NF were the most successful years enjoyed by the party.

In June 1980 he acted with others to found the New National Front, following disagreement with the NF Directorate as to the course the latter party was taking. In April 1982 the NNF merged forces with other Nationalist bodies to form the British National Party and Mr. Tyndall was chosen as the BNP's leader.

In addition to his party activities, Mr. Tyndall is the founder and publisher of the hard-hitting patriotic monthly, *Spearhead*.

A music-lover and physical fitness enthusiast, John Tyndall lives with his wife and young daughter in Hove, Sussex.
